AMARILLO WALKS OFF FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell on a walk-off home run to the Amarillo Sod Poodles 5-3 on Saturday night from HODGETOWN. With the game tied at 3-3 in the bottom of the ninth inning, Sod Poodles (10-7, 42-44) nine-hole hitter Jean Walters cracked a two-run walk-off home run against RoughRiders (6-11, 44-41) reliever **Josh Mollerus** (1-2). Amarillo reliever Jhosmer Alvarez (4-2) took home the win, throwing three shutout innings from the bullpen. The RoughRiders initially grabbed the lead in the second when **Frainyer Chavez** clubbed a two-run homer to make it 2-0. It was Chavez's third long ball of the season and his second in Amarillo this year. The Sod Poodles answered back in the bottom of the third when Manuel Peña cracked a three-run go-ahead shot against **Mitch Bratt** to push themselves ahead 3-2. Bratt threw five innings, allowing three runs on eight hits while striking out seven and walking one in his start. Frisco struck back in the sixth inning when **Abimelec Ortiz** scored on a throwing error in the top of the sixth to tie the game at 3-3 before the eventual walk-off loss.

ABIMELECTRIC IN AMARILLO:

Abimelec Ortiz homered again in Amarillo on Wednesday. Head-to-head against Amarillo, Ortiz has 11 home runs against the Sod Poodles while batting .267/.344/.548/.892 with 27 RBIs in 34 games. At HODGETOWN, he has been even better, hitting .297 (22-for-86)/.395/.608/1.003 with seven home runs and 15 RBIs in 18 games. His seven homers are the most by a visiting player at Amarillo in the last two seasons and more than all but seven Amarillo players in HODGETOWN as well.

K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 19 games, he is hitting .397 (27-for-68)/.481/.485/.966 with six doubles, five RBIs, 10 walks, 10 runs scored and just six strikeouts. In July, he is batting .406 (13-for-32) over nine games, which is second in the league.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 53 games since May 7th, he is batting .275/.342/.475/.817 with 15 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 17 games, he is slashing .310/.367/.577/.944 with five doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:

Starting pitcher **Mitch Bratt** has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is third in the league in ERA (2.73) while leading the league with 98 strikeouts this season. He is also eighth in innings (79.0), second in WHIP (1.13), first in strikeout rate (30.4 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), first in left on base rate (82.7 percent) and first in swinging strike rate (14.0). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.54 is second in all of Minor League Baseball.

SWIPE CITY:

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 16 of their last 18 games. Over those 18 games, they have stolen 30 total bases, which is third in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is tied for the league lead with eight steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is fourth with six. Overall this season, the Riders are tied for fifth in the league with 98 stolen bases.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 57. They also have just committed just 39 errors in their last 62 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 53 double plays turned since May 1st are also second in the league. Their 56 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Against the best stolen base team in the league in Arkansas, Frisco allowed seven stolen bases over the six games, below the Travelers' season-average of 11 per series.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (eight) for the Riders, a mark that second in the Texas League. Their 27 saves are tied for the most in Double-A. Their 4.25 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239. but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 128 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

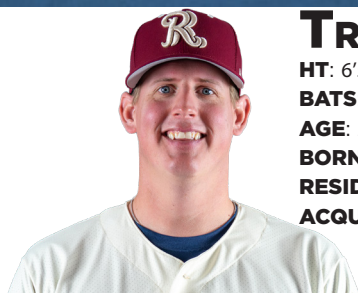

ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
