HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

The Shuckers enter today with 13 home runs, tied for the most in the Southern League and tied for the 2nd-most in Double-A... The 13 home runs are the most through 9 games in franchise history (since 2015) and tied for the 3rd-most in the Southern League in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

The Shuckers enter today with 66 walks through 9 games, the most in Double-A... During last week's series against the Blue Wahoos, the Shuckers drew 47 walks, the 2nd-most among all teams in Minor League Baseball.

☞ The Shuckers drew 32 walks against the Blue Wahoos bullpen during last week's series, a 22% rate... The Southern League walk-rate entering today is 14%.

I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHER'S LIVES A NIGHTMARE

Over his current 7-game hit streak **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** is 13-for-29 (.448) with a home run, a double, 2 triples, 6 walks and 7 balls in play at 100+ MPH.

☞ Made enters today among the Southern League leaders in hits (1st, 14), triples (T-1st, 2), extra-base hits (T-4th, 4), average (6th, .359), OPS (6th, 1.008), stolen bases (T-6th, 4), RBI (T-6th, 8) and OBP (9th, .444).

SPEED? I AM SPEED

The Shuckers enter today with 29 stolen bases, tied for the most in the Double-A... The Shuckers have recorded 24 stolen bases in 6 games during last week's series, the 3rd-most in Minor League Baseball.

☞ The Shuckers had 3 games with at least 6 stolen bases during last week's series against Pensacola, marking the 12th, 13th and 14th games in franchise history (since 2015) with 6+ stolen bases... Prior to last week, the Shuckers had never recorded at least 6 stolen bases 3 times in a single season.

BEST OF THE BEST

1B BLAKE BURKE was named the No. 10 first base prospect by *MLB Pipeline* on Monday, and was also named to the *MLB Pipeline* Prospect Team of the Week... During last week's series against Pensacola, Burke went 8-for-26 with a double and 3 home runs.

☞ Entering today, Burke leads all Double-A players with 6 home runs... Burke is 1 of 2 Double-A players with at least 4 home runs... Burke has more home runs than 6 Double-A teams.

☞ Since his Southern League debut on August 2, 2025, Burke leads Minor League Baseball with 17 home runs and is 1 of 3 players with at least 15 over that span.

☞ Last Thursday, Burke became the 1st Double-A player in the Digital Stats Era to record 6 home runs in a team's first 6 games.

MILLIONS OF PEACHES, PEACHES FOR ME

Today marks the first of 24 games between the Shuckers and Clingstones in the first half... Last season, the Shuckers tied 14-10 against the Clingstones, including a 9-3 record at Synovus Park... Standouts included **1B BLAKE BURKE** (6g, 10-for-24, 3 2b, 2hr) and **C MATTHEW WOOD** (9g, 10-for-34, 2 2b, 2hr, 5bb, 3sb).

MR. CONSISTENCY

2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE (11-for-30) enters today as 1 of 5 players in the Southern League with an active hit streak of at least 7 games and 1 of 3 players on the Shuckers roster.

☞ The 8-game streak marks O'Rae's longest hit streak at the Double-A level and the 2nd-longest of his career... His career-long streak is 9 consecutive games between July 3-18, 2023, with the ACL Brewers.

RUNS? WHAT ARE THOSE?

RHP TANNER GILLIS tied his career-high with 5.0 shutout innings in relief on Friday... Gillis retired 14 consecutive batters to begin the outing and 15 of 16 batters faced.

☞ Gillis has recorded 7.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to April 4, 2026, the longest streak by a Shucker pitcher this season.

PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

☞ The 4 are: **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7, No. 96 overall), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESÚS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

☞ Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (33 AB), Kevin McGonigle (59 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (61 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

☞ After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 50 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,450 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ (1-0, 1.59) makes his 2nd start of the season and his 1st career start against the Clingstones... In his Keesler Federal Park debut on April 8, Rodriguez allowed 1 run and struck out 5 over 5.1 innings... Across 2 Double-A starts, Rodriguez has held right-handed batters to 5-for-27 (.185) with 8 strikeouts.
