LÓPEZ HOMERS, BUT SHRIMP FALL 6-2

Otto López reached base four times and hit a home run Thursday but the Jumbo Shrimp dropped a contest 6-2 to the Knights. López led off the bottom of the first with a single and later scored on an RBI ground out. Charlotte responded by plating four runs in the second and adding two more in the third to make it 6-1. López then homered in the fifth inning, but Jacksonville went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position, stranding nine runners on base in the defeat.

GRAND THEFT OTTO

The Miami Marlins claimed **Otto López** off waivers from the San Francisco Giants on April 4 and promptly optioned him to Jacksonville. The Montréal native has been almost impossible to retire since that point. Over his first five games with the Jumbo Shrimp, López is 12-for-20 (.600) with two doubles, two home runs, four RBIs, three walks and four runs scored. He has reached base multiple times in all five games.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City for a series that began on April 2. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since **Peter O'Brien** went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last eight games, six of which came against Durham, Gray is a combined 9-for-31 (.290) with a double, five home runs, nine RBIs, three walks and seven runs scored.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 12 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 42 runs (3.5 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 18-for-109 (165/.298/.284/.582, ranking 30th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 84 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

'PFN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen has excelled of late. Over the club's last four games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to yield just one run on 11 hits in 19.0 innings (0.47 ERA) with 23 strikeouts against five walks. On the season, Jacksonville's bullpen has posted a 3.38 ERA, which ranks fourth in the International League. Jumbo Shrimp relievers have retired 30 of the 35 first-batters they have faced (85.7 percent).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31, a 6-2 defeat to Durham on April 5 and another 6-2 loss to Charlotte on Thursday, all nine of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 7-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won six of their last nine games. All six of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville outscoring their opponents 36-34. Relatedly, those 36 runs scored rank in a tie for seventh-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. However, their 34 runs allowed are tied for the fifth-fewest at the level since this stretch began on April 2. The Jumbo Shrimp's 3.08 ERA leads Triple-A during this stretch.

SHRIMP BITES

Of the 24 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, 12 have been multi-run frames... José Devers has hits in eight consecutive games, batting 10-for-29 (.345) with three doubles, a triple, home run, five RBIs, two walks and six runs scored... The Jumbo Shrimp struck out 17 Charlotte Knights on Thursday, the second-most in Triple-A this season (Columbus, 18, vs. Omaha on April 3). It was the most punchouts for Jacksonville since also whiffing 17 on May 20, 2022 vs. Durham. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp had three 17-strikeout games from May 14-20, 2022.

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

2024 SEASON

-Began rehab assignment from a left shoulder impingement on April 5 for Jacksonville

2023 SEASON

-Garrett began the 2023 season as a long reliever but joined the Marlins starting rotation in April 2023 after Johnny Cueto injured his right biceps.

-Right-handed hitters batted .261/.300/.448/.748 against him in 503 plate appearances, but Garrett held left-handed batters to a .211/.276/.324/.600 line in 156 plate appearances.

2022 SEASON

-In the major leagues, right-handed hitters batted .280/.346/.455/.801 against him in 284 plate appearances. However, Garrett held southpaws to a .173/.247/.235/.482 mark in 90 plate appearances.

2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.
