The Indians rode the long ball to victory against Jacksonville, with all three runs prior to the ninth inning coming via solo home runs. Gilberto Celestino and Grant Koch pounced on Jumbo Shrimp starter Valente Bellozo with back-to-back blasts to open the third inning. Ashcraft was tagged for his only earned run on back-to-back doubles in the fifth inning from Jacksonville's Jhonny Pereda and Tristan Gray, before Liover Peguero added one more to open the sixth. The 24-year-old struck out four and didn't walk a batter in his Indians debut, at one point retiring 12 hitters in a row. Ashcraft's Indians debut came on the heels of a career-high 12 strikeouts in his final Double-A start with Altoona, where he had an ERA under 2.00 during the month of May. He began the season with the Curve, going 2-for-2 with a 3.69 ERA (22er/53.1ip) and 63 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts). Ashcraft was selected by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson (Waco, Texas) High School and had his contract first selected by the Pirates on Nov. 14.</li> <li>ABOUT THE HOMERS: The Indians' three home runs last night courtesy of Gilberto Celestino, Grant Koch and Liover Peguero were their most in a game since launching a season-high six homers on May 23 at Omaha. It was also just the fourth time this season that they have hit three or more homers in a single game (also: 4 home runs on May 19 vs. Toledo and May 21 at Iowa).</li> <li>BACK-TO-BACK: Gilberto Celestino and Grant Koch gave the Indians an early lead in the third inning last night, launching back-to-back solo home runs against Valente Bellozo. It was the second pair of back-to-back home runs by Indians batters this season, following Billy McKinney and Matt Gorski on April 6 (2) vs. Memphis. Grant Koch went back-to-back with Mason Martin on Sept. 5, 2023, vs. Toledo for his first set of back-to-back homers with Indianapolis.</li> <li>PEGUERO PEPPERS: Liover Peguero launched his third home run of the season and first since May 16 (2) vs. Toledo last night, tacking on an insurance run in the sixth inning. The solo homer was his first hit of the series and fifth in his last six games. In that stretch, he has three extra-base hits and five RBI. He hasn't gone hitless in back-to-back games since May 16 (1)-17, and in 16 games since May 19 he is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with nine runs, three doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, nine walks and a .952 OPS. <b>GRANT GOES YARD:</b> Grant Koch joined Gilberto Celestino in logging a multi-hit game with a third-inning home run. It was the catcher's second home run of the season and first since April 13 (2) at Toledo. It was also his third season-high two-hit game, following that April contest and May 18 vs. Toledo. <b>TONIGHT'S PROBABLES:</b> In the fourth game of the six-game series between the Indians and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp at 121 Financial Ballpark, the Indians will send RHP Jake Woodford (1-3, 5.26) to the mound for his first start in an Indians uniform. Woodford has made three starts vs. Jacksonville in Triple-A, going 0-2 with a 7.62 ERA (11er/13.0ip) and 11 strikeouts. Woodford began the season with Charlotte and went 1-3 with a 5.26 ERA (29er/49.2ip) and 42 strikeouts in 10 games (10 starts). His best start of the season came on May 12 at Gwinnett, when he tossed 7.0 shutout innings with a season-high tying eight strikeouts. Woodford made two starts with Chicago (AL) before being designated for assignment and released. In 73 Triple-A appearances (71 starts) since 2018, he is 19-24 with a 4.19 ERA (169er/363.0ip) and 305 strikeouts.</li> <li>AFFILIATES TO ADVERSARIES: This week marks the first time the Indians have played a team from Jacksonville since they last faced a different franchise in the International League during the 1963 season. The current Jacksonville franchise served under Indianapolis as the Double-A affiliate to the Montreal Expos from 1985-90, with a roster boasting future Hall of Famers Randy Johnson and Larry Walker before they became Indians. With the realignment of Minor League Baseball in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp moved from the Double-A Southern League to the International League.</li> <li>THIS DATE IN 1996: In front of 14,603 fans at Bush Stadium, the largest turnout at West 16th Street since 1972, the Indians won a back-and-forth affair with Oklahoma City in 10 innings, 7-6. Tim Belk opened the 10th with a single and took third on an Eduardo Perez double. Following an intentional walk and force play at the plate, Joe Kmak delivered a broken-bat infield single to short to score Perez for the winning run.
