BIEBER FEVER: On Monday, July 21, the Cleveland Guardians announced that RHP Shane Bieber will make a rehab start for the Captains on Tuesday night. Guardians Manager Stephen Vogt said that the 2020 American League Cy Young Award winner is expected to log 3 innings or around 40-45 pitches for Lake County. This outing will mark Bieber's 1start as a Captain since April 30, 2017 vs. the West Michigan Whitecaps, a 3,005-day span.

CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: On Monday, July 21, RHP Robert
Wegielnik was named the newest Captain of the Week, presented
by Official League. The right-hander earned the save with 2
scoreless innings of relief on Sunday, July 20 vs. the Fort
Wayne, which included a stretch of 5 straight strikeouts.

RALPHY MAKES THE TOP 10: On Friday July 18, MLB Pipeline announced that with Kansas City Royals OF/1B Jac Caglianone's graduation from prospect status, Captains 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez is now MLB Pipeline's No. 10 1B prospect. The 2023 1st-round pick out of Huntington Beach HS (CA) has 46 RBI and 33 XBH in 76 games for Lake County this season.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. <u>Lake County aims</u> to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive <u>MWL titles</u>.

### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

SANTOS STANDS ALONE: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3<sup>rd</sup> season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With his 171<sup>st</sup> win with the Captains on June 8 at West Michigan, Santos became the winningest manager in history. He surpassed 2003 South Atlantic League Manager of the Year and former longtime Toronto Blue Jays First Base Coach Luis Rivera (2003-04; father of current Lake County Bench Coach Yan Rivera) for the most wins by a manager in Captains history.

A REUNION 13 YEARS IN THE MAKING: On Tuesday, July 8, RHP Tyler Naquin was promoted to Lake County from the ACL Guardians. Naquin, 34, converted to pitcher after an 8-year MLB career as an outfielder from 2016-23, After not playing in 2024, he signed with the Cleveland Guardians as a Minor League free agent on March 6, 2025. In his 1st pro stint as a pitcher. Naquin made 13 relief appearances for the ACL Guardians this year, going 2-0 with a 5.14 ERA, 8 K to 11 BB, and a 170 opposing AVG in 14.0 IP. Cleveland originally drafted Naquin with the 15th overall pick in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M. Soon after, he played for the Captains during the 2012 Midwest League Playoffs, batting .353 with 6 H, 5 R, 2 2B, 1 RBI, and a .961 OPS in 5 ames. Naquin logged a scoreless, hitless inning of relief in his High-A pitching debut on July 9 at West Michigan, striking out the 1st batter he faced and issuing a walk in 16 pitches (8 strikes).

TWO CAPS TO AKRON: On Friday, July 18, the Cleveland Guardians Player Development System announced that OF Wuilfredo Antunez and RHP Yorman Gómez were promoted to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks. At the time of their pormotions, Antunez was the only MWL player with a .260+ AVG, 30+ XBH, and a .500+ SLG this season, and Gómez was 1 of just 4 MiLB pitchers with 8+ wins, 80+ K, and a 3.00-or-lower ERA this season.

TWO CATS TO LAKE COUNTY: On Friday, July 18, the Cleveland Guardians Player Development System announced that OF Nick Mitchell and RHP Sean Matson were promoted to the Captains from the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. At the time of his promotion, Mitchell recorded 20 RBI, 24 BB to 21 K, and 21 SB in 23 attempts in 39 games with Single-A Lynchburg this season. Additionally, at the time of his promotion, Matson ranked top-5 among MiLB pitchers (min. 55.0 IP) in fewest R allowed (9, 191), fewest ER allowed (8, T-191), ERA (1,21, 2nd), and WHIP (0.84, 4ln), while ranking top-10 in opposing AVG (161, 8ln).

THE FASTEST MAN IN MILB IS HERE: On Monday, June 23, OF Tommy Hawke was promoted to Lake County from Single-A Lynchburg. At the time of his promotion, the left-handed hitter led MiLB in both SB (63) and R (65), while ranking 4<sup>th</sup> in OBP (453). Hawke is the 1<sup>st</sup> MiLB player with 60+ SB and 60+ R through a team's first 69 games of a season since at least 2005, a feat that has been achieved just once (Rickey Henderson, 1982) during MiLB's Modern Era (since 1901). Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Hawke currently leads MiLB with 65 SB, while ranking top-10 in OBP (444, 3<sup>sq</sup>) and R (68, T-6<sup>th</sup>).

FOUR-HEADED MONSTER: OF Alfonsin Rosario (15 HR), MLB Pipeline's No. 23 Guardians prospect, former Captains OF Wuilfredo Antunez (14 HR), and 18/LF Ralphy Velazquez (12 HR), MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect, and INF Jose Devers (12 HR) have each hit double-digit HR this season. The Captains are 1 of 2 High-4 teams with at least four 12+ HR hitters this year (also Everett AquaSox (SEA), 5 players).

ROSARIO'S ROBUST OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 23 Cleveland prospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters this year. The 21-year-old ranks top-10 in the MWL in HR (15, T-1\*), SLG (.498, 3\*), and OPS (.862, 6\*), while ranking top-15 in TB (129, T-12\*\*). Rosario is the only High-A player and 1 of 6 MiLB players with a .265+ AVG, 15+ HR, and 10+ SB this year.

WRECK-IT RALPH: 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier sluggers this year. <u>The 20-</u> year-old ranks top-10 in the MWL in 3B (6, T-3<sup>-d</sup>), HR (12, T-6<sup>th</sup>), XBH (33, T-6<sup>th</sup>), and TB (131, 10<sup>th</sup>), and top-15 in RBI (46, T-12<sup>th</sup>). <u>Velazquez is 1 of 5 MWL players</u> with 30+ XBH, 10+ HR, and 45+ RBI this season.

# **BIO**

**Mokoro** (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy (pronounced "EMPATHY"), LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games and select additional games this season!** 

**Mokoro** is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

#### FROM LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS WEBSITE

The Cleveland Guardians [on Monday, July 21] announced that RHP Shane Bieber would make a rehab start for the Lake County Captains on Tuesday, July 22 at 7 p.m. versus the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A Affiliate of the Athletics

This outing will take place 3,005 days since his last start as a Lake County Captain, which was back on April 30, 2017 versus the West Michigan Whitecaps, the then-Class A (now High-A) Affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

Bieber, who is currently recovering from Tommy John surgery he underwent last year, has yet to pitch at the Major League level this season.

One of the most decorated former Captains in franchise history, the 30-year-old is a two-time MLB All-Star (2019 and 2021) and was named the 2019 MLB All-Star Game MVP. He then won the American League Cy Young Award the following year, recording the 29th instance of an American or National League pitcher's Triple Crown since 1913 (when earned runs and ERA became official stats), and just the 13th instance of an MLB pitcher's Triple Crown during this span. Bieber also won an American League Gold Glove Award in 2022.

The Phoenix, Arizona native was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of UC Santa Barbara. He was eventually assigned to Lake County's 2017 Opening Day roster and made five starts for the Captains that season. The right-hander went 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA and 31 strikeouts to just one walk in 29 innings of work. His 31.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio led all MiLB pitchers for the month of April in 2017.

**LAST TIME OUT:** LHP **Michael Kennedy** (ND) did not record a decision in an eventual 5-2 road win over the West Michigan Whitecaps back on Sunday, July 13. The southpaw pitched 2.2 innings of piggyback relief, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits, while throwing 5 strikeouts to 1 walk in 57 pitches (37 strikes). **Kennedy**'s 2 runs allowed were courtesy of a 2-out RBI triple in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup> inning, and a bequeathed runner scoring on a 2-out RBI single permitted by Captains RHP **Kyle Scott** in the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup>.

WELCOME BACK, KENNEDY: After being placed on the 7-day injured list on May 7 with R knee soreness, Kennedy was activated on Thursday, June 26. <u>The southpaw made 2 rehab starts for the ACL Guardians on June 12 and June 19</u>, permitting 7 hits, 7 runs (5 earned), and 6 walks to 4 strikeouts in 3 combined innings of work

TOP 20 PROSPECT: Kennedy is the Guardians' No. 17 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. MLB Pipeline on Kennedy: "Kennedy's fastball averaged just under 90 mph and peaked at 93 last season, though it was effective because he creates deception and carry with a flat approach angle. Hitters also can't sit on his heater because he has a pair of solid secondary pitches that elicit a lot of chases. His sweeping low-80s slider keeps left-handers in check and his sinking low-80s changeup keeps right-handers at bay." In his career with the Pirates organization, the left-hander compiled a 3.11 ERA, with a 158/44 K/BB ratio over 130.1 innings pitched. In 2024, Kennedy had just a 6% walk rate, which ranked 3rd among teenagers in MiLB (min. 80 IP).

**FORMER TOP 30 PROSPECT:** Earlier this season, **Kennedy** was also the Guardians' No. 27 prospect according to *Baseball America*. **Baseball America** on **Kennedy**: "...a deceptive low-slot release and shorter arm path have allowed the sturdily-built lefthander to elicit whiffs at the top of the zone with his heater and mostly stymie lower-level hitters... **Kennedy** throws plenty of strikes and repeats his delivery well."

**WELCOME TO THE LAND:** On Dec. 10, 2024, **Kennedy** was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with fellow Captains LHP **Josh Hartle** and current Guardians RHP **Luis Ortiz** in exchange for INF **Spencer Horwitz**.

ROOKIE BALL LEGEND: With the FCL Pirates in 2023, Kennedy was awarded FCL Pitcher of the Month for August and was named a *Baseball America* Rookie Leagues All-Star. In August, he had a 0.61 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched, holding opponents to just a .109 AVG. Kennedy threw back-to-back scoreless starts on 8/8 and 8/15, tallying 8.2 straight scoreless innings. Kennedy's 0.61 ERA in August ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in all of Rookie Ball (min. 14 IP), and his 6.00 K/BB ratio ranked 4<sup>th</sup> in all of professional baseball in the month of August.

FIDGET SPINNERS: According to Baseball America's Tim Williams, Kennedy was bored in his house in Bradenton, Florida during 2024 Spring Training, so he decided to purchase fidget spinners from Amazon. He brought them to the clubhouse, and they were an immediate hit. As a result, the left-hander purchased a Pirates branded fidget spinner for each Single-A Bradenton pitcher. That season, Kennedy finished 5th on Bradenton in strikeouts (80), innings pitched (73), and games started (15, tied), proving the fidget spinners to be effective.

HIGH SCHOOL STARDOM: A two-way star in high school at Troy High School in Troy, New York, Kennedy was named New York's 2022 Gatorade Player of the Year following an incredible senior season both at the plate and on the mound. As a pitcher, the southpaw did not lose a single game in his high school career, going a perfect 13-0. In his senior season, he boasted a 0.61 ERA, adding 65 strikeouts to just 8 walks. In the final game of his high school career, Kennedy threw a no-hitter vs. Albany Academy, propelling Troy to the Section 2 Class A Semifinals. As a hitter, he was just as good, finishing his high school career batting .437 while slugging 7 home runs.

#### CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

2 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2025 season.

RHP Nic Enright: On Saturday, May 24, RHP Nic Enright was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians. He made his MLB debut on Sunday, May 25 at Comerica Park against the Detroit Tigers, <u>just under 2½ years after being diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma.</u> The right-hander pitched 2 scoreless innings, allowing 2 hits and throwing 3 strikeouts on 36 pitches (25 strikes), as Cleveland lost 5-0. Enright made 11 appearances for the Captains in 2021, going 1-0 with a 1.47 ERA, a 32/3 K/BB ratio, a .179 opposing AVG, and a 0.82 WHIP in 18.1 IP. <u>During his tenure with Lake County (May 7-June 24, 2021), the right-hander ranked top-five among Midwest League pitchers (min. 18 IP) in fewest runs allowed (3, T-1<sup>st</sup>), fewest HR allowed (0, T-1<sup>st</sup>), fewest earned runs allowed (3, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), saves (3, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), fewest walks (3, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), ERA (5<sup>th</sup>), and K/BB ratio (10.67, 5<sup>th</sup>).</u>

**LHP Doug Nikhazy:** On Saturday, April 26, **LHP Doug Nikhazy** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians as the 27<sup>th</sup> man for a home doubleheader versus the Boston Red Sox. The left-hander started Game 2 of the twin bill, suffering the loss in a 7-3 defeat. He pitched 3 innings, allowing 5 hits, 6 earned runs, and 6 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts. **Nikhazy** made 21 starts for the Captains in 2022, going 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA, 118 K, and a .182 opposing AVG in 93.0 IP. *His 118 K were tied for the Lake County lead, while his 93.0 IP and 21 GS (tied) ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> on the team.*
