SHOREBIRDS WIN SECOND STRAIGHT: The Delmarva Shorebirds picked up their second win in a row on Saturday night as they defeated the Lynchburg Hillcats 6-3. Delmarva fell behind 2-0 in the first following an tworun double from Wuilfredo Antunez but the Shorebirds would respond with three runs in the bottom of the second on an RBI single by Erison Placencia, and two RBI base hit from Stiven Acevedo to give Delmarva a 3-2 lead. The offense would provide another three-run inning in the fourth thanks to a pair of RBI triple by Brayan Hernandez and Luis Gonzalez. Gonzalez would score moments following his triple on a wild pitch to give the Shorebirds a 6-2 lead. With a season-best 7 strikeouts from Deivy Cruz, and strong work from the bullpen including Randy Beriguete who secure his first save of the season, Delmarva earned a 6-3 victory to win their second consecutive game.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT:** The series finale between Delmarva and Lynchburg will feature the same starting pitchers from Tuesday night as **Juan De Los Santos** faces **Alonzo Richardson**. Neither pitcher factored into the final decision, but both threw the ball well as De Los Santos tossed 5.2 scoreless, while Richardson threw 5 innings, shutting out the Shorebirds for his final four innings after allowing a first inning run. Tonight will be the fourth time Richardson will pitch against Delmarva and has allowed 11 runs on 20 hits in 15 innings for an ERA of 6.60. The Shorebirds are 2-1 in games Richardson has started.

**HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo** has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in 15 of 19 games he's played in since the break. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last 15 starts as he has 6 multi-hit games while scoring 9 runs, and stealing 7 bases in that short span. His run at the top included a leadoff home run on the first pitch of the game versus Kannapolis on July 25 and a start on August 5 where he reached all five times against the Lynchburg Hillcats with a two-run single, and a career-high four walks.

**HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER:** Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. De Los Santos is coming off his best month of the season in July where he batted .267 with an OPS of .785 with 7 extra-base hits and 12 RBI. Most notably, De Los Santos has trimmed his strikeout rate as he has struck out 25 times since the month of June after striking out 25 times in April and 29 in May.

**TWO MORE MOVE UP: Samuel Basallo** & **Trendon Craig** are the latest Shorebirds to earn promotions to the High-A club in Aberdeen. Basallo was not just the best offensive performer on the Shorebirds, but in all the Carolina League as the 18 year old had his way in his debut season in affiliated baseball as he became a Top 100 overall prospect. Craig moves up after a strong 39-game run with Delmarva where he batted .302 with 14 extra-base hits, along with 18 stolen bases. With the promotions of Basallo and Craig, there have now been a total of 11 Shorebirds from their Opening Day Roster who have earned a call-up to the next level.

**NEW MONTH, FRESH START:** The Delmarva Shorebirds will look to right the ship after a tough finish to the month of August where they lost 10 of their final 12 games, including losing 5 of 6 in their last two series against Charleston and Kannapolis. Delmarva has had success this season against the Lynchburg Hillcats as they've taken four of six games in each of the first two series, giving them an 8-4 overall record against the Cleveland Guardians affiliate.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Juan De Los Santos toes the slab for the final game of the series against Lynchburg, making his second start of the week. This will be the second time De Los Santos pitches twice in a series, also doing it against the Hillcats on May 23 & 28.

**LAST OUTING (8/1 vs LYN):** De Los Santos threw his longest outing of the season last time out on Tuesday in a no-decision against Lynchburg. The right-hander went 5.2 innings, throwing 81 pitches and allowed just 3 hits and 1 walk while striking out 4. His 5.2 innings on the mound matches the longest-outing by a Shorebirds starter this season (Brehmer X2).

vs. LYNCHBURG: This will be the fifth time this season De Los Santos will pitch against the Lynchburg Hillcats, with tonight being his third as a starter. This season, De Los Santos has allowed just 3 runs versus Lynchburg as he owns an ERA of 1.62 in 16.2 innings with 15 strikeouts and 6 walks. De Los Santos earned the first save of his career on June 29 in Lynchburg by tossing four shutout innings in an 8-0 win.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.
