

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped the series opener to Greenville on Tuesday night at Maimonides Park, 5-3...DH Nick Decker put the Drive ahead for good with a 2-run home run in the top of the 9th...Brooklyn tied the contest at 3 apiece in the 7th on a 3-run home run to left by CF Alex Ramírez...SS William Lugo tallied 2 hits for the Cyclones...LF Miguel Ugueto placed Greenville in front for the first time in the 4th with a 2-run triple...Decker added an RBI double in that frame...C Ronald Rosario picked up 3 hits and a walk for the Drive...RHP Cameron Foster punched out a career-high 7 over 5.0 innings in a no-decision for the 'Clones... LHP Dalton Rogers hoisted 5.0 shutout frames for Greenville.

**RAMÍ ROCKETS:** CF Alex Ramírez homered for the second-straight game on Tuesday night vs. Greenville...The 20-year-old pounded a game-tying 3-run home run to left in the 7th inning...Ramírez also tallied a solo blast in the 6th inning of Sunday's 9-3 win at Jersey Shore...It marked the 2nd time this season a Cyclone player has homered in consecutive games...RF **Stanley Consuegra** first accomplished the feat on April 14 and 15 at Winston-Salem...Ramírez is now tied for the team lead in home runs (5) with Consuegra and INF **Mateo Gil**...Since joining Brooklyn on July 4 of last year, the Mets' No. 2 prospect per MLB Pipeline leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (63), hits (108), doubles (26), extra-base hits (37), total bases (166)...Ramírez is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (63) trailing only teammate IF/OF Jaylen Palmer (65), and INF José Peroza (69).

**REMEMBER US?:** This week marks the first time a Boston Red Sox affiliate has played at Maimonides Park since the Cyclones captured the final New York-Penn League championship against the Lowell Spinners in Game 3 of the 2019 NYPL Championship Series on September 10, 2019...PH Alex Erro — who made the final out for Lowell on a strikeout against LHP Andrew Edwards — OF Nick Decker and OF Gilberto Jiménez appeared in that contest and are currently on Greenville's roster...Jiménez is presently on the 7-day injured list...Current New York Mets 3B Brett Baty started in all 3 games of the series for Brooklyn.

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 20 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 43 earned runs (59 total) on 134 hits through the last 169.0 innings...That is good for a 2.29 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...lt is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia is 2nd in MiLB (2.43)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 73 (10.3 BB%) and struck out 202 in that span (28.6 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 88-59, over the 20-game stretch...Brooklyn is 11-9 during that span.

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.19) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.58) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.38) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.17).

**NOT SO STUART LITTLE:** At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified pitchers in Minor League Baseball — in ERA (1.43)...Stuart is also 9th in the circuit in WHIP (1.20) and 10th in innings pitched (44.0)...The Kankakee, III. native is also 2nd in LOB% (87.2%), 2nd in FIP (2.87), 3rd in xFIP (3.46), 4th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 6th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64).

**BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23... Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him.

**1-2, E-STEP:** After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 25 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .314/.379/.500 with a .879 OPS...Estep has accumulated 15 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 14 RBI in 95 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 138 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 178 points in that time (.047 to .225).

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 5 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS/3B Eddinson Paulino (11), RHP Wikelman González (12), 1B/3B Blaze Jordan (14), IF Brainer Bonaci (16), and LHP Dalton Rogers (29)... Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate in the regular season since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League.

**GOING, GOING, GIL:** INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing ...264/.361/.566 and he has registered an impressive .927 OPS, 145 wRC+, and .410 wOBA in that time...Gil is 14-for-53 at the plate (.264) with 10 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 2nd in the league in home runs (4), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (8), tied for 3rd in RBI (13), 5th in slugging (.592), and tied for 8th in OPS (.927).

**UP TO PAR-ADA:** C **Kevin Parada** extended his on-base streak to 10 games with a single on Tuesday...The 21-year-old is 12-for-his-last-41 (.293) with a run scored, 3 doubles, 2 RBI, and 3 walks...Parada holds a 105 wRC+ and .345 wOBA in that span...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (14)...Since the start of May, Parada is tied for 4th in the circuit in two-baggers (10) and tied for 7th in the league in extra-base hits (13).

ALL GAS, NO TE-BRAKE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 6 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 3 walks over 9.1 innings, registering 15 strikeouts...That equates to a 42.9 K% (15/35).

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 20 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 90 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (97), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (96), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (92) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 38...Omar is already 12 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón tossed another gem last Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

**CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Wednesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (185), at-bats (610), plate appearances (730), runs scored (95), walks (100), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (191), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and tied for 5th in hits (113).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (23/26) and RHP Christian Scott (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 18 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.



LAST TIME OUT: Took his second-straight defeat in Game 2 of last Wednesday's doubleheader at Jersey Shore...Permitted 2 runs on 6 hits over 3-plus innings...Walked 4 and struck out 3...Tossed a wild pitch...Hurled 68 pitches and 38 strikes (55.9%)...Relieved by RHP Paul Gervase with runners at 1st and 3rd and nobody out in the bottom of the 4th and Brooklyn trailing, 1-0...1-of-2 bequeathed runners came in to score...BlueClaws went on to shutout the Cyclones, 5-0... Jersey Shore captured Game 1, 9-3.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by Baseball America...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
