YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 5-4, to pick up their seventh straight win. Ismael Munguia hit a home run to lead off the bottom of the first inning. Later in the first, Andy Thomas doubled in two runs. In the third, Akron's Petey Halpin closed the score to 3-1 with a solo home run. The Flying Squirrels scored a run on an error in the fourth to extend the lead to 4-1. Bryce Ball pulled the RubberPoucks within a run with a two-run homer in the fifth and then tied the game with a solo homer in the eighth. In the bottom of the eighth, Andy Thomas put Richmond back on top with an RBI single.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians and the final home game of the 2023 regular season. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21 and split another six-game series at Canal Park from July 18-23 coming out of the All-Star Break. The Flying Squirrels are looking for the first-ever six-game series sweep. Richmond is searching for its eighth consecutive win, which would tie the longest winning streak in team history, even with an eight-game winning streak from May 5-13, 2021.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 43-26 in their last 69 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 9-1 in their last 10 games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.99 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 48.2.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 648.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.83 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 33 times over the last 17 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are 6-14 in their last 20 games, including dropping six straight from August 18-24 and all five games so far this week. Akron's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Juan Brito (No. 7) and OF Petey Halpin (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes six Akron players, including Brito (No. 6), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 19), Halpin (No. 20), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26), LHP Will Dion (No. 27) and INF Milan Tolentino (No. 29).

FUR RICHMUND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 26th start of the season and his fourth against the RubberDucks. He picked up a win in the series opener on Tuesday and threw five scoreless innings, allowing three hits with five strikeouts. Murphy has matched his season high in innings pitched (5.0) in each of his last three starts. In four starts since August 18, Murphy has posted a 0.95 ERA (22 ER/19.0 IP). Over his last 17 starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 1-6 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) and 68 strikeouts, lowering his season ERA from 6.15 to 4.10. He first faced the RubberDucks on May 18 at The Diamond and allowed one run in three innings with five strikeouts and four walks. He pitched at Canal Park on July 19 and allowed two runs (one earned) over four innings with six strikeouts in a loss. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Jack Leftwich makes his 13th start of the season and his fourth appearance against the RubberDucks. He worked out of the bullpen on Tuesday and allowed three runs over three innings. He also pitched at The Diamond on May 17 in a start, surrendering a season-high eight runs in 3.2 innings in a loss, including homers by Carter Aldrete and Carter Williams. On June 22 at Canal Park against Richmond, He surrendered one run over three innings in a start. Leftwich was selected in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Cleveland out of the University of Florida.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (421,972) and average attendance (6,394) this year. They are also 14th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels have drawn their highest total attendance since 2013.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels' seven-game winning streak is their longest in the 2023 season and is tied for the second-longest in franchise history. It is the fifth time the team has won at least seven consecutive games, including seven-game win streaks from April 27-May 3, 2010, June 20-26, 2014 and April 28-May 5, 2022. The longest win streak in franchise history was eight games from May 5-13, 2021. The longest winning streak in the Eastern League this year was an eight-game streak by the Somerset Patriots from August 24-September 1.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With seven games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one games ahead of the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and three games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 33 times in their last 17 games dating back to August 22, which is the in the minors during that span. Last Thursday in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern Le game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006. In this week's series, they have hom nine times.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 15 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in 10 of them. On August 17, Victor Bericoto hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, Sean Roby won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, Jimmy Glowenke hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before Brady Whalen and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and Logan Wyatt hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On August 30 at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On September 2, Will Wilson hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on September 3, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score. On Wednesday against Akron, the Flying Squirrels picked up a walk-off win in the 10th on an error. On Thursday, Wyatt hit a go-ahead single in the bottom of the eighth for a 5-4 win.

YDSHI: Yoshi Tsutsugo has gone deep twice in his four games played in this weeks series against the RubberDucks. On Tuesday, he hit a solo homer. On Friday night, he hit a grand slam in Richmond 13-7 win. Through his nine games with Richmond, Tsutsugo is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with three homers and eight RBIs. Tsutsugo is the first player born in Japan to play for the Flying Squirrels in the franchise's history.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 20 games since August 16, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .293 (22-for-75) with six homers, six doubles and 19 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. Bericoto hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of the August 27 doubleheader at Portland. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 25 homers (16 with Eugene and nine with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 82 RBIs.

**LONGBALL LOGAN:** Logan Wyatt is batting .360 (18-for-50) with five homers, three doubles and 14 RBIs in his last 15 games since August 20. He has homered four times in his last 11 games since August 26. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On August 30 at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization. Wyatt also hit a go-ahead single on Thursday in the eighth inning to beat Akron.

**BLIW SHOW:** Jimmy Glowenke is has picked up 20 hits in his last 16 games dating back to August 23, batting .417 (20-for-48) with three homers, two doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .355 (39-for-110) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .175 (20-for-114) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .314 (48-for-153) with seven homers and 28 RBIs in 48 games. On Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford last week.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 71 times in his last 39 games since July 25 (38 hits, 32 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .277 (38-for-137) with seven homers, eight doubles, two triples and 28 RBIs. On Friday night, he had an RBI double and a two-run homer. He is now tied with Sean Roby and Devin Harris for third in Richmond franchise history with 27 career home runs. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 140 walks, ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

PRDSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
