LAST TIME OUT: Making his High-A debut in Game 1 of the South Atlantic League Championship Series on Sept. 17 at Heritage Financial Park against the Greenville Drive, Fristoe was solid, tossing 4.0 shutout innings while scattering three hits and walking one and striking out five. Greenville threatened in the third and fourth, but had two runners caught stealing in the third and Fristoe stranded the bases loaded in the fourth before exiting after throwing 56 pitches.

LAST TIME OUT: The last time Hendry took the mound in a game was on May 18, 2023 while he was with Oklahoma State taking on Oklahoma in the Bedlam Series. He allowed one run on three hits while striking out two in the ninth inning of a 13-2 win over the Sooners in Norman. That was part of a stretch where Hendry allowed just one run and struck out four across his final three appearances of his collegiate career with the Cowboys. He did not appear for the Pokes in the Big 12 Championship or in the NCAA Stillwater Regional.

- Drafted by the Yankees in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft, but did not pitch after the draft.
