CALAZ CONTINUES CRACKING SHELLS: Robert Calaz is hitting .385 with 5 homers against Modesto this year. Calaz smashed his fifth homer of the series on Saturday, hitting a 377 ft moonshot onto the Growlafornia building.

PIVOTAL POINT: The Grizzlies are playing their ninth home game out of their last 12 contests and will play 15 of 18 at Chukchansi Park before the All-Star Break next week. The Grizzlies are 7-4 in that stretch so far against North Division foes. They will return to action after the break with 9 straight games on the road against the same two rivals they've played already, traveling to Stockton and Modesto.

BIG CAT VS. MODESTO: Everett Catlett makes his fourth start of the season against Modesto on Sunday. The Grizzlies are 3-0 in his starts so far this year against the Nuts as he has allowed three total runs, but just one earned, in 17 innings. Catlett struck out 8 in six strong innings in Tuesday's win at John Thurman Field.
