

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn snapped a 4-game losing streak with a convincing 7-1 win over Wilmington on Thursday night...Trailing 1-0 and being no-hit into the 6th, the Cyclones scored 5 runs and sent 10 men to the plate in the frame...CF Alex Ramírez put Brooklyn in front for good with a 2-run single and added another RBI knock an inning later...Cyclones also scored on a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and a walk, a fielder's choice, and a sacrifice fly by DH Kevin Parada...RHP Raimon Gómez (3.1 IP), RHP Trey McLoughlin (2.2), RHP Jace Beck (2.0), and LHP Quinn Brodey (1.0) combined to permit a season-low 1 run for Brooklyn.

RAMÍ ON A ROLL: OF **Alex Ramírez** comes into Friday riding a team-season-best 7-game hitting streak...The 20-year-old is 11-for-his-last-28 (.393) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases...Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.283) and triples (7)... He is also tied with former Cyclone INF **Ronny Mauricio** for the most doubles (33)...Ramírez is 2nd in on-base percentage (.346) and hits (154), tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (52), and 3rd in slugging (.435), OPS (.781), and total bases (237).

KING CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 7 games in 2023...Berbesi is 10-for-24 (.417) at the plate with 9 runs scored, a double, a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Friday's game 2nd in the SAL in on-base percentage (.576)...He is also tied for 3rd in batting average (.417) and 5th in OPS (1.118)...Berbesi has walked 74 times compared to only 84 strikeouts in 103 career games.

DANG, DANIEL!: LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 4 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 8...In 9 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 9.1 innings... The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 17-straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 23 strikeouts in 19.2 innings.

COMEBACK KEVIN: INF **Kevin Kendall** has reached base safely in 11-straight games to start his Brooklyn career... After being limited to just 3 games last year due to injury, the former UCLA Bruin is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in triples (2)...Entering play on Friday, Kendall is tied for 2nd on the Cyclones in walks (9), and 4th in total bases (14) plus on-base percentage (.352).

CONSUE-HEY!: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week (April 10-16) on Monday...During last week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI last Thursday...The Dominican native's previous 4-hit vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 5 of the Nats' top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF James Wood (1), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (8), OF T.J. White (10), RHP Andry Lara (15), and INF Trey Lipscomb (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against the Blue Rocks in 2022...Brooklyn and Wilmington split 10 games at Maimonides Park last season...The Cyclones are 15-9 all-time at home vs. Wilmington.

night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into Friday, Consuegra is tied for 2nd in the SAL in home runs (3)...He is also tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (6), tied for 5th in total bases (24), and tied for 6th in doubles (3) and RBI (10).

SIT 'EM DOWN: Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches last Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory...RHP Raimon Gómez punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP Daniel Juárez (5), RHP Manny Rodriguez (3), and RHP Jace Beck (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the Ione South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-100 (.519).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.



LAST TIME OUT: Collected his 2nd-straight no-decision on Saturday night at Winston-Salem...Yielded 1 run on a career-high 4 hits over a career-high-matching 4.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a professional-best 7 hitters...Permitted a solo home run to DH Shawn Goosenberg in the bottom of the 2nd... Relieved by RHP Paul Gervase to start the 5th inning and the game tied at 1...Brooklyn held a 4-1 lead entering the 7th...Winston-Salem scored 5 in the 7th and defeated the Cyclones, 6-4.

2022: Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11... Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

SOARING EAGLE: Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

NEW ROLE: Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 4th professional start on Friday...In those outings, he has no record and a 1.74 ERA (2 ER in 10.1 IP), adding 17 strikeouts (14.81 SO/9)...The Kankakee, III. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

SUMMER NIGHTS: The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.
