#### JACKSONVILLE BLASTS MEMPHIS 10-1

Behind a season-high six innings from **Yonny Chirinos**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp blasted three home runs en route to a 10-1 win over the Memphis Redbirds Tuesday night. After trading scoreless innings through the first four frames, Jacksonville (13-9) packed the power in the top of the fifth. **Griffin Conine** (2) and **Jonah Bride** (5) each launched a two-run blast off Memphis (10-11) starter Michael McGreevy (L, 1-3) to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 4-0 lead. Memphis got a run back in the bottom of the sixth and **Troy Johnston** (1) blasted the third two-run blast of the game increasing the lead to 6-1. Four more runs crossed the plate for the Jumbo Shrimp in the eighth inning blowing the game open 10-1.

#### DANE TIME

Heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville outfielder **Dane Myers** is riding a 18-game on-base streak, the third-longest such run in the International League this season. Myers got off to a slow start on this streak; over the first eight games of the streak, he went just 6-for-29 (.207/.343/.207/.550) with one RBI and four walks. In the 10 games since, though, the Katy, Texas native is 11-for-37 (.297/.395/.486/.881) with four doubles, one home run, five RBIs, six walks and nine runs scored. On the season, Myers' 55.3 percent ground ball rate is the 17th-highest among the 145 qualifiers in the International League. His ground ball rate was 46.6 percent in 2023 with Jacksonville.

#### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jacksonville infielder **Jonah Bride** blasted two home runs on Wednesday, his second multi-homer game in six days. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 18-for-52 (.346/.493/.654/1.147) with four doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs, 11 walks and seven runs scored. Bride ranks first in the International League in on-base percentage while ranking fourth in OPS, ninth in slugging percentage and ninth in batting average.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 13 of Jacksonville's 22 games (59.1 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 10-3 (.769) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

#### SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 52 of their 196 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 52 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in half of those, a total of 26 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, three four-run innings, seven frames of three runs and 14 two-run innings.

#### TEN COMMANDMENTS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 12 of their last 18 games. Nine of those 12 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville actually being outscored by their opponents by a 82-78 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing fifth in ERA (4.26) in Triple-A during this stretch.

#### SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 22 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 102 runs (4.6 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 40-for-184 (.216/.326/.352/.678), ranking 29th, 27th, 27th and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just six stolen base attempts and five stolen bases in the 15 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A... Jumbo Shrimp starters have worked 97.2 innings this season, with the club's relievers combining for 98.1 frames. Thus, Jacksonville's starting pitchers have combined for 49.8 percent of the team's innings pitched... The Jumbo Shrimp's 24.9 AB/HR ranks sixth in Triple-A and their 30 home runs ranks T-4th in Triple-A.
