ROAD WARRIORS: After splitting two close games in the first two of this series with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, the FredNats continue this long road trip with game three against MB. Top pitching prospect Travis Sykora will make his third start of his professional career, looking to build on a strong start last week in Charleston. Sykora, the Nationals' third round pick last summer out of Round Rock HS in Texas, pitched four innings last time out, giving up a weird two-run homer on a part of the Charleston ballpark that's in play but ruled a home run on the ground rules. Sykora faces MB righty Kenten Egbert. FXBG became the first Carolina League team this year to cross the 200-run threshold in yesterday's 6-5 loss to the Pelicans.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Both offenses got off to a quick start, combining for four home runs in the first three innings of the game. FXBG got homers from Caleb Farmer and Brandon Pimentel to tie the game at three in the first, and then the Pelicans added on two single runs in the middle innings to take a 5-3 lead. Fredericksburg got a sacrifice fly from Cristhian Vaquero in the 7th to make it 5-4, and then an RBI double in the 9th by Nate Ochoa tied the game at 5. Myrtle Beach ended up manufacturing a run in the bottom of the 9th to give the Pelicans the walk-off win, which marks the first time this year FXBG lost on a walk-off.

**BULLPEN WORK:** So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. After allowing just one run in 10.1 IP this series, the bullpen has pitched 184.1 innings this year and allowed just 44 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.15. The Freddies are also 12/13 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League with seven saves. The unit has also danced out of trouble time and time again on this road trip. In all five wins this trip, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 16-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 wins in a row prior to Tuesday night. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday, and Tuesday night against Myrtle Beach was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

**FORMULA CONTINUED**: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 23 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .251 with RISP, compared to .109 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs, and then followed it up with a 6-for-23 peformance in the first two games of this series with the Pelicans.

**HE'S BACK**: 2021/22 FredNat Jeremy De La Rosa burst back onto the scene last week with the FredNats on a rehab assignment after injuring the AC joint in his shoulder during spring training. In his first game action in 2024, De La Rosa went 8-for-17 with four doubles, two triples and three RBI, including the game-winning RBI in the 10th inning of Saturday's game.

**ANOTHER PROMOTION:** Prior to Tuesday's game, RHP Jose Atencio was promoted to High-A Wilmington. Atencio was one of the best starting pitchers in the Carolina League, posting a 31/1 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 28 innings for Fredericksburg. He is the only FredNat pitcher this year to reach the sixth inning of a start as he battled the RiverDogs through six tough innings last Thursday. Atencio was promoted to Fredericksburg in July of 2022 and now gets the call to Wilmington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 164-132 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Travis Sykora is making his third professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Sykora is working on an extra day of rest, after the rotation was shuffled following the promotion of Jose Atencio to Wilmington.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

**QUICK CLIMBER:** Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during last week's series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sykora looked sharper in his second pro start, firing 3.2 innings against the RiverDogs, while allowing two earned runs and walking just one batter.
