ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Sugar Land Skeeters earned a 5-1 win over the Round Rock Express on Friday night at Dell Diamond. CF Bryan De La Cruz singled to left field to start the night's action and reached third shortly after when LF Ronnie Dawson added a hit of his own. The Skeeters got on the board when DH Lorenzo Quintana hit the third single in as many batters faced to drive De La Cruz home. In the top of the second inning, both 3B C.J. Hinojosa and 2B Miguelangel Sierra knocked their first home runs for the Skeeters, each hitting solo shots to left field to give Sugar Land a 3-0 lead. After four scoreless innings, the Skeeters tallied their final two runs in the top of the seventh. De La Cruz scored his second run of the night after getting on base with a single and advancing to third on a double from Dawson. RF Jose Siri brought both runners in with a single to right field. Round Rock responded with a run in the bottom of the inning. RF Carl Chester led the way with a triple to the center field wall before scoring as C Yohel Pozo reached base on a fielder's choice, trimming the final score to 5-1.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Texas Rangers have recalled Round Rock Express RHP Hunter Wood prior to tonight's contest. In addition, OF Eli White has joined the Express roster after being optioned from Texas.

THE GREAT GAVIGLIO

E-Train RHP Sam Gaviglio dazzled in his first start of the season back on May 9, holding the Oklahoma City Dodgers to just one unearned run on three hits in 6.0 strong innings. The righty tallied nine strikeouts, his most in a game since also punching out nine hitters back on May 18, 2015 against the Las Vegas 51s as a member of the Tacoma Rainiers.

CHESTER IS BETTER

Round Rock RF Carl Chester tallied a season-high three hits, including his first triple of the year, in last night's defeat. The performance marked the most hits for the speedy outfielder since a four-hit night back on August 23, 2019.

DON'T DOUBT DELINO

Thanks to a fifth-inning single last night, Express CF Delino DeShields now has at least one base hit in all six games he has appeared in this season. On the year, DeShields is hitting .375 (9-24) with two doubles, a triple and two RBI.

A GOOD STREAK SNAPPED

Friday night's contest marked the first time this season that the Round Rock Express were held without a home run, snapping a seven-game streak. The E-Train was previously the only team in the Triple-A West League that had recorded at least home run in every game this season.

STRIKEOUT SUCCESS CONTINUES

Round Rock pitchers combined to strike out 10 Sugar Land hitters last night, including a five-strikeout performance by RHP Jharel Cotton. The Express have now struck out double-digit hitters in seven of the eight games played in 2021. Round Rock continues to lead the Triple-A West League in strikeouts with 94, three more than second-place Tacoma's 91.

GET 'EM IN

Despite dropping the first two contests against Sugar Land, Round Rock hasn't been without scoring opportunities. The club left a season-high 11 men on base on Friday night, just one game after leaving nine men on the base.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Eleven members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, OF Leody Taveras and RHP Collin Wiles. C Blake Grant-Parks is also seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejeda and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 16 different states: Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Five different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 24 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Anderson Tejeda, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
