TUESDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Somerset Patriots, 12-4, to open the Eastern League's second half. The Patriots struck first with a solo homer by Max Burt in the third inning. Richmond took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the fourth with an RBI double by **Brady Whalen** and an RBI single by **Jimmy Glowenke.** The Patriots scored six runs in the fifth to take the lead. Anthony Siegler hit a go-ahead, two-run single. Spencer Jones hit a three-run homer and Benjamin Cowles followed with a solo homer. In the bottom of the fifth, **Will Wilson** brought home a run with a groundout. The Patriots pulled away with four runs in the sixth inning. Spencer Jones plated a run with a sac fly and Tyler Hardman hit a three-run homer. **Christian Koss** hit an RBI single in the sixth inning to close the score to 11-4. Cowles capped the scoring with a sac fly in the eighth. The Patriots hit four homers in the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in the second of a six-game series. The two teams met in a three-game set in New Jersey to open the season in April, with the Patriots taking two-of-three games. This series is the Patriots' only visit to The Diamond this season. The Flying Squirrels are 14-8 this year against teams from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-3 dating back to last Friday. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won four-of-their-last-six series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9. They followed by winning four-of-six June 11-16 at New Hampshire and four-of-six last week in Portland.

THE PATRIOTS had lost five consecutive games, all last week at home against the SeaWolves, before taking the series opener on Tuesday night. They finished the first half with a 32-37 record, which was fourth in the Northeast Division. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (78) and triples (16). There are five Somerset players ranked MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), 3B Tyler Hardman (No. 25) and RHP Danny Watson (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects list includes three Somerset players, including Jones (No. 2), Selvidge (No. 11) and Vrieling (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 14th start of the season and his second against Somerset. He last pitched on Friday at Portland and allowed a career-high eight runs over 3.2 innings, including three home runs. He pitched at Somerset on Opening Day on April 5 and surrendered four runs (three earned) over five innings. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. He has made six scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR SOMERSET: Left-hander Brock Selvidge makes his 14th start of the season and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Selvidge allowed a season-high seven runs over 4.2 innings in a loss against the SeaWolves last Wednesday. In his first six starts of the year, Selvidge went 3-1 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER/33.0 IP) but has gone 3-4 with a 5.60 ERA (22 ER/35.1 IP) in his last seven starts. Selvidge was selected by the Yankees in the third round (92nd overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Hamilton High School in Chandler, Ariz. Last year in his first season at the full-season level, he went 8-5 with a 3.45 ERA in 24 outings for Low-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley. Selvidge is rated by MLB.com as the No. 10 Yankees prospect and No. 11 by Baseball America.

KOSS-SOME: After leading the minors with a .647 batting average (11-for-17), Christian Koss was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday. In his return to Portland to face his former team, Koss posted a league-leading 1.591 OPS and also led the circuit in hits (11) and doubles (5). He was tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (5), ranked second in OBP (.650) and SLG (.941) and tied for second in runs scored (6). Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 20 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .438 (28-for-64), which is highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season.

HIT PARADE: In Over the last 12 games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.303), runs (84), hits (130), RBIs (77) and OBP (.376) while ranking second in total bases (196), doubles (26) and OPS (.833). In those 12 games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7.0 runs per game and 10.8 hits per game.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 14 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .375 (24-for-64) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 23 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .333 (32-for-96) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. His 11-game hitting streak was snapped on Saturday night. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in six-of-seven games dating back to June 15 and is batting .448 (13-for-29) in that stretch.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting .367 (11-for-30) with a homer, a double and seven RBIs over his last seven games dating back to Sunday. He has picked up multiple hits in four-of-his-last-seven games, including three hits on June 16, June 19 and in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. He hit a solo homer in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with Shane Matheny, Sean Roby and Devin Harris while trailing only Ricky Oropesa (37), Jacob Heyward (33) and Jarrett Parker (30).

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .381 (8-for-21) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in each of his five games played, including three two-hit games. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fifth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,002).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2010, the Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 6-3, in 11 innings at Jerry Uht Park. Thomas Neal became the first player in team history to homer three times in a single game. No other Flying Squirrels player had ever hit three homers in a game until Carter Aldrete did it in August 2023. Brandon Crawford hit a go-ahead single in the top of the 11th inning for the Flying Squirrels.

IN OTHER WORDS...

Christian Koss on his big week in Portland against the Sea Dogs last week while facing his old team:

"To be playing well is a good feeling. The fact that it's them on the other side makes it a little better. I think the biggest thing is just trying to be consistent with my at-bats.
