### HATCHER'S WALK-OFF SINGLE SEALS 6-5 VICTORY OVER HOOKS:

**Josh Hatcher** lined a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th to push the Frisco RoughRiders over the Corpus Christi Hooks 6-5 on Friday night from Riders Field. Frisco (22-15) was once down to their final out when **Abimelec Ortiz** drilled a solo home run, tying the game at four in the ninth and forcing extra innings. Ortiz's blast was his second game-tying or walk-off home run in the ninth inning this week. Corpus Christi (11-26) struck first in extra innings when Anthony Sherwin served an RBI single in the top of the 11th inning to grab a 5-4 lead. Frisco then loaded the bases in the bottom of the 11th after walks to **Ian Moller** and **Aaron Zavala**. **Sebastian Walcott** then plated **Franyer Chavez** on a game-tying fielder's choice and Hatcher delivered the walk-off single to right field. The Riders scored five of the game's last six runs after the Hooks led by as much as 4-1. Corpus Christi's first four hits went for extra bases, starting with a Zach Cole solo home run in the top of the first to take a 1-0 lead. After Frisco's **Cam Cauley** rifled a game-tying sacrifice fly in the bottom of the sixth, the Hooks hit back-to-back homers in the top of the seventh. Ryan Wroblewski clipped a two-run homer and then Austin Deming blasted a solo shot to snatch a 3-1 lead. In the bottom of the seventh, Ortiz ripped a two-run single to pull the Riders to within a run, setting up his game-tying long ball in the bottom of the ninth. Hatcher's walk-off allowed RoughRiders reliever **Janser Lara** (1-0) to earn his first Minor League victory in almost 2,500 days. Lara pitched two innings, allowing one unearned run and striking out four. Hooks reliever Patrick Halligan (0-1) suffered the loss, allowing his second walk-off hit this week. Frisco starter **Ben Anderson** captured his first quality start of the season and seventh with the RoughRiders, pitching six innings of one-run ball.

### HISTORIC OFFENSIVE DAYS:

When the RoughRiders fell to the Hooks 20-14 on Tuesday, they allowed 20 or more runs for the fourth time in franchise history and the first time since 5/1/18 vs. San Antonio (20-4 loss). In that game, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Josh Naylor** and **Ty France** all homered for the Missions. The 34 runs were the most combined runs in franchise history and their second time losing while scoring 14 or more runs. It was their first time since 5/16/15 versus Corpus Christi (15-14 loss). The first two games of the series combined for 55 runs.

### ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While on an eight-game hitting streak, Ortiz is hitting .485 (16-for-33)/.553/.879/1.432 with four doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single. He is fourth in the Texas League in May average (.375), second in RBIs (16), tied for second in home runs (four) and third in OPS (1.152).

### MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 12 this month, which is sixth in the league and have allowed 18, which is the most. Corpus Christi has both hit the most (19) and allowed the second-most (16) in the Texas League this month.

### NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

### DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

**Aaron Zavala** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .333 (21-for-63)/.469/.571/1.040 over his last 19 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (30) and OBP (.469) while leading the league in walk rate (24.4 percent), a mark which also ranks fifth in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 PA). He is currently on an 11-game on-base streak, batting .410 (16-for-39)/.540/.641/1.181 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and 11 walks. In May, he is hitting .372/.500/.581/1.081, ranking fifth in average and sixth in OPS in the Texas League.

### HOOKIN CORPUS:

The Riders have played well against the Hooks this season, going 8-5 against the Astros affiliate. On offense, the Riders are averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .709 OPS. **Sebastian Walcott** (3), **Abimelec Ortiz** (3), **Josh Hatcher** (2) and **Luis Mieses** (2) have all hit multiple home runs against the Hooks this season. Ortiz is now hitting .321 (17-for-53)/.400/.556/.966 against the Hooks with 15 RBIs over 13 games this season.

### BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

**Mitch Bratt** has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first six starts, his 1.99 ERA is fifth in the Texas League. It is also the second-best start to a season through the team's first 32 games (min. six games start) recorded franchise history, only trailing **Justin Grimm** in 2012, who had a 1.60 ERA through seven starts. His 3.9 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.80 K/BB is also first.

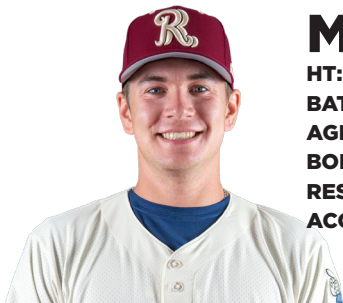

ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft. Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2025 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
