### **THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!**

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

#### Follow The Leader

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

#### **STAR-STUDDED ROTATION**

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP Alec Marsh started Tuesday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 24th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish started Wednesday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano started yesterday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy starts Saturday, April 23rd for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

#### **TOOLSY TEAM**

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the . system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system. .
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

#### GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

**NOTES** 

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and despite having not drawn just two walks in his last seven games and 29 plate appearances, is still second in the Texas League in base on balls with 12.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 56 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 27 times, for a cool .464 on-base percentage (14 hits + 12 walks) ... his OBP ranks sixth in the league and is the best among gualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all 12 games this season and one of just two players in the Texas League with a 12-game reached base streak this year, along with San Antonio's Esteury Ruiz.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leader in many categories, including 6th in on-base percentage (.464), tied 2nd in walks (12) and 3rd in steals (7).

While Maikel Garcia is the only Naturals hitter that has reached base at least once in all 12 games the team has played, he is not the only Natural that has reached base in every game they have played. 39 41

- SS Maikel Garcia has reached base in all <u>12 games</u> he's played started the season hitting .318 (14-for-44) with 2 doubles and 12 walks, giving him a .464 on-base percentage.
- started the season hitting .222 (6-for-27) with 1 double, 1 home run and 10 walks, giving him a .447 on-base percentage.
- Prior to Tuesday, INF/OF Nate Eaton and 2B Michael Massey had both reached base in all eight games they'd played this season and OF Tucker **Bradley** had reached base in all six games he'd played to start the season, but all three of those streaks ended Tuesday as Eaton, Massey and Bradley all failed to reach base ... pinch-hitting in the 9th inning and striking out, Bradley's team-best six-game hitting streak ended as well, though Garcia is only one behind him right now at five games.

#### **SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!**

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.

## **#6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH**

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility

## **#27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • Assistant Hitting Coach**

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
   After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices

- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.

### #23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
  - Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

### DANNY ACCOLA • Certified Athletic Trainer

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.


