FIRST HALF FLEW - Triple-A baseball finished the first half of the season last Sunday. The winner of the International League was the Norfolk Tides with 48 wins. The top team of the Pacific Coast League was the Oklahoma City Dodgers with 50 victories. These two teams will face off against the two champions of the second half in the first round of the playoffs.

ON TOP OF THE ORG - At the half way point of the season, Andres Chaparro leads the Yankees farm system with 69 games total games played and runs batted in with 48.. Estevan Florial has knocked the most homers with 19. Matt Bowman has made the most appearances out as a pitcher with 26 total. Mitch Spence has tossed the most innings with 76.2 frames pitched.

BULLPEN BEST - The RailRiders bullpen has impressed this season with a 3.91 earned run average in 301.1 innings pitched. The staff has totaled 353 strikeouts to just 171 walks. The 'pen was second in the International League with 19 saves led by Greg Weissert's six. Matt Krook impressed out of the pen with a 1.29 ERA in 21.0 innings pitched while Colten Brewer recorded a 1.37 ERA in 19.2 innings.

STACKING UP - At the end of the first half, SWB is middle of the pack in batting average with the team hitting a combined .260. Syracuse is just beneath them with a .255 average. The RailRiders are in the top third in steals in the International League with 87 while the Mets are in the bottom with 49 total snags.
