YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Somerset Patriots, 6-5, in 10 innings. Simon Whiteman started the scoring in the third with an RBI double. Heliot Ramos opened the lead to 2-0 with a solo homer in the bottom of the fifth, his ninth of the year. In the sixth, Somerset evened the score with a sac fly by Oswaldo Cabrera and an RBI single by Donny Sands. In the sixth,
Richmond moved back in front with a two-run single by Brandon Martorano. In the eighth, Oswald Peraza hit an RBI triple and Richmond moved back in front with a two-run single by Brandon Martorano. In the eighth, Oswald Peraza hit an RBI triple and Cabrera hit a sac fly to tie the game, 4-4. Somerset scored two runs in the top of the 10th and the Flying Squirrels were held to one run in the bottom of the inning, an RBI double by Whiteman. Starter Caleb Kilian worked 5.2 innings and allowed two runs with five strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series marks the first-ever trip for the Patriots to The Diamond. From June 15-20, the Patriots won five-of-six in Bridgewater against the Flying Squirrels. This series marks the final set between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won eight of their last 12 games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.85 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have gone $8-5$ over the last 13 games. They currently lead the Northeast Division by 2.0 games over Portland. For the season, the Somerset offense has hit .243, which is sixth in the circuit. The pitching staff has a 2.95 ERA, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. Somerset is playing its first season as an affiliated team after playing in the independent Atlantic League as a founding member of the circuit from 1998-2020, winning six championships. The Somerset roster includes four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Osward Peraza (No. 4, No. 97 overall), RHP Luis Medina (No. 7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (No. 27) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Sean Hjelle makes his 11th start of the 2021 season. Last time out, he allowed three runs over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts in a no-decision at Bowie on Saturday. He last pitched against Somerset on June 17 but left the game with back spasms after recording just one out. Over his last five starts since June 4, Hjelle has gone 1-1 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP). In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year America as the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He enters the 2021 season rated by more on Hjelle, see page two

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Luis Medina makes his fifth Double-A start. In his most recent outing, Medina worked 5.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts at Harrisburg on July 4. He made his Double-A debut against the Flying Squirrels in Bridgewater on June 16, allowing three runs over 5.2 innings with 10 strikeouts, his highest strikeout total at the Double-A level so far. Medina began the season with High-A Hudson Valley, where he went 2-1 with a 2.76 ERA in seven starts. He is rated by Baseball America as the New York Yankees' No. 9 prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com.

POWER SURGE: Over the last nine games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 14 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. Vince Fernandez has hit four homers in his seven games played during that stretch. Heliot Ramos has hit three and Frankie Tostado has hit two. Andres Angulo, Sandro Fabian, Brandon Martorano, Andy Sugilio and David Villar have each homered once in that stretch. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank seventh in the circuit with 65 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 123 home runs this season in 120 games. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Villar and Fernandez lead the team with 11 home runs this season. In 2019, Gio Brusa led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season.
RAMOS RAKING: Heliot Ramos is currently riding an eight-game hitting streak since July 4. In that span, he is batting . 333 (11-for-33) with four home runs, four doubles and nine RBIs while scoring eight runs. He began the season hitting .314 with three homers and 12 RBls in 22 May games. In June, he posted a .155 batting average and homered twice with three RBls in 26 games. Ramos is back with the Flying Squirrels this week after missing two games last weekend while traveling to Denver for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game as part of MLB's All-Star Week festivities. On Thursday, he hit his ninth home run of the season for the Flying Squirrels, a 484 -foot shot over the batters' eye in center field.

TOASTY: Over his last 29 games since June 6, Frankie Tostado is batting . 330 (37-for-112) with seven homers, eight doubles and 30 RBls. Last Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer in the series opener at Bowie. He has at least one extra-base hits in 10 of his last 15 games. Tostado also has two hits in each of his last two games.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, David Villar has hit . 337 (31-for-92) with six homers and 14 RBls over his last 25 games since June 16. He added a three-run homer on Saturday night at Bowie to put the Flying Squirrels ahead in the eighth inning. For the season, Villar is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 11 games since June 30, Vince Fernandez is batting . 460 (17-for-37) with four home runs, two doubles and 13 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked tied for first on the team with 11 homers this season and third with 29 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in six of his last 11 games. On Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4 -for- 5 with homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11 th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 8-13 (.381) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked tied for eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 40 RBIs and seventh with 60 hits. Shane Matheny is tied for sixth with 28 walks. Norwith Gudino and Patrick Ruotolo are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. Frank Rubio is tied for fourth with 22 games pitched and Joey Marciano is tied for sixth with 21 games pitched Caleb Kilian is ranked second in ERA (2.21), first in complete games (2), first in shutouts (1), third in BAA (.216), tied for second in WHIP ( 0.92 ) and first in winning percentage (1.000).
PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Will Wilson (10), Tristan Beck (13), Sean Hjelle (14) and Jose Marte (30). Ramos is also rated by Baseball America as the No. 83 overall prospect. Simon Whiteman is rated by Baseball America as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and Diego Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, includ ing Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
