July 11: Baysox 9, RubberDucks 0: Luis De Leon held the Ducks hitless until the seventh and only surrendered two hits in Chesapeake's 9-0 win. **Zane Morehouse** tossed a scoreless 2.2 innings while striking out four for Akron out of the bullpen.

Today's starter: Braylon Doughty is making his third Double-A start and 17th start of the season. The right-hander is coming off a no-decision after striking out six over six scoreless innings on Tuesday against the Baysox. Doughty is currently ranked as the Guardians top pitching prospect according to MLB Pipeline. He ranks top 10 in the Guardians organization in strikeouts (82, third), innings pitched (68, seventh), average against (.272, sixth) and WHIP (1.28, third).

Mr. Thompson says hello: Bennett Thompson made a quick impression in Akron by launching a grand slam for his first Double-A hit on July 1. This kick started a great week for the new Akron catcher and first baseman as he hit .294 with four runs scored, two home runs and seven RBI against Erie. Thompson is batting .300 on the season between Akron and Lake County, which leads the Guardians organization. His .461 OBP between the two levels is second best in full season MiLB (Mike Sirota of the Dodgers organization leads with a .475 OBP).

Men of steal: The Akron RubberDucks swiped six bases in the win over Chesapeake on Wednesday. Since June 1, the RubberDucks have stolen 46 bases, which is sixth most in the Eastern League, while being caught just eight times, which is tied for fourth fewest in the EL. **Alex Mooney** leads the RubberDucks with 19 stolen bases on the year while **Nick Mitchell** (14) and **Alfonsin Rosario** (12) are the only other Akron batters with double digit steals. Mooney needs just six stolen bases over the last two and half months this season to tie his total from all of last season. He has stolen six bases in every month in 2026.

Multi inning Matson: Sean Matson tossed three scoreless innings allowing just one hit to pick up the win in relief on Wednesday night. The right-hander has worked multiple innings in 13 of his 18 outings with Akron this season.

Walk this way: After leading the Eastern League and ranking fourth in all of Double-A in walks in 2025, the RubberDucks batters are once again showing impressive patience in 2026. Akron's 384 walks rank second in Eastern League and ninth in Double-A this season. Nine different Akron batters have walked 20+ times this season. **Nick Mitchell** leads the RubberDucks with 43 walks.

RubberDucks and Baysox: Akron is facing Chesapeake for the fourth and final series this season and second time in Akron. Akron is 13-9 against Chesapeake this season and 359-285 all-time. Top prospects in the series includes:

Summer of Fonsi: Alfonsin Rosario was named Eastern League Player of the Week for Week 14 (June 29-July 5) after hitting .480 with eight runs scored, two doubles, two triples, three home runs and seven RBI during the series against Erie. This marked Rosario's second EL Player of the Week award this season after taking home the honor for Week 10 (June 1-7) at Chesapeake. Since June 1, Rosario has been on a different level at the plate batting .331/.081 with 10 doubles, three triples, 10 homers and 35 RBI in 33 games. He's scored 27 runs and added in six stolen bases in those 33 games. Since June 1, he leads the Eastern League in RBI, slugging percentage (.685), OPS, triples, extra base hits (23) and total bases (89) while ranking second in hits (43), third in homers and fifth in batting average. Rosario's hot stretch has increased his season average from .210 to .275 and increased his home run total to a team leading 16 (second most in Guardians organization).

Dependable Devers: Jose Devers has been one of Akron's best hitters over the last two months. After batting .183 in April, the RubberDucks infielder is batting .304 with six doubles, three triples, two home runs and 23 RBI since May 1. He's scored 34 runs in 55 games over the last three months and raised his season average to .274. Devers is batting .299 with two doubles, two triple and five RBI in 21 games against the Baysox this season.

Healthy Jachec: Matt Jachec is looking sharp on the mound. In 11 appearances off the IL, Jachec is 1-0 with a 1.76 ERA, a save and 26 strikeouts over 15.1 innings pitched. He has allowed just two runs (one earned) since the start of June. The right-hander has not allowed a run over his last six games (two hits allowed over 9.1 innings).

More than a state: Alaska Abney has been big out of the RubberDucks bullpen since coming off the IL on May 31. In 11 appearances, Abney is 1-0 with a 2.30 ERA and 11 strikeouts over 15.2 Innings pitched. He's worked multiple innings in four of his last six outings including tossing 2.1 perfect innings with two strikeouts on July 4. The right-hander has allowed just two unearned runs over his last six appearances spanning 9.2 innings pitched.

Opened the season ranked as the Guardians #6 prospect and #2 pitching prospect according to Baseball America.
Picked up his first professional win on April 23 at West Michigan (5.0IP, 5H, 1R, 8SO).
Started the season with High-A Lake County making 14 starts going 3-3 with a 3.02 ERA and 74 strikeouts over 59.2 innings.
His 74 strikeouts against 11 walks with the Captains at the time of his promotion made him one of just four pitchers in MiLB to strike out 74+ and walk 11 or fewer.
Named Midwest League Pitcher of the Month honors in June after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 24 strikeouts over 22 innings pitched in four starts.
Transferred to Akron on June 30.

- Opened the season Single-A Lynchburg making 22 starts going 0-7 with a 3.48 ERA and 99 strikeouts over 85.1 innings pitched.
 - 99 strikeouts ranked second on the team.
 - Did not pitch after Aug. 15 due to right shoulder inflammation.

- Drafted by Cleveland in CB-A round (36 overall pick) in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Chaparral High School in Temecula, CA.
 - Same High School as former MLB outfielder Alan Craig and former MLB catcher Rob Brantly.
 - As a senior in 2024, he went 4-3 with a 1.11 ERA (8ER/50.1IP), 85 strikeouts and a .155 opponent batting average, allowing just 28 hits and walking just 10.
 - Fastball in high school touched 97 mph and curveball spin rates topped 3,000 rpm.

2026 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization. The 2025 season will be DiCenzo's third as RubberDucks manager, and fifth as a manager in Cleveland's organization. He's led the RubberDucks to a 157-118 record in two seasons as Akron's manager including an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#48 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his seventh season with the Guardians organization and third with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#43 Hitting Coach Cole Nieto enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Nieto joins the RubberDucks after serving as the hitting coach for the Lynchburg Hillcats in 2024 and their Carolina League championship season in 2025.

A graduate of St. Ignatius High School in Cleveland, Nieto played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea. While at Baldwin Wallace, he hit .341 with 17 home runs and 109 RBI in 137 career games.

#55 Pitching Coach Angus Adams enters his first season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Adams served as a performance coach for Tread Athletics and was a pitching coach at Elmira College.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his fourth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of [Akron](#), Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#33 Bench Coach Yan Rivera enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Rivera spent 2025 as the bench coach for Lake County and 2024 as the manager for the ACL Guardians.

Rivera is the son of former Cleveland minor league manager and Toronto Blue Jays coach Luis Rivera.

#47 Development Coach Gustavo Nava enters his second season with the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Nava served as the Development coach for Lynchburg in their 2025 Carolina League championship season.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his ninth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel enters her third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to the RubberDucks, Gutiérrez-Sogel spent the 2025 season as the Assistant Athletic Trainer in Lake County.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jack Baldwin enters his third season with the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Baldwin served as the Strength and Conditioning coach for Lynchburg in 2025.

Mental Performance Coach Andie McGregor enters her third season with the Guardians. She previously worked as a Mental Performance Coach at IMG Academy, supporting middle school, high school and post-grad student athletes in the baseball program. Also served as a Mental Performance intern with the New York Mets, working with the FCL Mets during the 2021 season. Has a Master of Science in Educational Psychology – Sport Psychology at Florida State University and a Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science at Georgia College & State University.

Baseball Technology Fellow Ryan Chambliss enters his first season in Akron. He spent the 2025 season with the Guardians ACL affiliate.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, then team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World**." Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
