TWO HOMERS NOT ENOUGH IN 11-5

Both Tristan Gray and Jonathan Davis homered on Saturday, but the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Tides 11-5. Coby Mayo cracked a two-run home run in the first inning before Grav got Jacksonville on the board with a solo shot in the second. Davis' three-run bomb highlighted a four-run fourth that gave the Jumbo Shrimp a 5-2 lead. Norfolk immediately plated three runs in the fifth and one in the sixth to regain the lead. A five-run Tides seventh inning blew the game open with an 11-5 margin. Norfolk won their second straight game in the series.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE. NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jacksonville infielder Jonah Bride blasted two home runs on Wednesday, his second multi-homer game in five days. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast. Bride is 17-for-49 (.347/.484/.673/1.157) with four doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs, 10 walks and six runs scored. Bride ranks third in the International League in on-base percentage while ranking fifth in OPS, seventh in slugging percentage, eighth in batting average and tied for 15th in home runs.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 45 of their 178 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 45 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 21 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, one four-run inning, five frames of three runs and 13 tworun innings.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 20 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 84 runs (4.2 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 35for-168 (.208/.320/.351/.671, ranking 28th, 28th, 27th and 27th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

DANF TIME

Heading into play on Sunday, Jacksonville outfielder Dane Myers is riding a 16-game on-base streak, the third-longest such run in the International League this season. Myers got off to a slow start on this streak; over the first eight games of the streak, he went just 6-for-29 (.207/.343/.207/.550) with one RBI and four walks. In the eight games since, though, the Katy, Texas native is 8-for-28 (.286/.394/.500/.894) with three doubles, one home run, three RBIs, five walks and six RBIs. On the season. Myers' 60.0 percent ground ball rate is the fifth-highest among the 145 qualifiers in the International League. His ground ball rate was 46.6 percent in 2023 with Jacksonville.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 13 of Jacksonville's 20 games (65.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 10-3 (.769) in those closely-decided affairs thus far Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

TEN COMMANDMENTS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 10 of their last 16 games. Nine of those 10 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville actually being outscored by their opponents by a 82-78 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing eighth in ERA (4.47) in Triple-A during this stretch.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just six stolen base attempts and five stolen bases in the 14 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A... Jumbo Shrimp starters have worked 90.2 innings this season, with the club's relievers combining for 87.1 frames. Thus, Jacksonville's starting pitchers have combined for 50.9 percent of the team's innings pitched... The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 59 consecutive innings without an error, their longest streak of the season.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.
