

Leading Off

Tonight, Reading finishes a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats. Reading leads the season-series 9-8 and is aiming for a its second series win of the season. It'll be a rematch of Tuesday's matchup of Victor Vargas againt Gabriel Hughes.

Looking Back

The long ball and pitching powered Reading to a win. David Parkinson pitched a season-high six innings and got the win. Carlos De La Cruz, Jhailyn Ortiz and Nick Podkul all homered in the win. De La Cruz extended his on-base streak to 32 games. Johan Rojas stole three bags, becoming the first R-Phil to do that since himself on July 1, 2022 against Somerset.

The Big 3-0 for Carlos

With a home run last night, Carlos De La Cruz extended his on-base streak to 32 games, which dates back to May 12. De La Cruz is the first R-Phil to have a 30-or-more game on-base streak since Cameron Perkins reached base in 33-straight games in 2014.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he hit .423 last week and is .458 against Hartford so far. Entering this week, Rojas led all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks fifth in the Eastern League with a .312 average.

Consistent Kroon

Matthew Kroon has established himself as one of the most consistent bats in the Reading lineup. After missing all, but two games, in 2022 with an injury, Kroon has played in nearly every game this season and leads the team with a .312 average; which also ranks fourth in the Eastern League. Kroon also has played third base and all the outfield positions this season.

Bullpen Blues

Following Parkinson, the bullpen pitched three shutout innings, continuing its stretch of domination in wins this season. In wins this season, Reading's bullpen has a 2.31 ERA, but in losses it's a 7.45 ERA.

Around the Organization

The Phillies stayed hot with a 12-inning, 3-2 win, over Oakland and will go for the sweep today. Lehigh Valley fell to Toledo 9-5 to drop back to .500 at 33-33 on the season. Jersey Shore had a 4-1 win over Wilminton to improve to 32-29 on the year. Clearwater fell to Tampa 7-2 last night in a game that was completed early due to rain, but still hold the best record in the Florida State League at 42-19.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 18, 1917: At Circus Maximus, the New York State League Reading Pretzels score seven times in the third inning and go on to beat Harrisburg, 9-6. Playing in Reading for the first time, Bucky Harris singles and scores two runs.

The Goats

This is the third series of the season between Reading and Hartford. The Yard Goats currently sit in fifth in the Northeast Standings, two games ahead of Reading. Last week, Hartford dropped five-of-six games to Somerset at home, winning on Wednesday. After this week, the Yard Goats return home to host Erie for a six-game series to close the first half. Reading is hitting .321 against Hartford this season.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Gabriel Hughes gets the start for the second time this week against Reading. In his first road start in double-A, Reading roughed up Hughes for ten-earned runs on ten hits in just 3.2 innings pitched and suffered the loss. Hughes made his double-A debut on June 7 against Somerset, after making eight starts with high-A Spokane. In total, Hughes is 4-4 with a 6.99 ERA acorss ten starts at both levels. Hughes was a first-round pick by Colorado in 2022 out of Gonzaga, and currently ranks as the Rockies number-five prospect.
