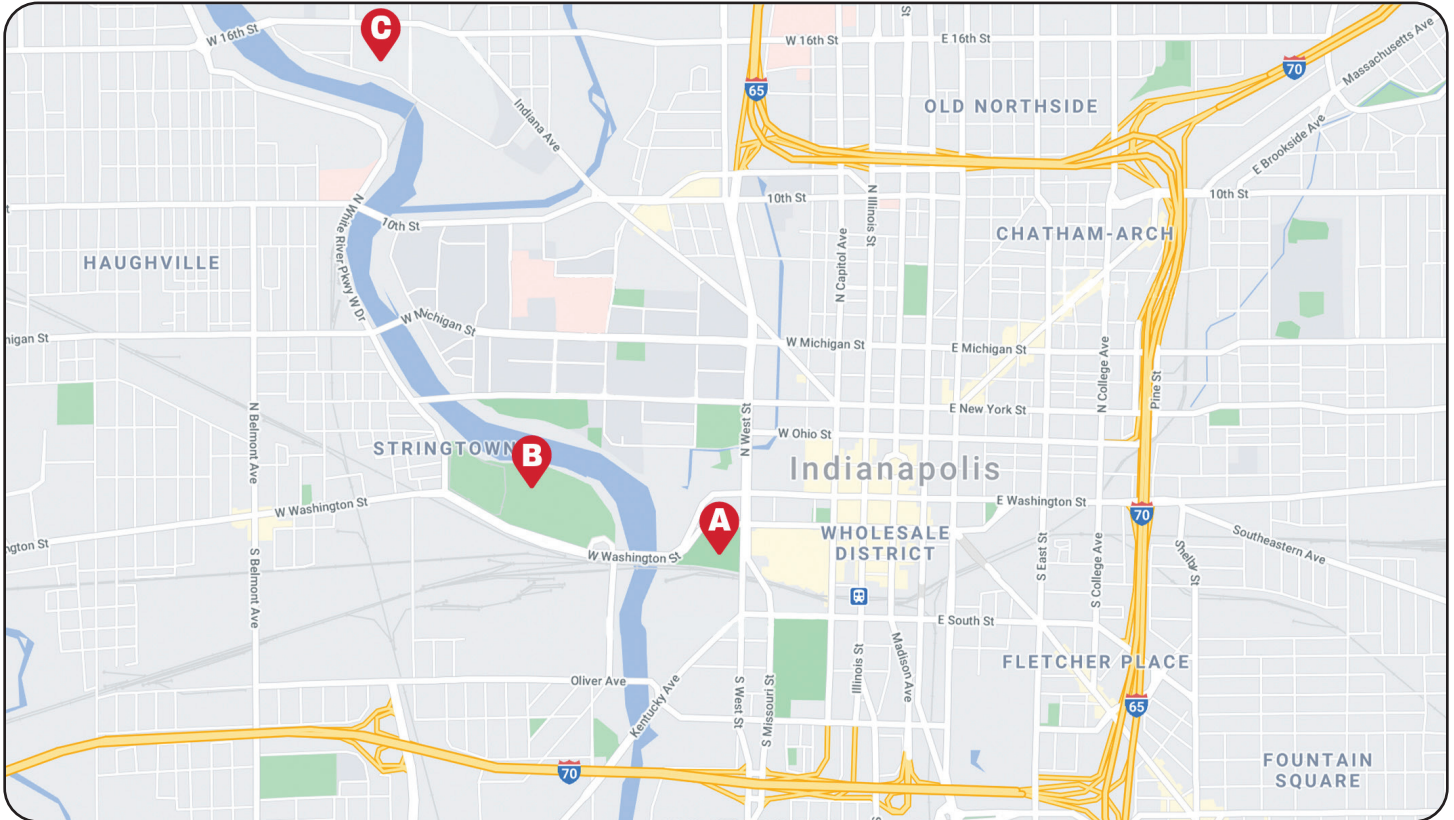


INDIANAPOLIS NEGRO LEAGUES BALLPARKS OF INDIANAPOLIS

Washington Park

In 1905, as baseball was growing in Indianapolis, Washington Park was built as the new home of the Indianapolis Indians. On May 2, 1920, the first game of the Negro National League was played there, and for the next six years it would be home to the Indianapolis ABCs. The Indians played at Washington Park for 26 years, and the final game was hosted on August 19, 1931.

(Old) Victory Field

Renamed Victory Field from Perry Stadium, this ballpark was home to the Indianapolis Indians under that name from 1942 until Aug. 30, 1967. Victory Field was also home to the Indianapolis Clowns, and featured some of the greatest names in Negro Leagues baseball, including legendary ballplayer Hank Aaron. The name of the park changed again from Victory Field to Bush Stadium in 1967 and remained that until the Indians moved in 1996.

(New) Victory Field

In the late 1990s, the Indianapolis Indians moved from Bush Stadium to brand-new Victory Field and have called it home since. This stadium held its first game on July 11, 1996 and has since been home to endless laughs, popcorn and Indians victories. It celebrates its 25th anniversary this year.



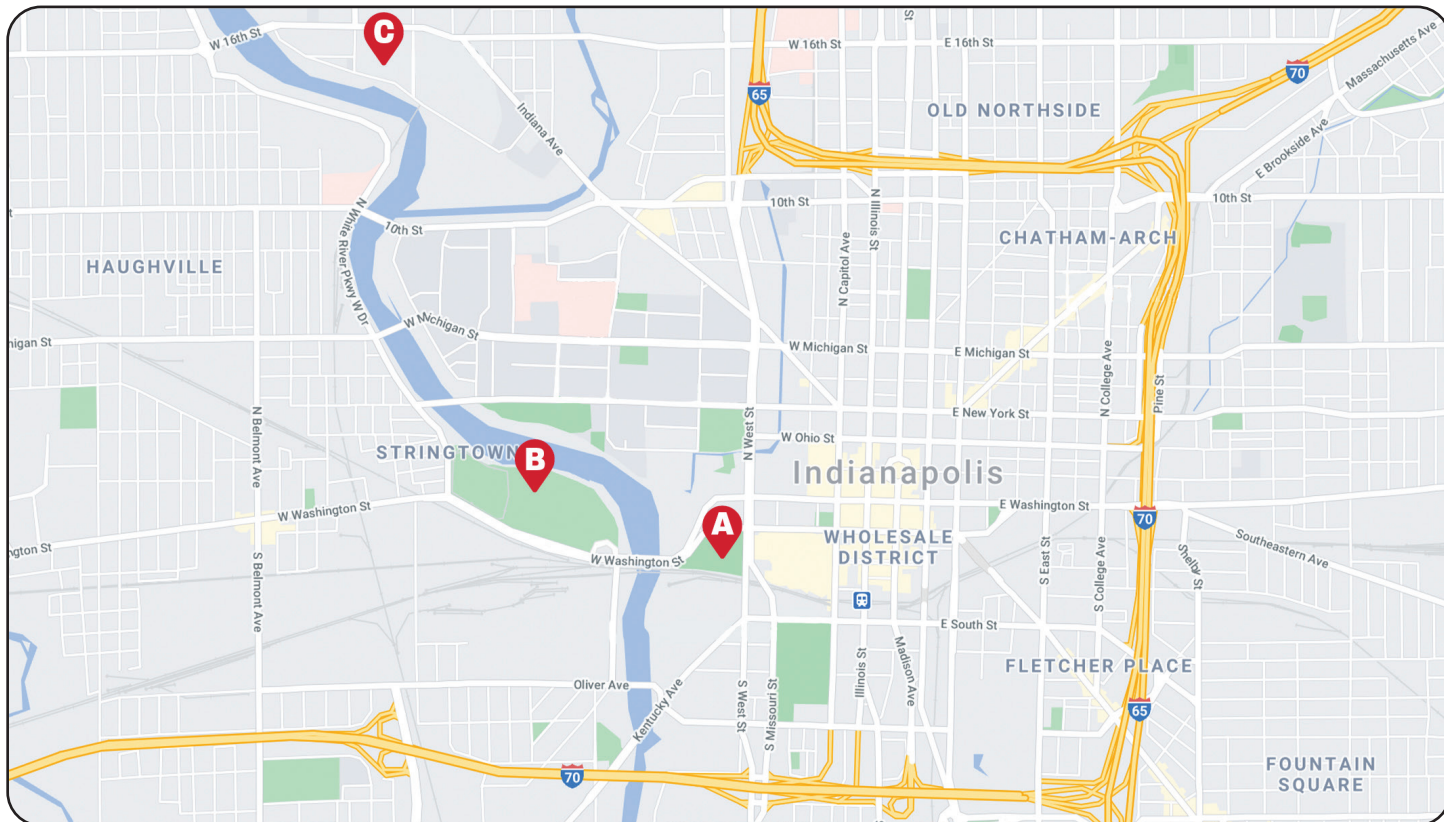
