Dragons On The Field

- Elly De La Cruz (seventh youngest position player in the league with at least 120 AB) over his last 33 games (since May 25) is batting .323 with nine home runs and 24 RBI. De La Cruz ranks in the top five in the MWL in nine major categories: OPS, slugging percentage, home runs, RBI, batting average, hits, runs, extra base hits, and stolen bases.
- Austin Hendrick over his last six games has three home runs, two doubles, eight RBI, and an .810 slugging percentage.
- **Joe Boyle** has an earned run average of 0.65 and opponent's batting average of .086 on the year. Both figures would lead all Minor League Baseball, but he is four innings short of the minimum number to qualify.
- The Dragons have nine players on *MLB Pipeline's* Top 30 Reds Prospects list. This group is headlined by De La Cruz, ranked #2. Other top prospects on the Dragons roster include infielder Tyler Callihan, outfielder Austin Hendrick, catcher Mat Nelson, right-handed pitcher Christian Roa, infielder Jose Torres, catcher Daniel Vellojin, outfielder Justice Thompson, and right-handed pitcher Joe Boyle.
