FRED NATS HANDILY TAKE GAME FOUR: The Delmarva Shorebirds dropped their second straight game to the Fredericksburg Nationals on Friday night by a score of 10-1. In what was a pitcher's duel to start between **Zack Showalter** and **Brad Lord** turned into a Nationals rout in the later innings. With the score 1-0 entering the sixth, the Fred Nats scored three runs to extend their lead to 4-0. They'd add another one on in the eighth on an RBI double by **Max Romero Jr.** Delmarva scored their lone run of the night on a solo home run by **Randy Florentino** in the bottom of the eighth, but Fredericksburg put the game away for good with five runs in the ninth to easily take game four 10-1.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Moises Chace makes his seventh start of the season on Saturday night against one of the Nationals top prospects, **Jarlin Susana**. Susanna is the No. 6 prospect for a deep, Washington farm system and was acquired from the San Diego Padres as part of the deal that sent Juan Soto to San Diego. Susana has a 75-grade fastball and is coming off his best month of the season as he finished the month of June where he had an ERA of 1.08 in 16.2 innings. This will be the third time this season Susana will face the Shorebirds and pitched four innings each time, allowing just one run on five hits in his two starts combined.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In 20 games since returning, Craig is slashing .333/.415/.533 and has collected a total of 10 extra-base hits, and 12 RBI, while also stealing 9 bases. Craig has reached base safely in 24 of 26 games with the Shorebirds and has multiple hits in 11 of his 26 games with Delmarva. His 16-game on-base streak that was snapped on June 23 is the longest by a Shorebirds hitter this season.

BLAZING BASALLO: Samuel Basallo is currently in one of his hottest stretches this season. Since June 18, Basallo is batting .354 with 5 home runs and 13 RBI. During his current run, he was named the Carolina League Player of the Week for June 20-25 versus Augusta, featuring a game where he went yard twice, his second multi-homer game of his career. He also hit the first grand slam of the season for the Shorebirds on Sunday in the 8th inning against Lynchburg to break a 0-0 tie. Basallo is currently the league-leader in RBI amongst active players and is 9 RBI ahead of the next closest player (**Zach Cole** - Fayetteville).

THE 'BIRDS ARE HOT?: After a tough month and tough 20 game stretch where the Shorebirds went 4-16 from May 28-June 18, Delmarva is playing with some momentum as they've won their last two series against Augusta and Lynchburg. It's the first time the Shorebirds have won consecutive series since the end of April when they took four of five from both the Fredericksburg Nationals and the Salem Red Sox.

ROLLIN' WITH ROMERO: Noelberth Romero has put together a tremendous series so far against Fredericksburg as he is 6/14 with a home run, a double, and 4 RBI. Romero had multiple hits in the first three games against the Freddies this week and now has 7 multi-hit games in 22 games in Delmarva. Romero has played a total of 51 games this season across all four affiliated levels of the Orioles minor league system.

SETTING THE TONE: The starting pitcher for the Shorebirds has been a difference maker over the last two series as the starters have a combined ERA of 2.13 over the last 15 games with 69 strikeouts (10.5 K/9). The starter has departed from the game six times during this stretch without allowing a run and no one has allowed more than three earned runs.

TIME FOR REVENGE: The Shorebirds welcome in rival Fredericksburg for the first time this season and our looking for payback after dropping six out of seven games to the Freddies last time the two matched up from May 30-June 4. Delmarva was walked-off three times in that series and lost a pair of games in extra innings.

TODAY'S STARTER: Moises Chace returns to the mound as a starter for the first time since June 18, making his 16th appearance and 7th start this season.

LAST OUTING (7/3 @ LYN): Chace tossed arguably his best outing of the season last time out as he tossed four shutout innings to earn a save on Monday in the series finale against Lynchburg. The right-hander stuck out nine batters, the most in his career in a 5-0 shutout win.

vs. FREDERICKSBURG: This will be the third time this season Chace will pitch against the Fred Nats and his second as a starter. Chace earned a win in relief on April 19 in Fredericksburg by pitching the final four innings, allowing two runs on three hits while striking out seven in a 7-4 victory. On June 1, the Nationals scored the most runs on Chace in an outing this year as they chased him out of the game in the third inning after recording eight outs, but allowing five runs on five hits. He would not factor into the decision in a 8-7 loss in extra innings.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The spent all of 2022 in

Delmarva had a nice first season in full-season baseball as he finished the season making 19 appearances and 14 starts that covered 59.2 innings. His record was 3-5 and struck out an impressive with 64 with 42 walks. Opponents hit just .213 against him on the mound.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Chace enters his start tonight with 71 strikeouts, which is the third most on the Shorebirds behind Jared Beck (75) and Juan Nunez (72) but Chace is the club lead in K/9 this season amognst qualified pitchers on the team with 13.3. He is coming off an outing lin Lynchburg where he struck out a career-best of nine in four innings of work. Opponents are batting just .202 against him this season.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
