YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 5-3, to earn a series split. Akron opened a 2-0 lead in the first with a two-run homer by Johnathan Rodriguez. In the bottom of the first, Carter Aldrete brought in a run with a groundout and Andy Thomas drove a two-out, RBI single to tie the game, 2-2. The RubberDucks took a 3-2 lead in the eighth after a run scored on an error. In the bottom of the eighth, Marco Luciano tied the game, 3-3, with a leadoff homer. Later in the inning, Aldrete and Thomas hit back-to-back solo homers to give the Flying Squirrels a 5-3 lead. Mason Black started and allowed two runs, both in the first, over four innings with five strikeouts. Richmond relievers Juan Sanchez, Randy Rodriguez and Raymond Burgos combined for five innings without allowing an earned run.

TÜDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the first of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first set in Binghamton since 2019. That year, Richmond swept a three-game set at NYSEG Stadium from June 21-23. Since 2017, the Flying Squirrels are 7-2 in Binghamton. They have won three consecutive road series in Binghamton, going 2-1 in 2017, 2-1 in 2018 and 3-0 in 2019. The last series loss for Richmond in Binghamton was a three-game sweep from June 24-26, 2016. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, 2021, but it was canceled. This year, the Flying Squirrels are 5-2 in series openers, but have lost their last two in Erie and against Akron. Richmond is 3-0 against teams from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are back in first place in the Southwest Division, a half-game ahead of Erie. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 11-of-their-last-17 falling to .500 for the first time this season before picking wins in the final two games of the series against Akron. The Richmond pitching staff is second in the Eastern League in ERA (3.58). The Flying Squirrels have a 2.82 bullpen ERA this year, which is the best in the minors.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have alternated wins and losses over each of their last six games and split last week's series in New Hampshire. After starting the season 11-10, the Rumble Ponies have gone 6-11 in their last 17 games. Binghamton's .216 team batting average is the lowest in the Eastern League. Their 4.90 team ERA is ninth in the league and their 5.94 bullpen ERA is last. Binghamton's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 11), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 12), RHP Junior Santos (No. 20) and RHP Luis Moreno (No. 24). Jose Peroza is rated as the organization's best defensive infielder. MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list includes RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 7), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 9) and RHP Junior Santos (No. 17).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his eighth start of the season and the second of his career against the Rumble Ponies. Teng last pitched on Wednesday against the RubberDucks and allowed three runs (two earned) over 3.2 innings with six strikeouts. Today marks his first start this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division. In the Eastern League, Teng is ranked sixth in strikeouts (42). He is currently ranked sixth in Richmond franchise history with 211 career strikeouts and first with 11.6 K/9 IP (min. 100 IP). Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Junior Santos makes his eighth Double-A start. He last pitched last Wednesday at New Hampshire and worked 1.2 innings, allowing two runs on two hits and three walks. In his previous start on May 10, he had his best outing of the year, working six innings and allowing two runs against the Yard Goats. Santos signed with the Mets at age 16 in 2017 out of the Dominican Republic. After suffering a broken foot in 2020, Santos spent the 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 6-6 with a 4.59 ERA in 21 games. Last year, he pitched for the High-A Brooklyn Cyclones and made 26 appearances (23 starts), going 8-13 with a 4.47 ERA. Santos is rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Mets prospect.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete has homered three times over his last five games and driven in seven runs. In his last 13 games since May 6, he is batting .300 (15-for-50) with four homers, four doubles and nine RBIs. For the season, Aldrete is ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 23 RBIs. He hit a go-ahead, solo homer in Sunday's finale against Akron.

LUCY, 1'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On May 4, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Last Wednesday against Akron, he hit his third Double-A homer and tied a career high with four RBIs. On Sunday, he hit a solo homer in the eighth to tie the score in the Flying Squirrels' late comeback win. He has reached base in 11-of-his-14 games started this season.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night and added his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a three-run shot to center.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated Wade Meckler last Wednesday and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. This year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.430) and ranks 10th in OBP (.473). He began the season with High-A Eugene and hit .456 in 20 games. He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 regular-season games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked eighth in batting average (.304). Ismael Munguia is ranked 10th in batting average (.300) and seventh in hits (39). Carter Aldrete is ranked tied for fourth in RBIs (23). Riley Mahan is ranked tied for sixth in RBIs (22). Hayden Cantrelle is ranked seventh in OBP (.414). Tyler Fitzgerald is ranked tied for first in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is ranked tied for sixth in strikeouts (42). Evan Gates is tied for sixth in saves (6).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Rudick is seventh in batting average (.307), first in OBP (.451), 10th in SLG (.518), fourth in OPS (.969), tied for fourth in walks (27) and fourth in runs scored (26). Jose Peroza is tied for sixth in SLG (.542) and seventh in OPS (.923). Wyatt Young is tied for sixth in walks (26). Nate Lavender is tied for sixth in saves (4).

PRDSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

RDAD TO THE SHOW: With his MLB debut on Sunday for the San Francisco Giants, pitcher Ryan Walker became the 88th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. Walker pitched 51 games for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, combining to go 7-2 with a 2.95 ERA and two saves. He struck out 66 batters over 55 innings. This year, Walker made 15 appearances for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-0 with a 0.89 ERA, before his call to join the Giants. In his debut on Sunday, Walker also picked up his first MLB win after pitching a scoreless sixth inning, working around two hits that frame. He started the seventh and left after allowing a single, which was stranded.


THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY
