TODAY'S GAME: After taking their four of six in their series against the Chihuahuas in the first half of the season, the Space Cowboys look to start the second half on a winning note as they open a six-game series against El Paso on Tuesday night

ABOUT SUNDAY NIGHT: A go-ahead two-run homer from Cavan Biggio in the eighth inning lifted the Sugar Land Space Cowboys to a 7-6 come-from-behind victory over the Albuquerque Isotopes on Sunday evening at Rio Grande Credit Union Field... CJ Alexander homered for the third time in the series and drove in two runs, while Pascanel Ferreras added an RBI triple... After Albuquerque took its first lead in the seventh, Biggio's blast put Sugar Land back in front for good... Miguel Ullola escaped a bases-loaded jam in the eighth and retired the side in order in the ninth to earn his first save and secure the series-finale win.

INF Jack Winkler released by Houston... 6/18 - Carlos Pérez released by Houston... RHP Trey McLoughlin promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus... 6/17 - RHP Jason Alexander placed on the 7-Day IL, retro to 6/16... RHP Ryan Weiss outrighted to Sugar Land... 6/16 - C Collin Price optioned to Sugar Land... Yainer Diaz completes ML rehab, reinstated from the IL by Houston... RHP Hunter Brown completes ML Rehab, reinstated from the IL... 6/15 - RHP Jayden Murray recalled by Houston... RHP Alimber Santa optioned to Sugar Land.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 11 players drafted by Houston, 9 players signed as free agents, 3 international free agents, 2 non-drafted free agents, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 1 player selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features six of the Top 30 prospects in the Astros' system... That includes RHP Ethan Pecko (#6), OF Zach Cole (#9), OF Lucas Spence (#10), RHP Miguel Ullola (#11), RHP Alimber Santa (#16) and RHP Jose Fleury (#22).

PECKO PAINTING: RHP Ethan Pecko stayed sharp on Thursday, allowing one run on four hits over 7.0 innings with five strikeouts in his second straight seven-inning start... He threw a season-high 91 pitches and reached 96.8 mph... Over his last three outings, Pecko has allowed just one run on nine hits across 18.0 innings with 12 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .145 average... His seven-inning effort was the longest start by a Space Cowboys pitcher against Albuquerque in franchise history and made him the first Sugar Land pitcher to record consecutive seven-inning starts since Ryan Gusto in August 2024.

JUNE SURGE: Pascanel Ferreras went 1-for-4 with a triple and an RBI on Sunday night, extending his hitting streak to 15 games... Since June 1, Ferreras ranks second in the Pacific Coast League with a .455 batting average and a .523 on-base percentage... He also ranks second in OPS (1.214), ranks fifth in hits (25), is tied for sixth in RBI (17) and fifth in SLG (.691).

Upcoming Probable Pitchers

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: After hitting seven home runs in May before being called up by Houston on 6/4, C Collin Price returned to Sugar Land's lineup and homered twice on 6/17 as part of a 4-for-6 night with four RBI and four runs scored... It was his second multi-homer game of 2026 and the fourth of his career... Since rejoining the Space Cowboys, Price is 6-for-18 with two home runs, five RBI, two walks and four runs scored.

MISSED THE CYCLE BY... A COUPLE HUNDRED FEET: CJ Alexander finished a single shy of the cycle on Wednesday night, going 4-for-6 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, two RBI and four runs scored... After doubling in the first, tripling in the third and homering in the fourth, Alexander stepped up in the ninth needing a single, but ended up hitting his second double of the night, a 410-foot bullet that left his bat at 104.6 mph... Alexander's four extra-base hits tied a single-game franchise record, the fifth overall game with four extra-base hits and first since Luis Castro on 8/5/25 @ SAC.

POWER PAIR: CJ Alexander went 1-for-4 with a homer, three RBI, a walk and a run scored on Sunday night... Over the six-game series against Albuquerque, Alexander went 9-for-26 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI, three walks and eight runs scored.

Cavan Biggio went 2-for-4 with a home run, two RBI, two walks and three runs scored on Sunday evening... The pair of walks moved Biggio into second place in the Pacific Coast League with 50 on the season... During the series against the Isotopes, Biggio went 7-for-20 with a double, three home runs, six RBI, seven walks and six runs scored.

TRIO OF TOUCHDOWNS: Sugar Land's 21-run outburst last Wednesday marked the eighth 20-run game in franchise history, tied for the third-highest scoring total all-time, and their first 20-run performance since 5/29/24 at Las Vegas.

SPENCE SOARS: OF Lucas Spence was promoted to Sugar Land on June 22 after putting together a 14-game hitting streak with Corpus Christi... During the streak, Spence batted .407 (24-for-59) with five doubles, two triples, four home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored and five walks against nine strikeouts.

On June 18 against San Antonio, the left-handed hitter recorded the first multi-homer game of his professional career... Spence opened the night with a 407-foot home run off the batter's eye in center field before adding an opposite-field blast to left-center in the third inning to complete the two-homer performance.

Rated as the #10 prospect in the Astros' organization by MLB Pipeline, this is Spence's first promotion to Triple A.

EXTRA, EXTRA! A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

ONE-HIT WONDER: On 4/3, the Space Cowboys took a no-hitter into the ninth inning and came three outs shy of the first no-hitter in franchise history... However, it was the fifth one-hitter for Sugar Land in a nine-inning game and their first since April 13, 2025 vs. Albuquerque when they won 7-0. The other one-hitters were:

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on audio streaming at SLSpaceCowboys.com/Listen. All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

LAST OUTING: Started on 6/17 @ Albuquerque gaining his third win of the year... Fired 5.1 innings giving up seven hits, four runs, three earned, with two walks and four strikeouts... Gordon threw 88 pitches, 54 strikes and topped out at 93.6 mph.

VS ELP: Next appearance against El Paso will be his 11th... Against the Chihuahuas in his career is 4-0 with a 5.48 ERA in 44.1 innings with 13 walks and 42 strikeouts.... His last appearance against ELP was on 6/3 @ ELP where he threw 5.2 innings, allowing nine hits and five runs while striking out two in a 15-8 win in which he received the win.

PCL PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Named PCL Pitcher of the Week for 5/26 - 31 after hurling 6.0 shutout frames against OKC... Was the only pitcher in the PCL during the week that threw at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run... Was his third career PCL Pitcher of the Week honor.

2026: Has pitched for both Houston and Sugar Land in 2026... Started the year on the Space Cowboys roster, making three starts... Went (1-1, 1.76 ERA), 15.1 IP, 11 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 4 BB, 13 K... Recalled by Houston on 4/13... Made 4 appearances, 1 start, throwing 9.1 IP, 21 H, 12 R, 12 ER, 3 BB, 11 K... Optioned to Sugar Land on 4/25.

2025: Made 20 appearances, 14 starts, with Houston in 2025, going 6-4 with a 5.34 ERA, hurling 86.0 innings and striking out 72... Finished tied for third in innings pitched for the Astros... Made Major League debut on 5/14 vs. KC and struck out the first batter he faced in the first, Jonathan India, for first-career K.
