

LAST GAME

For the second-consecutive night, the Bowie Baysox hung up ten runs on the Akron RubberDucks, winning their third-consecutive game 10-3. Matching his feat from two nights prior, Connor Norby led off the game with a solo home run, and Donta' Williams added to the feat by homering on the first pitch of his Double-A debut. Garrett Stallings allowed three brief runs, but turned in one of the best starts of his career, working through six innings and striking out nine batters. Bowie scored eight consecutive runs, including three in the ninth when Akron pitching walked six batters.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has been the hottest team in the Southwest Division over the past month, and have an opportunity to complete their late-season comeback with this final six-game series. The last time these two teams met, Bowie was entering a seven-game series with an active eight-game win streak, but only won two of the seven games. Since the start of that series, Akron is 21-11, and Bowie is only 14-17. Akron has been dictated by their pitching plenty this season, their 3.53 ERA over that same span is the third-best in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Tanner Bibee is still in just his first season as a professional after being drafted in the fifth round of the 2021 draft, and has proven his worth as another quality arm in the Guardians organization. He struck out 86 batters in just 59 innings while working with High-A Lake County for most of this year, and allowed only five earned runs over 22.1 innings in his last four starts before earning the promotion to Double-A. His work at Double-A has been just as impressive, as he's struck out at least four batters in every start for the Ducks, while walking only 12 total batters. He tossed a complete game in a doubleheader in his first battle with Bowie, but took the loss as he allowed two solo home runs to Connor Norby. His second outing was even more impressive, where he put in six more innings, allowing only one unearned run, but took a no decision when Bowie later tied the game. On perhaps one of the most impressive runs by a pitcher in the league this season, Bibee has thrown seven-consecutive quality starts, winning six games, striking out 46 batters and walking only nine in 42 innings. His fastball can work in the upper 90s while his slider has drawn praise for its hard movement and swing-and-miss action.

A COMMON OCCURRENCE

While their last two games have seen Bowie, more-or-less, gifted free runs from Akron, they've still plated ten runs on consecutive games. There are only 13 instances this season of a team posting ten runs in consecutive games this season in the Eastern League. Bowie and Somerset are the only two teams in the Eastern League to accomplish the feat three times this season. Bowie and Portland are the only two teams in the league to score ten-or-more runs in three consecutive games this season

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT!

Bowie finally broke out of a long slump of timely hitting that had plagued them for over a week. In an eight-game stretch from 9/6-9/14, Bowie only went 5-for-64 (.078) at the plate with runners in scoring position, only able to mange three wins in the eight-game span. In their last two games, Bowie is 8-for-21 at the plate with runners in scoring position.

GIVE ME A NUMBER THREE WITH EXTRA MAYO

Bowie infielder Coby Mayo had a slow start to his time at Double-A, missing a full month with injury after playing just three games with the Baysox at the start of the second half. While Mayo only hit 6-for-33 (.182) in his nine games back from the Injured List, he's gone 22-for-76 (.290) in the 20 games since with four home runs. Mayo hit his first career grand slam on Thursday, while collecting a career-high six RBI. Mayo is currently ranked as the Orioles #7 prospect by both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America

NORBY KNOWS HOW TO HIT

Connor Norby is taking on all pitches lately, while he has shifted back into the top of the Bowie lineup, Norby is hitting 11-for-30 (.367) at the plate with eight walks and only seven strikeouts. His 25 home runs across High-A and Double-A are the second-most among Orioles minor league players. He has hit 11 home runs in the first inning of games this season, the most in all of baseball. He has eight home runs in the first inning of games with Bowie, that's the most among any player in Double-A this year.
