FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher</u>" in the ... system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

Last week against Springfield, Naturals starting pitchers combined to throw 27.2 innings (out of 52.0 played, or 53%), the most the rotation has collectively offered in a series this season, including three performances of 5.0 innings or more.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.57 ERA in the month of May ranks 4th in the Texas League, with four of seven starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer.
- Across seven May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 3.58 ERA (13 ER in 32.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts (9.64 K/9) and a .197 opponents' average.
- Reigning Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 5.0 innings or more in each of his last five outings, including a pair of scoreless starts, 6.0 innings on 4/26 vs. AMA and 5/7 @ SPR.

NATURALS IN THE SHOW

In last Tuesday's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Fransisco Giants on April 12.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPE14CTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 2-12, while 12-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 4-11 when recording nine hits or less, but 10-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 14-2 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-11 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 11-5, whereas 3-8 when the opponent scores first.

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

NOTES

Through 26 games, the Naturals have stolen 38 bases in 47 attempts (average 1.41 steals/game) and pulled off a double steal 6 times.

- 38 steals ranks third in the Texas League, eighth in Double-A and tied for 29th in the Minors, while a 80.85% success rate on steals ranks 20th among MiLB teams with at least 35 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's 11 steals (in 13 attempts) ranks tied for third in the Texas League and tied for seventh in all of Double-A.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia is currently riding a 11-game hitting streak, but also has 22 walks on the season, which is tied for second in the Texas League and tied third in Double-A.

- The 11-game hitting streak is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for ٠ the third-longest in the Texas League this season and is tied for the longest active hitting streak with Amarillo's Dominic Fletcher ... in the 11 games since 4/27, he's batting .391 (18-for-46) with five doubles and a .981 OPS.
- In 126 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 54 times, for a .429 on-base percentage (32 hits + 22 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 24 of the 26 games he's appeared in this season ... the only games he didn't reach base were back-to-back games, on April 23 & 26 ... he's also reached base at least twice in 17 of 24 games where he has reached base.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking third in walks (22), tied third in steals (10), tied fifth in runs scored (25), tied sixth in hits (32) and ninth in on-base percentage (.429).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

NATE IS GREAT

Utility man Nate Eaton has been a consistent presence in the Naturals lineup all season along, playing all over the diamond for Northwest Arkansas as well.

- Eaton's .322 average leads gualified Naturals hitters, while he ranks third on the team in hits with 29.
- Between April 23 and May 1, Eaton collected an eight-game hitting streak, going 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS ... this streak ranks second on the team in 2022, behind Maikel Garcia's active 11 game streak.
- With 14 starts (122.0 innings) at third base, 4 starts (36.0 innings) in right field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field.

It's Gonna Be Massey

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman Michael Massey has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .455 (10-for-22) average with a 1.153 OPS across six games, while driving in 10 runs.

- After two slow weeks to start the season, Massey has turned things around, raising his batting average over 100 points, from .213 after April 21 to the .320 it sits at now.
- His hot streak began April 22, homering in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco and went from having no homers through the first 11 games of the season, to having five in his last 14, leading the team in that department.
- Massey has reached base in 21 of 25 games he's played this year, with already nine multi-hit games.
- Massey ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking third in runs batted in (26), fifth in hits (33), tied fifth in doubles (8), eighth in total bases (56), ninth in extra-base hits (13) and tied 10th in home runs (5).


