YESTERDAY: The Captains set a series of records (see below) in a 17-10 win over the Lansing Lugnuts. Seven different Captains turned in multi-hit performances. Brayan Rocchio, José Tena, Victor Nova and Joe Naranjo each tallied three hits, while George Valera, Aaron Bracho and Joe Donovan each had two hits. Valera and Bracho each homered. The Captains scored seven runs in the fourth and six in the eighth. Captains starter Xzavion Curry held the Lugnuts to one run over six innings to earn his third straight win. Lansing starter Richard Guasch allowed seven runs, six earned, over 3.2 innings to take the loss.

RECORD-SETTING NIGHT: The following records were set last night.

ROCCHIO REACHES: Brayan Rocchio reached base in each of his first 10 plate appearances of this series at ansing. Rocchio hit five singles, two doubles, walked once and was hit by two pitches before he bounced into a fielder's choice in his final plate appearance on Wednesday. Rocchio made it on base all seven times he batted on Wednesday if you include the fielder's choice (which does not count as him "reaching base" statistically because an out was recorded). Rocchio has a .909 on-base percentage during the series.

ROCCHIO ON A ROLL: Brayan Rocchio is on an eight-game hitting streak, during which he has hit .457/.537/.600 (1.137 OPS). Rocchio has five multi-hit games during the streak, including a four-hit game on July 13 at Lansing. In the month of July, Rocchio is hitting .362/.455/.468 (.923 OPS).

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan has led off two games with a home run in the last week. He hit a home run on the first pitch of the game at Fort Wayne on Wednesday, July 7 and homered on the fifth pitch of last night's game at Lansing. Brennan enters today third in the High-A Central League (HAC) with 18 doubles, sixth in patting average (.290), seventh in hits (58), ninth in extra-base hits (23), 14th in on-base percentage (.370) tied for 14th in total bases (90).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 14-22 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.89 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a 15-game on-base streak. Over the last 15 games (since June 24), Lavastida is hitting .429/.469/.750 (1.219 OPS) with four homers and six doubles. Lavastida has seven multi-hit games during that span, including three three-hit performances.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: George Valera and Joe Naranjo have both increased their walk-rate recently. Valera walked at an 8.9% rate in June, but has walked at a 15.4% rate in July. Naranjo walked at a 7.6% rate in May, but has walked at a 11.5% rate since the start of June.

**LAST TIME OUT:** In his last start with Low-A Lynchburg, Espino lasted a season-low three innings and tied a career-high with four walks in a loss at the Carolina Mudcats (Low-A; Brewers). Espino surrendered two runs on one hit and struck out three in a 4-2 defeat at Five Counties Stadium.

PROSPECTING: Espino ranks as Cleveland's #5 prospect according to FanGraphs, #6 by MLB.com and #9 by Baseball America

**TOP PICK:** Cleveland drafted Espino with their first round pick (24th overall) in the 2019 MLB Draft. The right-hander earned a \$2.5 million signing bonus. He was committed to play at Louisiana State University before signing with Cleveland.

**SCOUTING REPORT:** "Espino works at 94-97 mph and can touch triple digits with his fastball, imparting running life on his four-seamer and heavy sink on his two-seamer. He backs up his heat with a pair of batmissing breaking balls, with his low-80s slider sharper and grading better than his high-70s curveball. His changeup is more of a work in progress that gets too firm at times but also features some promising sink." (Source: <a href="MLB.com">MLB.com</a>)

SCOUTING GRADES: Fastball – 70; Slider – 60; Curveball – 55; Changeup – 50; Control – 50; Overall – 50 (Source: *MLB.com*)

PANAMA → GEORGIA: Espino was born and grew up in Panama, but moved to the United States when he was a sophomore in high school and pitched for Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, GA. As Mandy Bell wrote in her <u>MLB.com</u> article on <u>Espino</u>, Espino spent time in the U.S. for baseball when he was 10 and decided then that he wanted to move there. When Daniel was 15, he went to his parents and told them he needed to move to the United States to pursue his baseball dreams. When asked about his decision to move to the U.S., Espino said "My mom and dad wanted me to finish high school first and then worry about the next, but I love playing baseball. I had the opportunity to [visit America] when I was 10 years old and I loved it. Now, the sacrifice is paying off (Source: <u>The Record-Courier</u>).

PANAMANIAN ROLE MODEL: Espino idolized Panamanian star and Hall of Fame closer Mariano Rivera as a child.

**FIRST SINCE FRANCISCO:** When he advanced to Mahoning Valley in 2019, Espino became the first high schooler promoted by Cleveland to the Short Season level since Francisco Lindor in 2011.

**2020:** Pitched at Classic Park, which was Cleveland's alternate training site, before doing remote development prior to the fall instructional league. Espino did not pitch at instructs due to a minor shoulder injury (Source: *FanGraphs*).

**2019:** Made his professional debut in the Rookie Level Arizona League and posted a 1.98 ERA before being bumped up to Short Season Mahoning Valley. Espino posted a 6.30 ERA with the Scrappers over three starts. Though he made nine starts and did not make any relief appearances, Espino never pitched more than four innings in a single professional game during his debut season.
