JUMBO SHRIMP WALK OFF TIDES, SALVAGE SPLIT

A strong outing from **Patrick Monteverde** and a walk-off from **Javier Sanoja** helped the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp defeat the Norfolk Tides 2-1 Sunday evening. Tied 1-1 in the bottom of the 10th, Dalvy Rosario started the inning at second base as the zombie runner. After a strikeout, Norfolk (60-72, 24-33) reliever **Corbin Martin** (1-3) intentionally walked **Jacob Berry**. Rosario stole third and then Sanoja hit a ground ball to Tides shortstop **Niko Goodrum**, who threw to first for the out but allowed Rosario to score the winning run for Jacksonville (63-67, 28-27) in the process.

'PEN PALS

After the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen surrendered seven runs in the 10th inning of Thursday's 12-7 loss to the Tides, Jacksonville's relievers have been extraordinary in the three games since. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers combined for 17.1 scoreless innings over the weekend. Over these last three games, the Jacksonville bullpen has yielded only six hits with 21 strikeouts against three walks.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jumbo Shrimp starting pitching has picked up considerably over the last 11 games, beginning in the midst of their set at Nashville. During this 11-game stretch, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to yield only 23 runs, 19 earned, on 41 hits (6.9 H/9) in 53.2 innings for a 3.19 ERA. Over this span, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has combined for 60 strikeouts (10.1 K/9) against only 14 walks (2.3 BB/9). Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 10 of these 11 games, with shutout performances in two contests.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 31-37 (.456) record.Jacksonville has scored only 281 runs at home (4.1 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 295 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 277 runs (4.5 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded tied for the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (331, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is +18 on the road, but -50 at home.

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 45 games this season decided by one run (21-24), tied with Iowa (26-18) for the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 83 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 63.8 percent of the club's 130 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 43-40 (.512) in those tightly-decided contests.

LADIES FIRST

When Norfolk scored the game's first run on Sunday against Jacksonville, it marked the 17th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .529 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 9-8 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 68 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 46 contests (67.6 percent). Jacksonville is 16-30 (.348) in those affairs.

IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last 12 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of both Nashville and Norfolk have combined to surrender only 13 runs, 11 earned, on 27 hits (5.1 H/9) in 47.2 innings (2.08 ERA, 50 K, 19 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 12-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 27-for-156 (.173) at the plate, scratching across only 12 runs in 40 innings.

SHRIMP BITES

Anthony Bender was the Jumbo Shrimp's 44th pitcher of the season, matching the club record (1962-present) of 44 set during the 2023 campaign. He was Jacksonville's 24th different starting pitcher. The franchise record is 26, which was set during the 2022 season... Bender is also the 77th Jumbo Shrimp to play in a game this season. The club record is 79, also set in 2022... After salvaging a series split last week, Jacksonville has only two home series wins in 2024 (4/16-21 vs. NOR and 8/13-18 vs. MEM).

ABOUT RODDERY

-Originally signed by the Atlanta Braves on June 11, 2018 as a non-drafted free

-On July 17, 2023, the Washington Nationals claimed Muñoz off waivers from Atlanta. The Pittsburgh Pirates then claimed Muñoz on waivers on December 1, 2023, and after designating him for assignment, they traded him to Miami on December 20, 2023 for cash considerations.

2024 SEASON

-Made major league debut for Miami on April 20 against the Cubs, pitching five innings, allowing two runs on two hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

-Earned first career MLB win on May 1 in a start against the Colorado Rockies in which he ceded only one run on three hits in 6.0 innings. He struck out seven

-Worked a career-high 8.0 innings on May 26 at Gwinnett, scattering three hits and two walks with three strikeouts.

2023 SEASON

-Between the Rookie-level FCL Braves, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett and Triple-A Indianapolis in 2023, posted a 4-6 record and 5.42 ERA in 34 games, including 14 starts (78.0 IP, 70 H, 53 BB, 81 K)

-Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts (35.0 IP, 35 H, 26 BB, 36 K, .259 BAA). As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (31.0 IP, 28 H, 20 BB, 32 K, .239 BAA).
