**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds begin a six-game series against the Memphis Redbirds tonight at AutoZone Park. It's the first of four series and 24 games involving Tennessee's Triple-A teams this season. Right-hander Janson Junk makes his second start of the campaign. He'll face Memphis' Victor Santos, with first pitch at 6:45 p.m. central.

**Janson Junk:** The 28-year-old takes the mound for his 29th career appearance and 27th start for the Sounds. He made his 2024 debut on April 3 in game two of the series vs. St. Paul and took the loss. Junk allowed five runs (all earned) on five hits and four walks in 3.2 innings of work. He totaled 74 pitches and 42 strikes in the opening game of his seventh season in professional baseball. He has a four-pitch mix of fastball, sinker, sweeper and curveball. Junk went 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA in 140.0 innings last year. He pitched in a couple of games with the Brewers last season and has also appeared in the big leagues with the Angels (7 appearances in 2021 and 2022). The right-hander was originally drafted in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Yankees out of Seattle University.

**Victor Santos:** The 23-year-old is also making his second start of the season with Memphis tonight. Santos was acquired by St. Louis from Boston along with RHP Nick Robertson in exchange for LF Tyler O'Neill on December 8, 2023. Born in Villa Tapia, Dominican Republic on July 12, 2000, Santos took the loss in his Cardinals organizational debut on April 4 at Indianapolis. He allowed two runs (both earned) on eight hits and two walks in 5.0 innings of work, totaling 78 pitches (54 strikes). Santos broke into the Triple-A level in 2022 with Worcester in the Red Sox organization, going 3-4 with a 4.95 ERA in nine starts. He missed all of the 2023 season due to injury. Santos was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for May 29-June 4, 2022 with Portland and the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for June 16-22 with Lakewood. He was originally signed as an international free agent on November 14, 2016 by the Phillies.

**Wiernmobile Off and Running:** Outfielder Joey Wiemer blasted his first home run of the season on Sunday in Nashville's 8-1 win over St. Paul. After a slow start in the opening series at Toledo, Wiemer is batting .333 (7-for-21) with a double, home run, three RBI and four runs scored over the past six games. He's the only Sounds position player to play in all nine games to start the season.

**Bullpen Beat:** The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level on Sunday, working six one-run innings in relief of Nashville debutant Chad Patrick. Nashville relievers have all four of the wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.29), WHIP (0.93) and opponent batting average (.145) at the Triple-A level. Enoli Paredes (5.0 IP), Harold Chirino (3.2 IP), Rob Zastryzny (4.0 IP), Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The pitching staff as a whole has the lowest opponent batting average (.182) at the Triple-A level and the second-lowest ERA (2.93).

**Sunday Best:** The Sounds are 2-0 with a +19-run differential (20-1) after their first two Sunday games of the season. They throttled Toledo 12-0 on March 31 before the 8-1 win over St. Paul in their last contest. The 20 runs are the most scored on Sunday in the league, while the 0.50 ERA (18.0 IP/1 ER) and .103 opponent batting average (6-for-58) are the best marks on Sunday.

**Tobias Taking it to Ten:** Strikeout specialist starter Tobias Myers was back to his old ways, fanning 10 Saints in 5.2 innings on Saturday. It is the earliest a Sounds pitcher has gotten 10+ strikeouts in an outing (8 games) since at least the 2004 season. Myers became the first Sound to reach double-digit strikeouts since Eric Lauer on September 22, 2023 vs. Jacksonville. Entering the day, it's the only 10-strikeout outing by a pitcher this season in the league. Myers set a single-season strikeout record with Double-A Biloxi last season with 168 strikeouts in 137.2 innings.

**Something Brewing:** Brewer Hicklen has reached base in all eight games this season after whacking a double on Saturday. He leads the Sounds in most offensive categories. Hicklen is tied for the league lead in doubles (5) with former Sounds catcher Alex Jackson (now with Durham). He also ranks among league leaders in stolen bases (T-6th, 5) and extra-base hits (T-6th, 6).

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 687-588 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,279-2,108 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

**LAST OUTING:** Junk went 3.2 innings vs St. Paul on April 3. He allowed five hits, five earned runs, four walks and struck out three batters. Junk was charged with the loss in the effort.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Junk has three career starts against Memphis with them all coming in 2023. He is 2-1 with a 2.16 ERA (16.2 IP/4 ER) and nine strikeouts in the starts. He got the win in both of his road starts against Memphis (April 7 and June 29). His most recent start against Memphis was on September 8 where he went 4.2 innings and allowed seven runs (three earned) with one strikeout.
