- Turned in a career-long outing on June 28 of last season while visiting the Wilmington Blue Rocks... took the loss however after allowing five runs in a 7-4 loss.
- His 0.94 WHIP over his final eight starts with Single-A Tampa was the lowest of any qualified pitchers in the Florida State League from June 5 - August 3, 2024... led the league in innings pitched (44.2) in that span, in addition to being second in ERA (1.81) and BAA (.192).
