LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dismantled the Erie SeaWolves on Wednesday, slapping a season-high 20 hits in a 15-5 win. Cade Povich tossed a quality start on the mound, while Cody Roberts collected a career-high four hits, and Zach Watson had a career-high six RBI. While Bowie only scored in five of the nine innings. multiple hits strung together accomplished the task, as Cesar Prieto also added three hits, Toby Welk had three more as well as a solo home run, and Hudson Haskin had a pair of hits including a three-run home run. Aside from a solo home run in the fourth, Cade Povich struck out six batters over six strong frames.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Every series is important, but in terms of potential impact, this week of games between Bowie and Erie is the most instantly impactful. Erie has had the best full season in the Southwest Divsion this season, led mostly by a high-ranking pitching staff. Their 3.78 ERA as a staff is the second-best in the league, but the numbers from their starting rotation have been even better, with a league-leading 3.29 ERA, the best in the league. Despite playing in a park that favors more pitchers, Erie's offense has still been able to display power, with the second-most home runs in the league, despite only scoring the fourth-fewest overall runs in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Reese Olson is in his first full season as a Tigers farmhand after being traded over from the Brewers organization in 2021 in exchange for big league lefty Daniel Norris. After five starts with Erie at the tail end of 2021, Olson has blown by opposing batters in his time with the SeaWolves this season. He has struck out at least seven batters in just under half of his starts this season, including eight punchouts against the Baysox in May, when he allowed only one unearned run over five innings in a winning effort. He took a loss to Bowie in June when he allowed four runs in four innings, including a solo home run to Hudson Haskin. After a month-long stretch that saw him only finish the fifth inning once, he's rebounded to fire six innings in his last three starts. He's got a four-pitch mix with a mid-90s fastball, a heavy fading changeup, as well as a slider and a curveball.

HUD-DLED UP FOR WARMTH

Baysox outfielder Hudson Haskin just wrapped up his best month of the season, slashing .300/.418/.511 in 24 games, driving in 18 runs and drawing 12 walks. He did not go consecutive games without a hit over the entire month. Haskin was ranked as the Orioles #16 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #22 according to Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star in the outfield by MiLB.com for his 2021 season, but did not get to see the full season due to a thumb fracture in late August.

FIELD GENERALS

Thanks to Cody Roberts and Maverick Handley, Bowie has had the most feared backstops in the league. Bowie's CS% of 33% is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 72 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors (Omaha-71).

SLIPPING THROUGH THE CRACKS

Bowie pitching had been the largest factor in their successful second half. From the start of the second half into the start of this most recent homestand (6/27-8/12) Bowie pitchers were running with 3.16 ERA, the best in all of Minor League Baseball. Since the start of that homestand, however, Bowie has been saddled with a 5.06 ERA, the highest in the Eastern League over the span.

The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
