**GAME 89:** After dropping the first two games of this series and the two-week homestand, the FredNats will try to get back in the win column tonight with LHP Erik Tolman getting the start. Myrtle Beach has scored 21 runs in the first two games - double digits in each game - and has slugged their way to two comfortable victories in their first ever trip to Fredericksburg. Tolman will start for the fifth time as a FredNat tonight, and he's coming off a career-high four walks in three innings his last time out in Augusta last week. This is Tolman's third home start, he pitched four shutout innings in his debut at home a few weeks ago.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The FredNats scored two runs in the first inning and chased Myrtle Beach starter Jackson Ferris out of the game, but the Pelicans quickly took the lead back with six runs in the 4th inning to eventually pull away with a 10-5 win. Four walks hurt starter Riley Cornelio, and four FredNat hitters had multi-hit games: Max Romero Jr., John McHenry, Roismar Quintana and Cortland Lawson.

**ROSY JULY:** FredNat infielder turned outfielder Roismar Quintana has enjoyed his best month of the season in July. He's got seven multi-hit games this month - including the first two games of this series - and his slash line is .349/.431/.397 for an OPS of .827 this month. After roster movement, he has been pushed back out to the outfield, a spot that was his normal position prior to this year.

**TO THE MAX:** Catcher Max Romero Jr. has had a great stretch at the plate since returning from the injured list earlier this month. In 12 games in July, Romero is slashing .366/.480/.659 for an OPS of 1.139. He's hit the first three home runs of his professional career, thrown out about a third of baserunners from behind the plate, and driven in 12 runs this month to lead the team.

**JOHN MCHENRY IS A MIGHTY MAN:** Since joining the FredNats one month ago, John McHenry has been a valuable bat. In 10 games with Fredericksburg, McHenry is 11-for-35 with a homer, nine RBI, and seven walks for an OPS of .832. He's played both second base and the corner outfield, and has hit for power from both sides of the plate as a switch hitter.

**IMMACULATE:** Coming out of a rain delay on Friday night, relief pitcher Matt Merrill fired an immaculate inning - three straight strikeouts on nine pitches. The feat was just the fifth this year in Minor League Baseball at any level, and the first in the franchise history of the FredNats. Merrill threw only fastballs in the inning, and the entire frame lasted just about two and a half minutes.

**CLOSE IT OUT:** When the FredNat offense has given the team a late lead in games this year, the bullpen has done well to close the games out. Fredericksburg is 31-5 this year when leading after seven innings, and 29-3 when leading after eight innings. Seven different pitchers have recorded a save this year for the bullpen.

**SOUTHERN STRUGGLES:** While the FredNats have a winning record against teams in their own division this year, games against the Carolina League South Division have not gone quite as well. Fredericksburg is 27-24 against the North and just 13-24 against the South. The FredNats have lost all but one series they have played against South Division teams, with the lone exception coming when the FredNats beat the Charleston RiverDogs four out of six games at home back in June.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 33, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

**THE STAFF:** Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.) and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Erik Tolman has become a key piece of the Fredericksburg rotation, after a brief stint in the Florida Complex League to begin his 2023. The left-hander was largely effective in three starts with the FCL Nats. Tolman worked eight innings all together, giving up just one earned run while striking out eight batters. Most recently, against the Mets FCL club, Tolman tossed three scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts and no walks.

**ROAD TO FREDERICKSBURG:** Tolman spent three seasons at Arizona State, enrolling in 2019 and ultimately getting drafted in the 14th round after his junior campaign in 2021. Tolman was primarily a reliever with the Sun Devils, although he did make 10 starts out of 31 appearances. He worked to a 3.29 ERA, with 93 strikeouts in 79.1 innings pitched.

Tolman was also a bona fide two-way threat his first year with the Sun Devils. He played left field for ASU, launching three home runs and driving in seven runs while clocking a .761 OPS.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Tolman was excellent last week against the Augusta Greenjackets. He turned in three innings of one-run ball, while giving up just a pair of base hits and striking out three men. That was Tolman's third start with FXBG where he allowed 1 ER or fewer.
