### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils open up the second half of the season at Richmond. It is the first-of-six games against the Flying Squirrels this season and the opener of six games at The Diamond, the final six games Reading will ever play at The Diamond. Richmond captured the 2024 series over Reading 5-1. The Flying Squirrels don't return to Reading this season and have not played at FirstEnergy Stadium since June 28-July 3, of the 2023 season.

### Game 67 Recap

The Fightin Phils closed out the first half with a 9-1 defeat to Hartford on Sunday, dropping the series. 4-2. Estibenzon Jimenez started and allowed six runs on seven hits over five innings, in his Double-A debut. After two-scoreless innings from Gunner Mayer in relief, Travis Kuhn surrendered three-more runs to Hartford to put the game out of reach. Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two hits, and Caleb Ricketts had two-more base knocks. Leandro Pineda, Robert Moore and Cade Fergus all doubled in the loss.

### New Half, Clean Slate

Following Sunday's conclusion of the first half, the Fightin Phils record resets to 0-0 with the second half starting on Tuesday night. Reading finished the first half with a 25-42 record, last in the Northeast Division. This marks the second time in three years, that the R-Phils will open up the second half against Richmond, as the teams opened the second half in 2023. It's also the third time in six halves that Reading and Richmond will begin a half against each other, as the Fightin Phils were in Richmond to open up the 2023 season.

### The Lights Were Bright on Saturday Night

On Saturday night, Reading set season highs in: hits (17), doubles (8) and extra-base hits (10). They tied season-highs in runs (12), hits in an inning (5) and margin of victory (10). Reading's 17 hits were its most in a game since having 17 base knocks in back-to-back games on May 5-6, 2023, at Hartford. All nine member of the starting lineup had a hit on Saturday, which was the first time that's happened since July 24, 2024, at New Hampshire. The last time the R-Phils had eight doubles in a game was June 29, 2018, and it was just the fourth time they've have eight-plus doubles in a game since 2005. Additionally, Reading's last time with 10-plus extra-base hits in a game was July 8, 2016.

### Hendry Making History

It is believed that Hendry Mendez hit for the first cycle in R-Phils history on Friday night. Mendez had four hits, three runs and three RBI. He hit a triple in his first at bat, then singled his next time up. Mendez then launched his fifth home run of the season in the sixth inning. Then, Mendez stepped up in the bottom of the eighth a double shy of the cycle, and he lined a 3-1 pitch to right-center field and stopped at second base to complete the historic feat. Dating back to 2005 (as far back as MLB's research tool keeps MiLB stats), no R-Phil has hit a cycle. Records prior to 2005 show no prior cycles were ever hit by an R-Phil, but data is incomplete. But, it is believed that Mendez now holds the distinction of the first cycle in R-Phils history, dating back to 1967.

### Hammering Homers and Triples

The Fightin Phils have launched 23 home runs since the start of June. That is a mark that is tied for themost in the Eastern League with Somerset. Reading ranks tied for fourth in the league in home runs this season with 56. Since the start of June, the Fightin Phils have hit seven triples, a mark that is tied for first in the Eastern League over that stretch. Since the start of June, Hendry Mendez has hit three triples, a mark tied for first in the Eastern League over that span.

### On the Move

With the secpnd half begining on Tuesday, the Philadelphia Phillies announced some additions to the Reading Fightin Phils roster. 22-year old Dylan Campbell was promoted from Jersey Shore (A+). Campbell posted a .221/.302/.390 (.692 OPS) slash line, with 30 runs, 11 doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 35 RBI. After a slow start to the season, Campbell has slashed .323/.389/.516 (.905 OPS) in June. The Phillies acquired Campebell in a trade with the Dodgers in January. Additionally, Jose Rodriguez re-joins the Fightin Phils on Tuesday. Rodriguez played 38 games for Reading in 2024 before being placed on the ineligible list on June 4, 2024. Rodriguez re-signed with hte Phillies on June 5 and appeared in 11 games with Clearwater (A) before re-joining Reading.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 24, 1875:** The Reading Actives beat the Wilmington Quicksteps, 18-8, in Reading. Wilmington players are stoned by rabid Reading fans on their way to the train station.

### Rolling into Richmond

Richmond finished the first half of the season with an Eastern League-worst 21-46 record. The Flying Squirrels took four-of-five games at Altoona last week in the Trey Wilson bowl to finish the half. Following this week, Richmond remains home and hosts Chesapeake for three games before hitting the road to continue the series with the Baysox. Richmond's roster features five of the Giants' top-30 prospects: Joe Whitman (6), Diego Velasquez (15), Aeverson Arteaga (16), Sabin Ceballos (23) and Jack Choate (27).

### Goat on the Bump

Righty Manuel Mercedes makes the start tonight for Richmond. Over 13 starts, Mercedes is 3-7, with a 7.36 ERA (42 ER, 51.1 IP). Mercedes suffered the loss on June 18 at Altoona, allowing two runs on eight hits over six innings, with three strikeouts. He spent all of last season with Eugene (A+), going 4-9, with a 5.28 ERA over 26 appearances and 25 starts. Mercedes spent 2022 and '23 with San Jose (A) and began his pro career in 2021 with the ACL-Giants (ROK). The 22-year old was signed as an International Free Agent in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.

**LAST START:** 6/18 vs HFD: L, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 0 HR, 1 BB, 8 SO, 92 pitches (66 strikes)... The Fightin Phils lost to Hartford, 3-0, at FirstEnergy Stadium. Cabrera surpassed 90 pitches for the third time this season and allowed a season-high seven hits, along with three runs. He honed back in on his control with just one walk and matched a season-high with eight strikeouts. Cabrera posted a zero in four-of-five innings and the only damage came on three runs in the top of the third inning when he allowed four hits in the frame. Cabrera was relieved by Gunner Mayer in the top of the sixth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- Lone win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- Season-high six innings on three occasions: Apr. 22 at Portland, May 8 at Binghamton and June 6 at Harrisburg
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
- Issued season-low one walk in three-straight starts: May 25 at POR, May 31 vs ERI and June 6 at HBG; issued one walk again on June 18 vs Hartford
- Posted seven strikeouts June 6 at Harrisburg, which was tied for his second-most in a game this season
- Matched season-high with eight strikeouts June 18 vs Hartford, also allowed season-high seven hits and ultimately suffered loss, but surrendered just three runs
- Over seven home games, has a 3.82 ERA (15 ER, 35.1 IP), compared to 4.18 ERA (15 ER, 32.1 IP) across five away contests
- Holding RHH to .176/.276/.232 (.508 OPS) slash line
- Wish RISP, opposing hitters are slashing .174/.256/.261 (.517 OPS)
- Entering play on Tuesday, Cabrera is fifth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (67), third in IP (67.2) and tied for fourth in average against (.206)
- Entering play on Tuesday, has allowed the most walks in the Eastern League (37)
- Since May 25 (five starts/26.1 IP) has allowed 49th most walks in the league (7)

- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)
