NEWS & NOTES

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH: The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night tonight at Heritage Financial Park. The team has brought 12 Bhutanese baseball and softball players for a baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York. The athletes landed in the USA early Sunday morning, and were at the ballpark on Monday for a clinic with Renegades players and coaches, and a Business of Baseball Panel with the Renegades Front Office Staff. On Tuesday, they participated in a sightseeing tour of Dutchess County planned by Dutchess Tourism before experiencing a V.I.P. experience at the game. On Wednesday, the group will tour MLB's offices in Manhattan and receive a behind-the-scenes V.I.P. experience at Yankee Stadium before watching the Yankees play the Cleveland Guardians. ABOUT THE BBSA: The Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association was founded by **Matthew DeSantis** and **Karma Dorjee** in 2010 to build the games of baseball and softball up in the Kingdom of Bhutan. Located in the eastern edge of the Himalayas in Southeast Asia, Bhutan is home to nearly 800,000 people, with over 6,000 people playing baseball. The BBSA currently features four baseball and four softball leagues for ages 6-15, along with free grassroots clinics for individuals with any level of experience. 'GADES ARE HOT: Despite dropping the last two games to end the series with Hickory, the Renegades have won 13 of their last 19 games. On Friday, Garrett Martin hit a walk-off home run in the ninth to break a 2-2 tie. On Tuesday, Hudson Valley hit four long balls in a 13-0 win on Tuesday. Hudson Valley has won 10 of their last 13 games at Heritage Financial Park. The Renegades have a 17-6 record at home in the second half. Hudson Valley is currently in sitting first place in the SAL North, 1.5 games ahead of the Aberdeen IronBirds and Jersey Shore BlueClaws for a playoff spot with 19 games remaining in the season.

AT LAST: This week, the Renegades are playing the Wilmington Blue Rocks for the final time this season. Sunday's game will be the 30th matchup of the season between the two teams, having played four series prior to this week. This is the second series held at Heritage Financial Park, after 18 games were played at Frawley Stadium in Wilmington earlier this season. So far, the Renegades hold the advantage in the season series with a 13-10 record. After the final game of a series in June was postponed, the two teams will play seven games this week. In June, they played a eight-game series in Wilmington.

HOME COOKIN': The Renegades are currently in a stretch where they are playing 19 of their next 25 games at Heritage Financial Park. After hosting Hickory for six games, Hudson Valley continues a two-week homestand with the Wilmington Blue Rocks this week. Of their final 25 games, the Renegades will have played 19 of them at home.

PITCHING IN: Entering play on Sunday, the Renegades pitching staff sports a 3.41 ERA, not only the lowest in the South Atlantic League, but the best among all High-A teams. Hudson Valley ranks 7th among all full-season Minor League teams. Since the All-Star Break, the staff has a 2.35 ERA, which is the best in MiLB, just ahead of the Down East Wood Ducks (TEX, A), who have a 2.37 team ERA since the break. The Renegades have recorded four shutouts in the last ten games.

PITCHING REINFORCEMENTS: After being called up last week, **Josh Grosz** has been stellar for Hudson Valley. On Thursday, Grosz allowed just one hit in 5.1 scoreless frames. Grosz allowed just one hit in six scoreless innings in his return to the Renegades on Saturday, after making a spot start with the club in May. In his last five starts between Tampa and Hudson Valley, Grosz has been charged with just one earned run in 29.1 innings, good for a 0.30 ERA during that stretch. The East Carolina product was roommates in college with Renegades teammate Josh Moylan.

HEATING UP: **Antonio Gomez** have been excellent at the plate over the last two weeks. The Renegades catcher is currently riding a 14-game on-base streak, where he is 17-for-45 (.378) at the plate with seven doubles, a triple, two home run, seven RBIs, and 16 runs scored. During that stretch, Gomez has a .462 on-base percentage and a 1.173 OPS. He has boosted his average from .169 to .239 in the last 13 games.

LIMITING HITS: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 725 hits through 112 games. The Renegades have allowed the fewest hits in MiLB, 13 fewer than the Down East Wood Ducks (A, TEX) for the lowest mark. Renegades pitching is holding the opposition to a .209 batting average this season, the best in MiLB. Incredibly, the Lansing Lugnuts (OAK, A+) have allowed a staggering 1037 hits through 112 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Renegades bullpen collectively sports a 3.19 ERA (163 ER/459.2 IP) this season, the best mark in High-A and fourth-best in the minors. On Saturday, Matt Keating, Kelly Austin, and Mason Vinyard allowed just two combined hits and one run across 5.2 frames. On Friday, Hudson Valley's bullpen consisting of Indigo Diaz, Thomas Balboni, and Ocean Gabonia allowed just one total baserunner in 3.2 innings, closing out a 2-0 shutout win. In the last three games, the bullpen has allowed two earned runs in 13.1 frames, good for a 1.37 ERA.

WEST COAST ARMS: Starting pitching continues to be excellent for the Renegades. A Renegades starting pitcher has allowed more than two earned runs in a start once since July 28th. **Trent Sellers** continued his dominant form on Friday, throwing four scoreless innings while allowing just two hits and striking out four. The right-hander has an absurd 0.51 ERA in his last 35 frames dating back to June 26th, with 39 strikeouts and a .123 opposing average. Last week, Sellers was named South Atlantic Pitcher of the Month for July, holding the best ERA in MiLB (0.00) among qualified pitchers during that span. On Tuesday, **Kyle Carr** allowed just one hit in five scoreless innings while striking out five. Since the All-Star break, Carr has allowed just four earned runs in 24 innings with 25 punchouts, good for a 1.50 ERA. The southpaw has allowed just 10 combined hits in his last five starts.

THE RUNNIN' RENEGADES ARE BACK: After stealing only 13 bases in 27 games in June, the Renegades have been on a stolen base frenzy, going 44-for-51 on stolen base attempts as a team in their last 37 games.

DOUBLES MACHINES: With 208 doubles in 2024, Hudson Valley has the most doubles in High-A this season, seven more than the Everett AquaSox (+, SEA). Four Renegades have 16 or more doubles, and 10 players have ten or more two-baggers.

THE NEW GUYS: Since being called up two weeks ago, Dylan Jasso and Jackson Castillo have provided a spark at the plate. On Tuesday, the duo combined for 10 RBIs in the 13-0 win. With a three-run homer and grand slam, Castillo drove in seven runs, matching the single-game franchise record tied by Jared Serna earlier this year. Jasso was 2-for-4 with a triple, homer, and three RBIs on Wednesday. He has five extra-base hits in 10 games, and has reached base in eight of ten games he's played. Castillo is 8-for-23 with the Renegades, having reached base in six of seven games he's played. Last week, Castillo was placed on the 7-day injured list.

PIRATE POWER: **Josh Moylan** has been hot over the past three weeks. After three home runs in Wilmington in late July, he has continued to excel at the plate. In his last 14 games, Moylan is 12-for-43 (.279) with a .380 on-base percentage, 3 HR, 8 RBIs, a 535 slugging percentage and a .915 OPS

NEW BEGINNINGS: **Jace Avina** debuted with the Renegades on April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. July was a rough month for the outfielder, where he hit just .096 (7-for-72). However, August has started with a bang for Avina. He is 11-for-43 with two home runs and eight RBIs in 11 games so far this month. Last Sunday, Avina was featured as the No. 1 play on Sportscenter's "Top 10 Plays" for a home run robbery of Jersey Shore's Felix Reyes.

ROAD STRUGGLES: After losing both games of a doubleheader last Sunday, Hudson Valley is now 6-13 in its last 19 road games. The Renegades took three of the first four games on the road at Maimonides Park this week, but had to settle for a series split. Hudson Valley had just seven combined hits in the doubleheader. In the series, they only scored more than three runs twice, and scored six combined runs over the final three matchups of the set. This season, Hudson Valley is just 23-36 overall away from Heritage Financial Park this season. The 36 road losses are the most in the South Atlantic League this season. Last year, the Renegades were 41-25 on the road.

GADES THROW NO HITTER: Kyle Carr, Trent Sellers, and Hueston Morrill Renegades completed the third no-hitter in franchise history on July 19th. It was the first time since July 10, 2021 that the Renegades had thrown a no-no, and the first nine-inning no-hitter since August 10, 2000. With the score remaining tied into the bottom of the ninth, a Roc Riggio walk-off home run sealed the no-hitter and a 1-0 win.

DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT: In 20 of their last 39 games, the Renegades have played error-free. With no errors in 11 of the last 17 games, Hudson Valley is now 29-12 in games this season where they do not commit an error. The Renegades lost on Saturday despite not committing an error. They committed four errors on Wednesday night in a 7-5 loss.

LAST TIME OUT: Stuart struggled through 3.1 innings last Wednesday against the Hickory Crawdads, allowing three runs (two earned) on seven hits while walking one and striking out three. The Renegades lost 7-5 to the Crawdads while committing four errors in the field. It was the fourth straight start in which Stuart, who left with the bases loaded and one out in the top of the fourth, allowed multiple runs, and his third in his last four in which he failed to complete at least 5.0 innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster... promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on 5/23... transferred to the Renegades on 5/24.
- Threw his first quality start of the season on 5/15 vs Jersey Shore: 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K, 1 HR (two-run HR to Bryan Rincon) in front of largest crowd in Heritage Financial Park history (5,619). Stuart retired the first 11 batters he faced before an Otto Kemp single with two outs in the fourth.
- Called up to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to make a spot start on 5/23 (Game 1) vs. Syracuse, threw a complete game: W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 2 K. Joined **Sean Boyle** in 2021 as pitchers called directly up to Triple-A from the Renegades who went on to throw a complete game in a spot start (Boyle threw no-hitter at Worcester on 8/19/21).
- Allowed 10 hits on 7/13 @ Jersey Shore, first HV pitcher to allow 10+ hits in a start since Juan Carela on 4/29/23 @ Greenville.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in FCL... assigned to Tampa Tarpons on April 25... transferred to Hudson Valley on Aug. 2.
- Made his professional debut on April 30 at Jupiter: L, 4.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 5 K.
- In July with Tampa: 1-1, 1.48 ERA, 24.1 IP, 21 H, 8 R, 4 ER, 6 BB, 18 K in four starts. Lowered ERA from 5.59 to 4.00.
- Threw a quality start in three of his final four starts with Tampa before his promotion.
- Threw 100 pitches on 8/15 @ BRK, becoming the second HV pitcher in the 2023 season to throw 100+ in a game (Juan Carela, 7/2 vs Wilmington). His night ended with a 10-pitch walk worked by Jacob Reimer.
- During time with Hudson Valley vs. Jersey Shore: 13.50 ERA (15 ER/10.0 IP); vs. Others: 2.28 ERA (7 ER/27.2 IP).

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Baron Boward Stuart.
- Played collegiately for four years at the University of South Florida (2018-21) and one year at the University of Pittsburgh (2022).
- Signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent on July 21, 2022.
- Was a starting pitcher at USF, but transitioned to the bullpen at Pittsburgh. Led the Panthers with 27 appearances and seven saves, which was tied fifth in the ACC and fourth-most in a single season in program history.
- Helped lead Pitt to the semifinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time since 2018.
- Was a Nursing major at USF, majored in Communications/Cyber Security at Pitt.
- When MLB Draft Tracker Twitter account was hacked before the 2022 draft, the account tweeted out that the first overall pick of the draft was Baron Stuart.
