**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels blanked the Baysox, 4-0. **Logan Wyatt** brought in the game's first run with a groundout in the bottom of the second inning. **Wade Meckler** hit an RBI triple in the bottom of the seventh. **Marco Luciano** followed with an RBI double and **Andy Thomas** brought him home with a sac fly to extend the lead to 4-0. Richmond pitchers **Spencer Bivens** (3.0 IP), **Raymond Burgos** (3.0 IP), **Tyler Myrick** (1.2 IP) and **Blake Rivera** (1.1 IP) combined for the shutout.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale postponed until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

**HOT SQUIRRELS SUMMER:** The Flying Squirrels have gone 12-1 in their last 13 games, which is tied for the team's best record in a 13-game stretch in franchise history. It is even with a 12-1 stretch from August 3-16, 2013, although one of the wins was a completion of a suspended game from the previous month. The game on July 21 was halted in the 10th inning with the score tied, 5-5. The game was completed on August 16 and Richmond beat Bowie, 6-5, in the 11th with a walk-off single by **Brett Krill**. The Flying Squirrels are also 14-2 in their last 16 games. A win tonight would match their best mark through 17 games, which was 15-2 from July 28-August 16, 2013. That stretch also included the same completion of the July 21, 2013 suspended game.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 14-2 in their last 16 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022, and have matched that streak with six consecutive wins since Saturday. Over the last 16 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .269 (140-for-521) with 20 homers, 28 doubles and have scored 96 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.60 ERA (41 ER/142.0 IP), the best in the league, with 181 strikeouts. Over the last 21 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.00 ERA (17 ER/76.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.65 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 277.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 397.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.24 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and tied for the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

**THE BAYSOX** opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 2-8 in their last 10 games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11), Fabian (No. 15), McDermott (No. 17) and Rhodes (No. 19).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Mason Black** makes his 16th Double-A start and third against the Baysox. Black last pitched on Saturday and threw five perfect innings against the Fightin' Phils in Reading and tied his season high with eight strikeouts, earning him last week's Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award. That outing was his fifth-straight scoreless start dating back to June 8, covering 22.1 innings. On Thursday, Black was named the June Eastern League Pitcher of the Month after leading EL pitchers (min. 20 IP) for the month in ERA (1.27) and WHIP (0.94), including four consecutive scoreless starts to close the month. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 50 IP) this season, Black is second in strikeout percentage (31.2), third in BAA (.196), third in WHIP (1.05), fifth in K/9 (11.29), ninth in BB/9 (3.05) and 10th in ERA (3.66). He first faced the Baysox on April 27 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed one run over four innings with a season-high eight strikeouts. Black faced the Baysox a second time on June 14 and threw four scoreless innings, allowing two hits. Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

**ALL ZEROS:** **Mason Black** has worked 22.2 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to his start on June 2 against the Sea Wolves. Black is three outs away from matching the longest scoreless streak in Flying Squirrels franchise history, which was set by relief pitcher **Tyler Rogers** from April 22-June 23, 2016. During that stretch, Rogers made 23 consecutive appearances without allowing a run. He opened the 2016 season pitching 32 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run, spanning 32.0 innings while collecting 10 saves.

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Jean Pinto makes his second Double-A start and fourth Double-A appearance. He last pitched on Sunday against the Patriots and surrendered one run over three innings of work. He made his Double-A debut on June 20 in a start at Altoona, allowing one run in 4.1 innings. Pinto pitched again in that series on June 25 and recorded two outs, allowing five runs (one earned). Pinto began the season with High-A Aberdeen and made 12 starts, going 1-1 with a 2.86 ERA. He was promoted to Double-A on June 20. Pinto signed with the Angels as an international free agent in 2018 and was traded to the Orioles on December 2, 2020 along with RHP Garrett Stallings for SS Jose Iglesias.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,531) and total attendance (261,246). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MiLB teams.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In his five games of last week's series, Meckler reached base 13 times with 10 hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. In the series-opener on Tuesday, he clubbed a go-ahead, two-run homer in the eighth inning. He added an RBI triple on Thursday. Meckler has now reached base in all 24 of his Double-A games, including 36 hits and 17 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in Double-A and the longest by a Richmond player this season. He also leads Double-A with 11 consecutive games scoring a run. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 190 PA) this season in batting average (.379), OBP (.482) and is second in BABIP (.456). In the Eastern League (min. 100 PA), Meckler is first in batting average (.379), on-base percentage (.473), ranks second in wRC+ (178) and fourth in OPS (1.000), he has the fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (11.6) and the third-lowest swinging strike percentage (5.0).

**VAUN GONE WILD:** **Vaun Brown** is riding a 10-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered four times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of last week's series at Reading and a three-run blast on Tuesday night at The Diamond. In his last 10 games, Brown is batting .364 (16-for-44) with four homers, four doubles and 15 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts. Brown also has a league-best six-game extra-base hit streak dating back to June 25.

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** **Andy Thomas** has picked up 13 RBIs over his last 10 games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer last Thursday night at Reading. On Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last 10 games, Thomas is batting .378 (14-for-37) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 13 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 40 RBIs. Thomas has a hit in each of his last 10 games dating back to June 24.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
