NOTES AND NUGGETS

DON'T STOP ME NOW

Last week, the Storm Chasers won their 4th series of the season, just the team's 2nd 6-game series win of the year ... they've also come up short a few times.

Omaha took 3 of 5 from Norfolk in April, won all 6 at Toledo in June and won 2 of 3 at Buffalo in July ... Last year, Omaha won 15 of 27 regular season series, including 11 6-game series.

In addition to the 4 series wins, Omaha has 8 series splits this year ... of the 7 series splits that were 6-game series, the Storm Chasers have lost the final 2 games 3 times ... Omaha has split both of its 6-game series with St. Paul.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

MJ Melendez is hitting .296 (34-for-115) in the 2nd half and leads the team with 34 hits and 11 doubles ... he is 2nd on the team with 64 total bases, 18 RBI and 14 walks, and tied 2nd with 5 homers.

Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he leads the club with 9 homers, 66 total bases and 26 RBI since arriving ... 18 of his 29 hits going for extra-bases (8 doubles, 1 triple & 9 homers) ... his 19 walks lead the team, while batting .252 (29-for-115) with the Storm Chasers.

Dairon Blanco is hitting .277 (26-for-94) since June 24 ... 13 of his 26 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 8 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home run, for 48 total bases.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 137 bases this year, and only been caught 27 times ... 137 steals rank 6th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A.

137-for-164 in steal attempts is a 83.5% success rate, the 3rd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 8th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 87.6%, 106-for-121).

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only Rich Hill (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts.

Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024) ... there have been 15 Storm Chasers players this year with 2 or more years of MLB service time.

Bobby Dalbec's Omaha debut Saturday makes him the 16th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 18 players in their 30's appear between the last two years (2023 & 2024).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has played many close games this season ... with mixed success.

Yesterday marked the Storm Chasers' 7th 1-run win this year, ... Omaha is 7-19 in 1-run games this year, with 7 wins in 1-run games tied for the fewest among full-season Minor League teams.

Last Tuesday's win was Omaha's first 1-run win since June 10 @ Toledo, a 9-8 win over the Mud Hens ... the Storm Chasers had lost their previous 10 1-run games.

Yesterday was the team's 25th "comeback" win of the year, a win after trailing at some point in the game ... Last Tuesday was the 2nd time Omaha overcame multiple deficits to win, the 10th time winning while trailing for more than 2.0 innings.

WHAT A RELIEF

While Omaha's starting pitching has struggled at times in 2025, the bullpen has stepped up to help win games for the Storm Chasers.

In August, Omaha's bullpen has pitched to a 2.88 ERA (13 ER in 40.2 IP), the 4th-best ERA in the International League ... the relievers have allowed 3 earned runs just once in a game in the month of August, allowing more than 4 hits as a bullpen just once as well.

Omaha's relievers have combined for a 4.69 ERA (265 ER in 508.1 IP), while the starting pitchers have pitched to a 5.87 ERA (313 ER in 479.2 IP) ... the bullpen is tied 12th of 20 teams in the league in ERA while the starters rank 19th ... the relievers rank 4th in the league in K/9 (10.00) and K/BB (2.27).

The bullpen has combined for 23 scoreless efforts, most recently 3.1 innings in Sunday's win over the Indians, the relievers' second scoreless effort this month.

3 Chasers relievers have not allowed a run in the month of August: Joey Krehbiel (6.0 IP), Ryan Hendrix (2.2 IP) and Stephen Nogosek (1.0 IP).

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline (Not ranked)

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
