### TONIGHT'S GAME

El Paso and Round Rock get set for the series opener on Tuesday night. Express RHP Tyson Miller is slated to start against Chihuahuas RHP Matt Waldron, with first pitch at Southwest University Park scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Express fell in the series finale on Sunday by a final of 10-2 to the Isotopes. Albuquerque tagged Round Rock starter RHP Cole Winn for two in the first inning. SS Alan Trejo scored 3B Montes on an RBI single before a sacrifice fly for C Jonathan Morales brought the lead to 2-0. In the second, the Isotopes added six runs and took an 8-0 lead. LF Jimmy Herron and 2B Kyle Holder singled to start the frame as a wild pitch allowed both runners to advance a base. CF Wynton Bernard added a third consecutive single and the lead increased to 3-0. With two outs, Trejo singled to score two more. Morales blasted a three-run home run to left field. The Isotopes piled on with two more in the third. Herron led the inning off with a walk and scored on a triple from Holder. Bernard singled, scoring Holder to grow the lead as Albuquerque held a 10-0 advantage. Round Rock got on the board in the fifth frame. DH Steele Walker drew a bases loaded walk to score one run and CF Bubba Thompson avoided a double play by beating out a throw to first base as Arias scored from third to shorten the lead to 10-2. The score stood final as the Express couldn't come from behind for a victory.

### MILLER ON THE MOUND

Express RHP Tyson Miller is scheduled to make his sixth start and 17th appearance on Wednesday. The righty is 2-3 with a 4.24 ERA (22 ER/46.2 IP) with 59 strikeouts to 17 walks this year. He is 11 strikeouts away from 500 minor league K's for his career.

### ALL EYES ON BUBBA

CF Bubba Thompson stole his 40th base of the season on Sunday. INF Esteban German holds the Triple-A franchise record with 44 stolen bases in 2011 while OF Willy Taveras set the overall franchise record in 2004 with 55. The Pacific Coast League stolen base record, dating back to 1988, belongs to OF Will Taylor, who stole 62 bases in 1991 for the then-Las Vegas Stars. Also dating back to 1988, OF Billy Hamilton stole 75 bases in 2013 and holds the overall Triple-A record.

### HEAT WAVE

Sunday's game featured a heat advisory due to Round Rock's 105-degree temperature. Albuquerque kept the Express on the field for 44 minutes and 17 seconds through the first four innings while the Isotopes played defense for just 17 minutes and 37 seconds in the first four.

### BULLPEN BRINGS IT

Round Rock featured six different arms out of the bullpen for the final 7.1 innings on Sunday and they allowed only two earned runs as RHP Hever Bueno allowed both over 1.1 innings. RHP Daniel Robert provided 2.0 innings of scoreless baseball. RHP Nick Snyder, RHP Josh Sborz, RHP Jonathan Hernández and RHP A.J. Alexy each tossed 1.0 inning without allowing a run. The Express bullpen has a 4.74 ERA (205 ER/389.0 IP), which is the second best in the PCL behind the Tacoma Rainiers.

### DOROW TIMES THREE

Express INF Ryan Dorow went 3-for-4 on Sunday and had the team's lone multi-hit game. It was his third multi-hit game this month after he did not record one in 18 games throughout June. Dorow is now hitting .300 (9-30) in July over eight games.

### LATEST TRANSACTIONS

On Monday, the Texas Rangers recalled both C Sam Huff and LHP Kolby Allard. Tuesday saw C Matt Whatley transferred from Double-A Frisco to Round Rock. Whatley is seeking his Triple-A debut after starting the 2022 season with the RoughRiders. The backstop hit .226 (26-115) through 32 games with Frisco.

## EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
