TONIGHT'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds begin a six-game homestand to wrap up the 2025 season against the St. Paul Saints (Triple-A, Minnesota Twins) on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Aaron Wilkerson is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris for St. Paul.

SUNDAY'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds finished a six-game road trip against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Triple-A, Miami Marlins) with a 4-2 extra-inning victory on Sunday afternoon at VyStar Ballpark. Right fielder Noah Mendlinger smacked a two-run single with two outs in the top of the 12th inning to put Memphis in front. Mendlinger went 2-for-4 with two RBIs in the win. Second baseman Cesar Prieto went 2-for-5 with an RBI. Starting pitcher Zach Plesac allowed one earned run on five hits, walked one and struck out six in 5.0 innings pitched. The Redbirds bullpen combined for 7.0 innings of scoreless relief, led by Nick Raquet. The left-handed pitcher tossed 2.0 scoreless frames with a strikeout in his return to Triple-A. Memphis will finish the 2025 season with a 43-32 road record. The Redbirds wrap up the 2025 campaign with a six-game series at AutoZone Park against the St. Paul Saints (Triple-A, Minnesota Twins).

FEELS LIKE '18: With eight games to play in the 2025 regular season and its Friday night victory at Jacksonville, Memphis clinched a winning season for the first time since 2018. The Redbirds finished an even 74-74 in 2024, the club's best campaign since it won the Triple-A Championship over the Durham Bulls in 2018 and went 83-57 in the regular season. The winning season in 2025 marks the first in the tenure of manager Ben Johnson. Memphis continues its six-game series at Jacksonville against the Jumbo Shrimp, where Johnson became the all-time winningest manager in Memphis Redbirds franchise history with a win in May. The Redbirds finish the season with a six-game series at home against the St. Paul Saints.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 348 - 367 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

Transactions: Signed to a minor league contract by the Reds on 1/27. Opened the season with Triple-A Louisville.

2024 Season: Spent the full season playing in the KBO as a member of the Lotte Giants. Went 12-8 in 32 starts, logging a 3.84 ERA in 196.2 IP with a career-high 167 strikeouts. Ranked among Giants leaders in innings pitched (1st, 196.2), games started (1st, 32), strikeouts (5th, 167) and wins (T-7th, 12).

Career Highlights: Made his professional debut with the Red Sox organization in short season A ball with Lowell, tossing six innings on 7/20/14 at Auburn, allowing one earned run on three hits and two walks while striking out seven. Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers along with INF Wendell Rijo in exchange for INF Aaron Hill and cash on 7/7/16. Made his Major League debut with the Brewers on 9/15/17 at Miami, tossing a three up, three down ninth inning out of the bullpen to seal a 10-2 Brewers win and picking up his first two big league strikeout of J.T. Realmuto and Brian Anderson. Spent the 2022 season pitching in Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan for the Hanshin Tigers. Pitched for the Lotte Giants of the Korean Base- ball Organization in 2023 and 2024.

MLB Career: Made 14 appearances with the Brewers from 2017-19, posting a 6.88 ERA (27 ER/35.1 IP) and striking out 28 batters. His best outing came on 10/1/17 at St. Louis when he threw seven innings on one-run ball, striking out five and allowing just two hits.
