

SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS 50/50 RAFFLE FAQ

1. How are the proceeds split?

One winner receives 50% of the Jackpot for that game's drawing, and the remaining 50% is retained by the San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation for charitable programs, including the Community Grant Program and other youth, education, and community development initiatives.

2. How much are raffle tickets?

- 1 for \$3.00
- 5 for \$10.00
- 25 for \$20.00

3. How can I pay for raffle tickets?

Raffle tickets may be purchased using payment methods authorized at the point of sale, which may include debit cards and major credit cards. Not all payment types may be accepted at every sales location or game.

4. Am I eligible to participate?

You must be 18 or older and a legal resident of the United States or the District of Columbia. IDs may be requested.

5. Who is not eligible?

Employees of the Foundation, the San Antonio Missions, Wolff Stadium, affiliated entities, sponsors, vendors, players, coaching or training staff, board members, agents, representatives, and their immediate family or household members are not eligible to participate.

6. Are raffle tickets tax-deductible?

No. Raffle ticket purchases are not deductible charitable contributions.

7. When are tickets sold?

Tickets are available from the time gates open until the end of the sixth inning during participating San Antonio Missions regular-season home games. If a game does not start on time, or is delayed during the first two innings, sales will continue for at least two hours from gate opening unless otherwise required by law or operations.

8. Where can I buy tickets?

Tickets may be purchased only at authorized in-ballpark sales locations and methods at Wolff

Stadium, including approved kiosks, roaming sellers, and designated in-stadium digital purchase options.

9. Do I need to be present to win?

No. You do not need to be present at the time of the drawing to win.

10. When is the winning number announced?

The winning number is drawn and announced during the seventh inning on the public address system and on select video boards at Wolff Stadium.

11. Where is the winning number posted?

The winning number will be posted after the game on the official 50/50 raffle page designated by the Club or Foundation on www.samissions.com/5050.

12. Where do I claim a winning ticket?

On game days, the winning ticket may be presented at the Guest Services Booth inside the main gate. During normal business hours, it may also be presented to a Foundation representative at 5757 W US Hwy 90, San Antonio, TX 78227.

13. How long do I have to claim a prize?

A prize must be claimed within 30 calendar days of the drawing date. If the 30th day falls on a weekend or recognized holiday, the deadline extends to the next business day.

14. What do I need to claim my prize?

You will need the winning ticket, valid identification, and any required claim and tax documents. Additional documentation may be required by the Foundation.

15. How is the prize paid?

Prizes are paid by check only. After the prize is validly claimed and all required documentation is completed, payment will be issued within 30 days.

16. What happens if a prize is unclaimed or forfeited?

If a prize is not claimed on time or is otherwise forfeited, the funds will be retained by the San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation for charitable purposes, including the Community Grant Program and other mission-aligned initiatives.

17. What happens if an ineligible person participates?

Any prize associated with an ineligible participant will be forfeited and retained by the Foundation for charitable purposes.
