"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints ended their road trip in Indianapolis on a five-game losing streak as they fell 7-3 to the Indians on Sunday afternoon, dropping six of the seven games in the series at Victory Field. For the fifth straight game, the Saints gave up multiple runs in the first inning, falling behind 2-0 after a two-run double by Nick Yorke. In the fifth, the Saints rallied to tie the game when the two newest additions to the St. Paul lineup sparked a rally. With two outs, first baseman Aaron Sabato drew a walk and Noah Cardenas followed with a two-run blast to left field, his first Triple-A home run, to tie it at 2-2. Indianapolis answered in the bottom of the inning as Arika Williams reached on a throwing error by pitcher Cody Lawerson before Ronny Simon singled to right-center and Solak drove in his third run on an RBI knock to left-center. The Saints tied it up again in the eighth following back-to-back doubles by Carson McCusker and Anthony Prato, but the Indians responded with a four-run bottom of the inning. Liover Peguero gave Indy a two-run lead on a single and Darick Hall ripped a two-run homer to right to seal it, with all the runs allowed by reliever Ryan Jensen.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: The Saints and Mud Hens meet in a six-game series this week at CHS Field, and both come in on significant offensive ruts. St. Paul and Toledo were the two worst hitting teams in Triple-A in the previous week by both batting average and team OPS, with the Saints hitting just .179 (39-218) with a .583 OPS last week in Indianapolis, better than only Toledo who hit just .151 (26-172) with a .463 OPS in an 0-6 homestand vs Omaha. St. Paul and Toledo also have the two worst team batting averages in Triple-A since the start of June (Toledo-.198, St. Paul-.213) and each are bottom-6 in the Triple-A circuit in OPS since the turn of the calendar page. The Saints and Mud Hens each enter with losing streaks of five or more games (the Mud Hens have lost six straight), which are the two longest active losing skids in the IL West (Syracuse have lost 8 straight and Rochester 12 entering the week in the IL East). The Saints are just 3-12 since May 31, touting the fourth-worst winning% among all 120 full-season minor league teams and better than only Rochester (2-12) in the Triple-A circuit in that time.

DIGGING THEMSELVES IN A HOLE EARLY: The Saints have given up multiple runs in the first inning in all five games of their current losing streak. It marks the first time in the Saints' Triple-A history that they've allowed the opponent to score in the first frame in five games in-a-row. The Saints have allowed 66 runs in the first inning this season, the most of any inning this year and the second-most runs allowed in the opening inning of any team in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Triple-A Charlotte (77).

ROLE REVERSALS: St. Paul's ERA among relievers has been nearly two full runs better in the month of June than the first 24 months of the season while their starting pitching ERA has been about 1.5 runs worse in the month of June:

LIVING BY THE LONGBALL: The Saints homered just twice in their 7-game series in Indianapolis last week, their fewest homers hit in a 7-game span since going deep just once in the first seven games of the season. St. Paul had gone homerless for four games in-a-row until Mickey Gasper touched off for his tenth of the year on Friday night, marking the Saints' second-longest drought without a homer this year. From April 14-June 8, the Saints hit 67 homers in a span of 48 games, which ranked 3rd in Minor League Baseball in that stretch. In the seven games since June 10, they're one of just three teams in Triple-A with two or fewer. St. Paul are 23-20 this year when they hit at least one homer and just 8-21 when they don't go yard.

I'M LOVIN IT: Left-hander Richard Lovelady had retired 18 consecutive batters faced until allowing a two-out single to Darick Hall on Sunday in Indianapolis, an impressive run spanning from June 1-15. The veteran southpaw surpassed fellow left-hander Kody Funderburk for the most consecutive batters retired by a St. Paul pitcher this year, with Funderburk retiring 16 Triple-A batters in-a-row from April 4-27, interrupted by a stint with the Twins. Lovelady has successfully converted six straight save opportunities, currently the third-longest active streak in Triple-A entering the week.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .345 (41-119) with 11 doubles, 8 HR, and 22 RBI in 31 games. Gasper is t-2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (19) since that date and his OPS ranks 1st in the International League (min 100 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as 2nd in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure):

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints currently tout three of Minnesota's preseason top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list and St. Paul's roster overall features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and Baseball America's preseason lists: OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA, currently on the 7-Day IL), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23, on 7-Day IL). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 by BA.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (36-35) have lost four straight coming off a Monday off day and open up a three-game series in Cincinnati tonight with David Festa (1-1, 4.76) on the bump. Following a 3-for-4 game on Sunday that included his 7th home run of the year, Brooks Lee has hit safely in a career-high 15 straight games in which he's had an at-bat. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (34-29) won four straight to end last week and hit the road to face Arkansas (SEA) this week. Outfielder Tyler Fedko is tied for the Texas League lead with 11 home runs on the season entering the week. High-A Cedar Rapids (37-26) took 5-of-7 games last week hosting Peoria (STL) and are on the road in Beloit (MIA) this week. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaalen Cculpepper and catcher Nate Baez each rank among the top-10 in the Midwest League in batting average and OPS. Low-A Fort Myers (27-35) had seven games either postponed, suspended, or cancelled last week in Dunedin and look for better weather this week as they host Lakeland (DET).

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his 11th start of the season on Wednesday night in Indianapolis and turned in his best outing of the season, turning in five scoreless frames for the first time since his Triple-A debut in September of 2024. Pitched around two baserunners in each of the first three innings, but settled in to retire the last seven batters he faced to close the outing. According to pitch-tracking, threw 19 sweepers (26%), 17 four-seamers (23%), 15 cutters (20%), 12 changeups (16%), 8 curveballs (11%) and 3 sinkers (4%). Induced 10 swings-and-misses, his fourth straight start of double-digit whiffs after recording a season-high 20 in his previous start. Recorded two of his three punchouts on the curveball and one on the sweeper.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Raya etched his name into Saints history in his start on May 24 vs Norfolk. After entering play with an ERA north of 12.00 on the season and more walks than strikeouts, he came out and struck out the first six batters he faced, becoming the third-ever Saints pitcher to go six up, six down all on the strikeout to start a game, joining Joe Ryan (Aug. 20, 2021 vs Iowa) and Bailey Ober (May 30, 2021 @Iowa). He came one shy of the franchise record of 7 K's in-a-row at any point in a game, a record held by David Festa (set on May 25, 2024 @BUF). Raya was also perfect through the first four innings of the game before reaching his pitch count, marking just the third time that the Saints took a perfect game bid through four innings (Mario Sanchez went 13 up-13 down to start on June 26, 2022 @Buffalo & Simeon Woods Richardson went 12 up-12 down on April 28, 2023 @Rochester). The Saints bullpen promptly followed his start with a leadoff walk in the fifth in a game the Saints would go on to lose 12-1 in 7 innings.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletics run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.
