On the Bay: The Patriots continue a six-game series at home against the Bowie Baysox tonight. The Patriots took the first two games over Bowie despite falling behind 2-0 in the top of the first inning each night. Bowie has taken each of the last two games and have now scored first in each of the first four games of this series.

Well Regarded: The Patriots have eight players on their active roster ranked in the Top 30 prospects in the Yankees' system: Clarke Schmidt (No. 2), Oswald Peraza (No. 4), Luis Medina (No. 8), Josh Breaux (No. 14), Brandon Lockridge (No. 15), Ken Waldichuk (No. 21), Oswaldo Cabrera (No. 23), and Hayden Wesneski (No. 24).

Playoffs, Don't Talk About Playoffs: The Patriots currently find themselves in a playoff position if the season were to end today, tied with the Akron Rubberducks for the best record in the league and 1.5 games up on the Portland Sea Dogs. The postseason will consist of just a championship series between the two teams with the top records in the league regardless of division.

Arms Race: The team's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.29) and BAA (.209), most shutout wins (13), second-most strikeouts (908), and third-lowest WHIP (1.17) across all levels of Minor League Baseball.

Where's OsWaldo: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera improved his on-base streak to 26 games with a hit last night. Over the streak, Cabrera has reached base at a .319 clip. It's the longest such streak for Cabrera this season and is the second-longest on-base streak on the team this year.

Locked In: Brandon Lockridge went 3-for-5 with a pair of stolen bases in last night's game. Despite only playing in 21 games with the Patriots this season, Lockridge leads the team with six three-hit games. He has multi-hit games in nine of his 21 games with the team and is hitting .333 with a .379 OBP. That includes a .368 average and .458 OBP over five games in August.

Going Streaking: Isiah Gilliam and Jesus Bastidas are enjoying impressive streaks. Gilliam is batting .324 (11-for-34) with a .378 OBP over his current nine-game hit streak. Bastidas is hitting .306 and getting on base at a .432 clip on his 11-game on-base streak to begin his time in Double-A. Max Burt had an eight-game hitting streak snapped Thursday night but has now hit safely in nine of his last 10.

What up, BREAUX: Catcher Josh Breaux went 2-for-4 with his first home run and first two RBI at the Double-A level Wednesday night. Breaux hit 17 home runs earlier this season with High-A Hudson Valley. He ranks second in the Yankees' organization with 18 overall home runs this year, trailing Dermis Garcia (22) and one more than top-prospect Anthony Volpe (17).

On Assignment: RHP Clarke Schmidt pitched 2.2 innings allowing a run on two hits in a rehab appearance last night. Schmidt is ranked as the No. 2 prosect in the Yankees' system (MLB Pipeline). New York's first round draft pick from 2017 spent the 2020 season at the Alternate Training Site and made his MLB debut on Sept. 4, 2020.
