JACKSONVILLE DROPS FINALE, WINS SERIES

After taking an early lead, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp surrendered four unanswered runs in their 6-4 loss to the Syracuse Mets Sunday afternoon. Trailing 4-2, Syracuse's (31-44) bats woke up in the bottom of the fourth inning. **Gilberto Celestino** walked and **Yonny Hernández** singled to start the frame. **Chris Williams** (1) followed with a three-run home run, putting the Mets in front 5-4. A home run from **Donovan Walton** (10) in the fifth put the nail in the coffin, 6-4.

SUMMER DAYS DRIFTING AWAY

Jacksonville began the 2025 campaign on a tear, posting a 21-8 record through the first 29 games of the season. After posting a Triple-A best, ERA (2.80), batting average against (.205) and tied for the best record (21-8), the Jumbo Shrimp have cooled off heading in to summer. In their last 45 games (May 1-present), Jacksonville is 26-20 but have a -6 run differential. Their .702 OPS is the second-lowest in Triple-A while their 405 strikeouts are the 10th-most. Jacksonville outscored Rochester & Syracuse 73-43 during their road trip.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 61 of their last 74 games, with multiple steals in 46 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With two stolen bases Sunday afternoon, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fourth in the minors with 163 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks third in Triple-A with a 3.63 ERA, and their 302 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 18th in Triple-A in strikeouts (636), but their 532 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.1 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last 25 games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 55 runs, 48 earned, on 93 hits in 112.2 innings for a 3.83 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 111 strikeouts against 58 walks during this stretch.

WALK IT OUT

Through 75 games thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp have totaled 275 free passes (3.7 BB/G). **Jakob Marsee** ranks second in walks in the International League (49). Among the 100 qualified players in the circuit, Marsee ranks 11th in walk rate (15.7%). Including Marsee, Jacksonville has four other players scattered among the 100 other qualified players in walk rate in the IL. (**Jacob Berry**, 11.2%; **Maximo Acosta**, 10.6%; **Troy Johnston**, 8.4%; **Andrew Pinter**, 6.9%).

PITCH PERFECT

Jacksonville's 47 wins in 2025 can be attributed to the strength of their pitching staff. Not does the staff own the third-best ERA in Triple-A (3.63), they've coupled that with the 18th-most strikeouts (636) and the sixth-fewest walks (280). The low strikeout number isn't necessarily troubling because the staff has thrown the second-fewest pitches per inning (16.26). Meaning, that opposing hitters don't draw a ton of three-ball counts, but they also don't drive up the pitch counts of Jacksonville hurlers. Jumbo Shrimp starters average 4.0 IP per contest and own a Triple-A-best 15.77 pitches per inning. In addition, the bullpen averages 5.0 IP per game and is second in Triple-A in pitches/inning (16.66) behind Durham (16.62).

SHRIMP BITES

With Jacksonville's 4-2 Saturday last night and Lehigh Valley's 9-5 loss to Rochester, Jacksonville clinched the first half of the International League season, earning a playoff berth. This is the first time the Jumbo Shrimp have clinched a playoff berth since 2017, when they were members of the Double-A Southern League. The last time a Jacksonville team played for an International League title, was back in 1968 as the Jacksonville Suns, which they won over the Columbus Jets.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourth-most in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
