LAST TIME OUT: Messinger had another challening start last Friday against Bowling Green, allowing seven runs (four earned) on five hits across 4.2 innings. He allowed four runs in the third, but only three were earned after an error to start the inning. Blake Robertson hit a home run off Messinger in the frame, the eighth long ball allowed in his last three starts. He left with Hudson Valley trailing 7-1, but the Renegades were able to cut the deficit down to 7-4 before rain ended the game early with two outs in the top of the seventh.

OL' RELIABLE: In his first six starts of the season, Messinger allowed 1 ER-or-fewer five times. He is the first Renegades starting pitcher to do so since Yoendrys Gómez allowed 1 ER-or-fewer in eight straight starts from June 17-Aug. 9, 2022 (22.0 IP), though he never threw more than 4.0 innings in any one outing. Richard Fitts also allowed 1 ER-or-fewer in all five of his starts with Hudson Valley in 2022 from Aug. 13-Sept. 7.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster.
- Got the ball on Opening Day against Greensboro, and allowed just one run in 5.0 innings of work, but got no decision as he left with the game tied 1-1.
- •Turned in his first career Quality Start in his second start of the season on 4/14 vs Aberdeen: ND, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 7 K. Was the first Renegades starter to complete 6.0 innings on the season.
- Became the first Renegades pitcher in the Portal Era (2005-Present) to allow 4 HR in a game on 7/7 @ Jersey Shore. Allowed 3 HR in the fourth (Gabriel Rincones, Jr., Marcus Lee Sang and Leandro Pineda), and a solo shot to Rixon Wingrove in the fifth.
