2026 Media Notes – August 6th vs Frederick (Orioles)

Game 3 of 6 (Frederick leads season series 13-7 of 24)

Last Game Recap... Randal Diaz had a home run and five RBIs, including the game winning RBI single in the top of the ninth to complete a 10-9 Frederick win over the BlueClaws on Wednesday afternoon at ShoreTown Ballpark...The BlueClaws trailed 9-3 in the seventh inning and scored six runs to tie the game...Juan Villavicencio and Scott Mudler had three hits for Jersey Shore and Tyler Pettorini had two.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws have dropped the first two games of this series but have still won 9 of their last 14 games (since the start of their series at Brooklyn two weeks ago) following a 5-18 start to the second half...They swept two double-headers last week in taking five of six from Hudson Valley.

Daunte Delivering...Daunte Stuart enters today on an 11-game hitting streak (13-44), the longest by a BlueClaw this season (Nick Biddison had a 10-game hitting streak snapped last week)...Zach Arnold and Leandro Pineda had 15 game hitting streaks in 2024 and this is the longest since then...He gave the BlueClaws the lead with an RBI double in the eighth inning of game one on Friday and had a double in each end of the double-header...Stuart began the season with the New Jersey Jackals in the Frontier League before signing with the Phillies...He played last year in the American Association with Lake Country (WI) and 2024 in the Pioneer League with Oakland (CA).

Villa, We See Ya...Juan Villavicencio has five hits over the first two games of this series, including his first BlueClaws 3-hit game on Wednesday...He hit 13 home runs with Clearwater earlier this year, and hit his first with the BlueClaws leading off the game on Friday night...It was the third leadoff home run for the BlueClaws this year (IF Brady Day and rehabbing OF Pedro Leon have the others) and the 14th overall homer this season for the 21 year old from Venezuela...He joined the BlueClaws last week from Clearwater where he was hitting .298 with 13 home runs and 20 stolen bases.

Mud It Up...Scott Mudler, who joined the BlueClaws on Friday from the FCL Phillies, had three hits in the loss on Wednesday and is now 4-9 with Jersey Shore...He had a 2-run double in his first BlueClaws at bat in game two on Saturday...Mudler signed in June from the University of Oklahoma, where he played in 2024 and 2025 and was a student assistant there in 2026, helping the Sooners win the national title...Mudler was 9-47 with two home runs with the FCL Phillies.

Unlucky Seven...The BlueClaws have scored 16 runs in the first two games of the series, but have lost both...They were 24-4 entering the week when scoring at least seven runs, but 0-2 when doing so this week...They have allowed double-digit runs (10 in each) in both games of the series, and have allowed double-digits in back to back games for the first time since they gave up 11 runs in Frederick in three straight games during a Maryland visit in May.

Tip Top Tyler...Tyler Pettorini had two hits on Wednesday and is now 11-25 since Friday with two doubles and a triple...He had two hits on Sunday and three on Saturday in game two of the double-header...Pettorini joined the BlueClaws on May 26th from Clearwater where he was hitting .179 in 35 games...He was signed as a non-drafted free agent from Ohio State last year.

Deadline Dealing...Four BlueClaws were traded on Tuesday in two separate trades, only the 3rd and 4th times in team history that two current BlueClaws were traded in the same deals (Joe Wilson and Javon Moran to the Reds for Cory Lidle on 8/10/2004...Chris Oliver and Josh Taylor to the Diamondbacks for international slot money on 7/5/2014).

- RHP Ramon Marquez and RHP Marty Gair to the Giants for IF Luis Arraez and RHP Caleb Kilian.
- RHP Luke Gabrysh and OF John Spikerman to the Mets for LHP Brooks Raley.

The BlueClaws have had players traded at the deadline each year they have been a High-A affiliate (Tyler Burch to Baltimore and Kevin Gowdy to Texas in 2001...Ben Brown to the Cubs in 2002...Hao-Yu Lee to Detroit in 2023...George Klassen to the Angels and William Bergolla to the White Sox in 2024...Eduardo Tait to the Twins in 2025).

Make It Count...TJavy Walton, a 4th round pick in the 2023 draft from IMG Academy in Bradenton, FL, had a two run single in his first BlueClaws at bat on Tuesday night and added a single and two walks on Wednesday...Walton joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where in 22 games he .238 with two home runs...Walton was taken one round after the Phillies took BlueClaws OF Devin Saltiban in the 2023 draft.

All About the Ferrebus...C Alirio Ferrebus joined the BlueClaws last week from Clearwater, where he was hitting .324 with 11 home runs and 58 RBIs with Clearwater this year...At the time of his promotion, he was leading the league in batting average, third in RBIs, fourth in slugging percentage (.520), and third in OPS (.895)...The #6 prospect in the system, Ferrebus is just 20 years old and hails from Maracaibo, Venezuela...He had a 2 home run game on May 5th at Daytona earlier this year.

Carter Goes Boom, Again...Carter Mathison now has 11 home runs on the season after a three run shot in the first inning in game two on Saturday, nine of his home runs have come since June 16th...He hit four home runs at Frederick in a series that ended on July 12th...Mathison is now the first BlueClaw since Rixon Wingrove (15) and Gabriel Rincones, Jr. (10) in 2023 to reach double-digit home runs...Zach Arnold had nine last year and Jordan Dissin had nine in 2023...Mathison hit seven with Clearwater last year...He also has 21 stolen bases this year and is 38-40 in his career...Mathison was a 5th round pick in 2024 from Indiana University...There, he became one of three Hoosiers to hit 40 home runs in his first three collegiate seasons (Kyle Schwarber and Alex Dickerson).

Over the Humphreys...Nate Humphreys' first day with the BlueClaws was a big one...In game one, he homered in his second at bat (his first with the Claws after he hit 12 with Clearwater)...In game two, he gave the BlueClaws the lead with an RBI single in the top of the seventh inning to complete the comeback...Humphreys was a non-drafted free agent last year from Dallas Baptist...He turns 24 on August 16th.

From Manhattan to ShoreTown...RHP Tegan Cain, a native of Manhattan, Kansas, joined the BlueClaws on Tuesday from Clearwater where he was 1-1 with a 3.04 ERA in 23.2 innings, adding 36 strikeouts against just 10 walks...Cain gave up just four earned runs in his last 17.1 innings with the Threshers, fanning 27 batters...He was a 13th round pick in the 2024 draft from the University of Kansas, where he was a teammate of BlueClaws C Kodey Shojinaga and former BlueClaws RHP Reese Dutton, now with Reading.

The Gabe...Gabe Craig picked up a three out save on just two pitches on Thursday (there has been only one such save in MLB and one in MiLB since 2021)...He joined the BlueClaws on June 16th and since then, has allowed just two earned runs (five total), with both scoring in one inning on 7/7 at Frederick...Nine of his 10 appearances have come without allowing an earned run, and he has struck out 14 in his 12.0 innings...Craig began the year with Clearwater, allowing nine runs in 22 innings with 33 strikeouts...He was a 5th round pick in 2025 from Baylor.

A Tough Climb...Sally League hitters have had a tough time against LHP Cam Hill...The southpaw out of Georgia Tech has 17 strikeouts in 11 July innings, fanning 17 of 41 batters faced...He has 40 strikeouts in 28.1 innings with the BlueClaws this season and at least one strikeout in 15 of his last 16 appearances with the BlueClaws (the lone appearance in which he did not strike out a batter was on 7/22 when he retired the only batter he faced)...He arrived on April 30th after opening the season with Clearwater.

Heating Up...Jake Eddington is heating up out of the bullpen for Jersey Shore...The right-hander has allowed just four earned runs in his last 19.2 innings with 19 strikeouts in that stretch...Before the current run, he gave up seven runs in his first 14.2 innings this season...Eddington was a 7th round pick in the 2023 draft out of Missouri State, the same alma mater of Ryan Howard (though when Howard played there it was known as Southwest Missouri State).

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Going Deep...BlueClaws starters have thrown six innings in a game 10 times this year – once by Sam Highfill on June 9th at Hudson Valley, six by Reese Dutton (most recently on July 7th at Frederick) and three by Ryan Dromboski (including May 26th vs Frederick)...The last BlueClaw to throw seven innings in a game was Braydon Tucker on September 7, 2024 at Aberdeen.

Second Half Underway...The SAL Northern Division Second Half Champion will play Frederick in the first round of the post-season...Bowling Green won the Southern Division First Half title...In 2023, Jersey Shore made the playoffs despite a 7-14 start to the second half, going 30-15 the rest of the way to clinch on the final day of the season.

Extra, Extra...The BlueClaws have played 49 home games, and eight have gone to extra innings (4-4 at home, 4-7 overall in extra innings)...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

Things in 10s...The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game nine times this year (most recently on 7/12 at FRE), and scored 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times...After their 13-2 win on April 18th, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

Familiar Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have six walk-off wins this year...Trent Farquhar had a 12th inning walk-off single on 7/23 vs Brooklyn...Nick Biddison hit a walk-off home run on 7/22 against Brooklyn...Tyler Pettorini hit a walk off home run on Father's Day (6/21) against Greenville (the third walk-off home run by the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate – Felix Reyes in 2023 and Kehden Hettiger in 2025)...They beat Brooklyn 5-4 in 10 innings on June 4th on an RBI single from Luis Caicuto...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11th inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger.

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have used two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have one pair of college teammates in C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17th...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...136 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and nine total this year...**Justin Crawford** (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while **Andrew Painter** (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP **George Klassen** (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...IF **Hao-Yu Lee** (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17th with the Tigers...UT **Felix Reyes** (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18th with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...C **Rodolfo Duran** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on May 7th with the Padres...OF **Gabriel Rincones** (2023 BlueClaw) debuted on June 12th with the Phillies...RHP **Julian Garcia** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on June 24th with the Reds...RHP **Alex McFarlane** debuted on July 22nd with the Phillies...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wrobleksi makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

About: 22 year old, 6-1, 212 pound RHP from Bowdoinham, Maine

How Acquired: 3rd round pick, 2025 draft (Vanderbilt University, TN)

Season Notes: Struck out a career-high eight over five innings on 7/22 vs BRK (2 runs)...Earned first BlueClaws win on 7/8 at FRE, allowing one run over five innings...Threw his longest outing with the BlueClaws on 6/30 vs ROM, allowing two runs in five innings...Made BlueClaws debut on 6/16 vs GVL and threw four scoreless innings with six strikeouts...Joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on 6/16 where he was 2-4, 5.90 in 39.2 innings with 64 strikeouts and 20 walks...Struck out seven batters three times with Clearwater, two of those in just three innings...Longest outing with the Threshers was four innings, which he did four times...Entered season as the #16 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Career Notes: Did not pitch professionally in 2025...Spent one year at Vanderbilt, where he had a 4.38 ERA in 16 starts...Spent two years at Georgetown prior to transferring to Vanderbilt...Was a two-way player as a freshman at Georgetown...Helped Thornton Academy in Saco, Maine win the state title in 2022...Was a four year member of the National Honor Society in high school.
