SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

A CLEAN SLATE: Today marks the first day in the second half of the 2023 Southern League season... Every team across the league starts at 0-0, with the final two playoff spots determined by the best record in the North and South Division over the final 69 games... The Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA) and Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN) each clinched a playoff spot by winning the first half divisional titles in the North and South Division.

FAMILIAR FACES: The Shuckers are set to open the second half against the Mississippi Braves, marking the fourth of five series between the two teams in 2023... The Shuckers have stolen 52 bases against the M-Braves in 2023, led by INF Tyler Black (15) and INF/OF Isaac Collins (10)... The meeting marks their first at MGM Park since April 25-30, which saw the two teams split their six-game set.

A DYNAMIC DUO: Entering today, INF Tyler Black and OF Jackson Chourio are one of three pairs of teammates in Minor League Baseball with 10+ home runs and 20+ stolen bases this year... The duo is one of three, along with INF Jordan Lawlar and INF Ryan Bliss (Amarillo Sod Poodles) and OF Trey Cabbage and OF Jordyn Adams (Salt Lake Bees).

CROSSING THE 40 MARK: INF Tyler Black became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday... Black BLX SINGLE-SEASON SB LEADERS enters today 13 away from breaking **OF Johnny Davis'** record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... He enters today with the most out of any player in Double-A, and the fifth-most in Minor League Baseball... Black's 16 stolen bases in June are the thirdmost out of any player in MLB and MiLB.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: On Monday night, C Jeferson Quero and INF Jackson Chourio were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: With a two-run home run and a stolen base on Friday night, OF Jackson Chourio became the third teenager since 2005 to reach 20 stolen bases and 10 home runs in a single-season in the high minors and the first since **OF Ronald Acuna Jr.** did so in 2017... **OF Delmon Young** with the Montgomery Biscuits is the only other player to achieve the feat since 2005, doing so during the '05 season.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ [4-2, 3.02]: RHP Carlos Rodriguez is set to make his 40th career start, and his fourth against the M-Braves in 2023... The righty owns a 1.29 ERA over 14.0 innings against Mississippi with 26 strikeouts... Rodriguez has been dominant against left-handed batters, limiting them to a .164 average, the lowest out of any pitcher in Double-A and the eighth-lowest out of any pitcher in Minor League Baseball.
