GAME INFORMATION

2025 MLB ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: RHP **Jonah Tong** and OF **Carson Benge** both represented the New York Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game on Saturday at Truist Park in Atlanta. Tong took the mound for the second inning and recorded one strikeout in a perfect inning. Benge went 0-for-1 with a flyout and came off the bench to play left field. Tong, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 59 prospect, has spent the entire season with Binghamton and leads Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts in 78.2 innings, while holding 6-4 record and a 1.83 ERA in 15 starts. Benge, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 prospect, was promoted to Double-A on June 23.

JOANDERFUL: RHP **Joander Suarez** is slated to make his 14th Double-A appearance and 12th start for Binghamton this season. Suarez earned the win and recorded five strikeouts, while allowing three runs over five innings in the series opener against Altoona on Tuesday. Suarez has earned the win in each of his last three starts and in that span, the 25-year-old is 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA, 17 strikeouts, and just two walks across 17 innings pitched with a .172 BAA.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Altoona Curve, 4-1, on Saturday at Mirabito Stadium and snapped their six-game win streak. CF **Jett Williams** (3-for-5, 2B, K, SB) recorded his second-straight three-hit game. LF **D'Andre Smith** (1-for-4, RBI, K) hit an RBI single in the first inning. RHP **Jack Wenninger** (L, 5 IP, 3 H, 4 ER, 3 BB, 7 K) took the loss. Former Rumble Ponies RHP Wilkin Ramos recorded his fifth save of the season for Altoona.

THE JETT: SS/CF **Jett Williams**, the Mets' No. 1 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 45 overall prospect, went 3-for-5 with a 2B and SB on Saturday. He recorded his second-straight three-hit game and is 6-for-10 with 2 HR, 3 RBI, 2 R, 2B, 2 SB. Williams recorded the second multi-home run game of his professional career on Friday, with the first coming at Richmond on June 11 against RHP Manuel Mercedes. Williams had not homered since his multi-HR game on June 11, until he hit two bombs on July 11. Williams holds two of Binghamton's four multi-HR efforts this season, along with Kevin Parada and Ryan Clifford. The 21-year-old ranks among Double-A: 24 2B (T-1st), 5 3B (T-2nd most), 37 XBH (T-2nd), .894 OPS (4th), 498 (4th), 51 R (T-6th), .396 OBP (9th). Williams ranks among the Eastern League: 2B (T-1st), OPS (2nd), SLG (2nd), 37 XBH (T-2nd), 5 3B (T-2nd), R (3rd), OBP (3rd), 26 SB (4th), 48 BB (4th), .289 AVG (5th), 80 H (T-5th).

KEVIN!!!: C **Kevin Parada** went 3-for-4 with an RBI, R, and two doubles on Friday, which marked his second three-hit game of the series and over his last three games played. Over his last 18 games, Parada is hitting .354 (23-for-65) with a .956 OPS, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 10 R, 9 2B, 11 XBH. Parada had his first three-hit game of the season on May 16 at Hartford and since then ranks among Double-A: .568 SLG (2nd), .950 OPS (4th), .320 AVG (7th) and among the Eastern League: OPS (2nd), SLG (2nd), AVG (4th), 7 HR (T-6th), .382 OBP (8th). Parada was drafted by the Mets with the 11th overall pick in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Georgia Tech.

MORABITO MAGIC: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets' No. 16 prospect, is riding a six-game hit streak (7 H, 2 RBI, 3 R, 4 BB, 2 SB). Morabito ranks among AA: 33 SB (2nd), 23 2B (T-2nd), 85 H (T-10th) and among the Eastern League: SB (2nd), 2B (T-3rd), .290 AVG (4th), H (4th), 48 R (5th), 43 RBI (7th), 29 XBH (T-9th), .362 OBP (10th). This season, Morabito has set career highs in RBI, 2B, XBH, and tied a career high in HR.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect, blasted 2 HR (3-run HR & grand slam) and recorded a career-high 7 RBIs on Tuesday. Clifford has hit 4 HR and driven in 12 runs over his last nine games. Over his last 31 games, since June 6, Clifford has produced a .941 OPS, 9 HR, 24 RBI, 19 R, 6 2B, 16 XBH, 21 BB. Clifford ranks T-2nd with Kyle Fedko (Wichita, MIN) in Double-A with 17 HR, behind Brock Wilken (18 - Biloxi, MIL) and also ranks among AA with 54 RBI (T-4th), 50 BB (T-6th), 32 XBH (T-5th). The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: HR (1st), RBI (3rd), BB (3rd), XBH (T-4th), .820 OPS (8th), .470 SLG (9th).

WINNING: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are 57-27 overall this season and are 30 games above .500. Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.679) in Double-A and holds the second-best winning percentage in Minor League Baseball, behind High-A Greensboro (.694) (PIT). Binghamton is on pace for 92 wins this season, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013).

JACK ATTACK: RHP **Jack Wenninger**, the Mets' No. 27 prospect (MLB Pipeline), made his 17th start of Saturday and recorded seven strikeouts over five innings in the loss. Wenninger ranks 5th in Minor League Baseball with 107 strikeouts. The 23-year-old ranks among Double-A with 107 strikeouts (2nd), 8 wins (T-2nd most), 86.2 IP (T-6th), and a 1.07 WHIP (10th). RHP Jonah Tong (125 Ks) and Wenninger are the top 2 strikeout leaders in Double-A, respectively.

LAST START: Suarez earned the win for the third-straight start and recorded five strikeouts over five innings, while allowing three runs on six hits and two walks against Altoona in the series opener on Tuesday, July 8, at Mirabito Stadium...Suarez allowed three runs over the first two frames and settled in well finishing with three scoreless innings and retiring nine batters straight at one point.

2025 SEASON: Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed just two hits in the win at Hartford on July 2...Recorded season-high-tying 8 Ks in season-high 6.0 IP against Portland on June 26...Transferred back to Double-A Binghamton on May 20...Made start for Triple-A Syracuse on May 17 vs. Lehigh-Valley and earned the win (5.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 3 K) in his best start at the level and second-career win...Transferred back to Binghamton on May 3...Did not allow a run over first three appearances and was transferred to Triple-A Syracuse to start on May 1...Began the season with Double-A Binghamton.

LAST SEASON: Made 25 appearances and 23 starts across Double-A Binghamton (23) and Triple-A Syracuse (2) and went 10-6 with a 4.49 ERA and 124 strikeouts in 128.1 innings...Finished the season with two starts for Triple-A Syracuse and went 1-1, while allowing 12 runs over nine innings...Transferred to Triple-A Syracuse on August 29...Made 23 appearances and 21 starts for Double-A Binghamton and went 9-5 with a 3.92 ERA and 118 strikeouts in 119.1 innings...Suarez finished 2nd in the Eastern League in WHIP (1.14), 6th in ERA (3.92), T-6th in wins (9), and 8th in opponent batting average (.240)...Began the season with Double-A Binghamton.
