FOR THE LOVE OF GOD, PLEASE STOP RAINING: After winning the first game of the series Tuesday night, the FredNats endured their 13th rainout of the season last night, and third on this road trip. Tonight, the team will attempt to play a doubleheader with the Pelicans, and RHP R.J. Sales will make his team and organizational debut on the mound. Sales was acquired by Washington at the trade deadline from the Detroit Tigers as part of a package for Kyle Finnegan. He faces Pelican righty Nazier Mulé, a top-30 prospect for the Cubs who has struggled this year. Fredericksburg is now within a half game of first place in the Carolina League North with Carolina's loss paired with FBG's win last night. RHP Brayan Romero is scheduled to pitch game two. The FredNats are 8-8 in doubleheader games this year.

ABOUT LAST GAME: Fredericksburg had its highest-scoring single inning in two months, scoring five runs in the top of the first inning to stay in the driver's seat the whole game in a 7-3 series-opening win over the Pelicans. Angel Feliz hit his first Fredericksburg home run and first grand slam of the season for the FredNats in the first to blow it open, and the FredNat bullpen threw 4.1 scoreless innings. Kevin Bazzell and Cristhian Vaquero both had RBI singles, and Everett Cooper III had a sac fly. Victor Farias earned his first FredNat win.

NEW FACES: R.J. Sales debuts on the mound after posting one of the best stat lines in the Single-A Florida State League with the Lakeland Flying Tigers. He made 16 appearances (15 starts) with Lakeland, posting a 2.71 ERA in 66.1 innings with 63 strikeouts and only 17 walks. Saturday, Washington's ninth round pick in the 2025 MLB Draft Wyatt Henseler debuted for Fredericksburg, becoming the first member of the 2025 draft class to make his professional debut. Henseler was drafted out of Texas A&M, playing one season for the Aggies after a decorated four-year run at Penn, winning Ivy League Player of the Year in 2024 and breaking the Ivy League career record for home runs. Henseler broke up a no-hitter with a double in his second professional at-bat, and has reached base four times in his first two games. Today, 14th round pick Nick Hollifield debuts for Fredericksburg. He was drafted out of the University of Alabama-Birmingham (UAB).

START EARLY: The FredNats are 49-49 overall this season, but are 15 games over .500 (29-14) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 75-11 (-36).

HE'S INEVITABLE: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season last home stand, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 27 second half games, Vaquero is leading the league in batting average (.346), OPS (.957), slugging (.567), and he's third in hits (36) and sixth in extra-base hits (11). He also picked up his 11th outfield assist of the season in last night's game.

WHY TRY IT?: After picking up another last night, Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 80 (MB is 3rd with 69). Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by 10 with 52 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 43.6% of would-be base stealers. Bazzell is also in the midst of his best stretch of the season offensively, hitting .290 with a .728 OPS in his last 10 games.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.52, which is currently number two in professional baseball (150 total teams). Fredericksburg is 37-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 30-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 16 saves in that time frame is also tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

SALES AGREEMENT: R.J. Sales (Pronounced "Sails") joins the FredNats after being acquired by Washington in a trade with the Detroit Tigers at the MLB trade deadline. Sales was part of the return from Detroit for longtime Washington closer Kyle Finnegan. He was originally drafted in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of UNC Wilmington.

SALES PITCH: Before becoming a part of the Washington organization, Sales was dominant in the Detroit system with Single-A Lakeland. In his professional debut season, Sales started this year by throwing 66.1 innings with the Flying Tigers, posting a 2.71 ERA across 15 total starts. The righty struck out 63 hitters in the Florida State League and walked just 17. Among all pitchers in the FSL with 65 or more innings pitched, Sales had the 5th-best ERA and the 4th-best WHIP (1.12).

(IN THE) YARD SALES: In his 66.1 innings to begin the year with Lakeland, Sales allowed just two home runs. Since the beginning of June, the right-hander has not surrendered a homer.

GROSS SALES: Sales' fastball topped out at 97.2 mph during his time with Lakeland and owns one of the better breaking balls that the FredNats' pitching staff has seen this year. The 22-year-old's slider has just a .152 batting average against. He has allowed seven hits on the pitch in 15 starts and gotten 26 strikeouts with it.

MEET HIM: Brayan David Romero...(pronounced: Bryan) was activated from the injured list and returned to Fredericksburg on 6/7 after completing a rehab assignment with the FCL Nationals.

NOT THE FIRST TIME: Romero is making his second stint with the FredNats after making seven regular season starts in FXBG last year. The righty posted a 5.52 ERA across 29.1 IP with 13 strikeouts to five walks. This is his third season in the Nationals organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero got the loss in an eventual 6-0 FredNats defeat last Wednesday at Columbia. He covered four innings, but surrendered six hits and five earned runs. For the second time in four starts, Romero did not have a strikeout. He has walked at least three hitters in each of his last four starts.

FIRESTARTER: Romero started game one of the Carolina League Championship series in 2024 at Kannapolis. In an eventual FredNat win, he threw 4.1 innings, giving up three earned runs to the Cannon Ballers.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.

Ordez, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordez has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
